 Safeguard information system (SIS) to provide information on how the country is addressing and respecting the Cancun safeguards • Summary of information on how the Cancun safeguards are being addressed and respected submitted before Results-Based Payments



What does "Address and Respect" the safeguards mean?

"Address"

The governance arrangements - including policies, laws, regulations and the institutions, information systems, etc. – to deal with safeguards, are in place (*on paper*)

"Respect"

How these governance arrangements are being implemented and affect real and positive outcomes on the ground (*in practice*)





Other requirements on safeguards?

- Some donors / sources of REDD+ finance and resultsbased payments may have additional requirements related to the safeguards
- For example:
 - Operational policies of development banks (e.g. World Bank, ADB)
 - Green Climate Fund (GCF safeguards policy + additional requirements)
- Beyond the requirements of the UNFCCC, some countries may also have additional goals for their safeguards approach





2. Mongolia's national safeguards approach





Safeguards in the UN-REDD Mongolia National Programme

- Safeguards are a cross-cutting issue across the National Programme
- Two key outputs:
 - REDD+ social and environmental safeguard policy framework developed
 - Safeguards Information system (SIS) established
- So how can we achieve these two outputs?





Proposed **goals & scope** of Mongolia's national safeguards approach (2017):

Safeguards goals: to meet UNFCCC Cancun safeguards requirements, with reference to requirements for key climate finance initiatives relevant to Mongolia, such as the safeguards used by the Green Climate Fund.

Safeguards scope: to apply to all REDD+ activities and PAMs in the National REDD+ Strategy, taking into account its multiple objectives for climate change mitigation, adaptation to climate change, and support for 'green development'.

- Based on benefits, risks and PLRs relevant to country, as well as on clarification and objectives for SIS
- Information needs what specific information is needed to demonstrate appropriate PLRs are in place (addressing safeguards) and are being adequately implemented (respecting safeguards);
- Information structure how will the identified information be aggregated and organised in the SIS?

5. Review existing information systems and sources

- Assess what information is already available to show that Mongolia is addressing/respecting safeguards, and identify gaps
- Help to link to and build on existing information systems
- Help to identify sources of information and gaps
- Help to understand possible structure and institutions to involve







- Based on goals, information needs & structure, and existing systems
- Determine desired functions and institutional arrangements, and develop options for design of SIS
- ir Discuss/validate proposed SIS with stakeholders and relevant institutions
