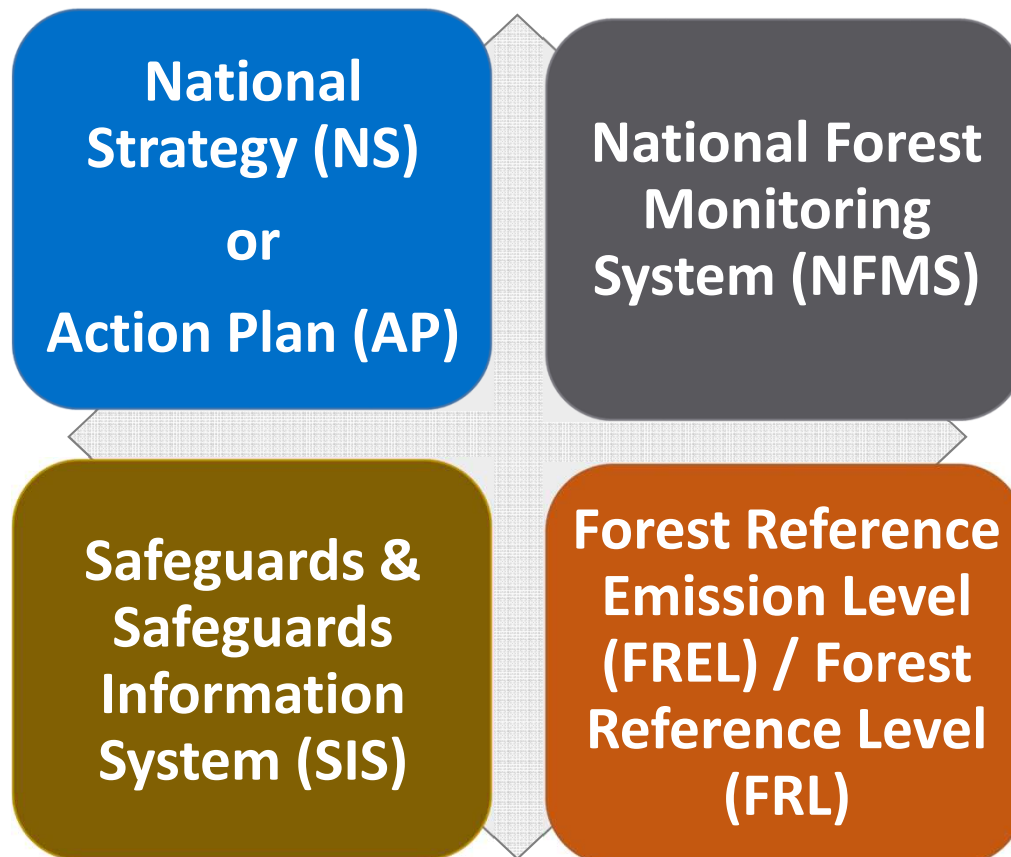

The Four REDD+ “Design” Elements



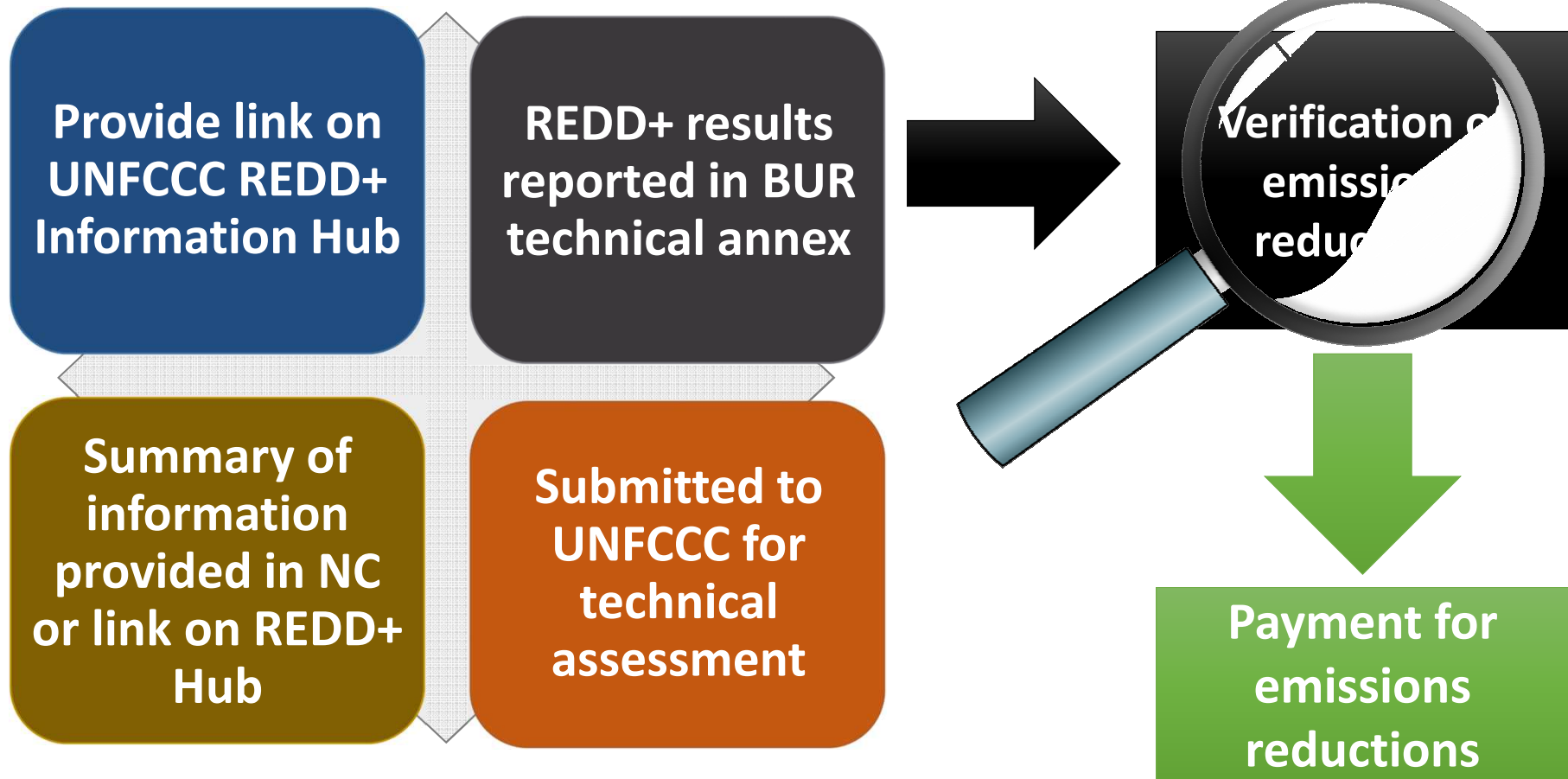
SCALE

The REDD- Web Platform, mandated by the COP in decision 2/CP.13, was established with the purpose of making available such information on the outcomes of activities relating to REDD-, including activities on capacity building, demonstration activities, addressing drivers of deforestation and mobilization of resources.

Since the launch of the REDD- Web Platform after COP 13, both the COP and the *Subsidiary Body for Scientific and Technological Advice (SBSTA)* have recognized the Platform as a useful tool and have mandated additional functions to be incorporated.
