Sri Lanka's Integrated REDD+ Finance and Action Planning



- Analysis of barriers & opportunities

- Forest emission reference level (FREL)/Forest reference level (FRL)

- Specific interventions to remove barriers & capitalise on opportunities

- Identifying & addressing risks
- Estimation of carbon & NBCs
- Methods to monitor, measure & report results
- Refining and detailing PAMs

- Integrating PAMs into national budgets/dev assistance
- Strategies to fill financial gaps
- Linkages with other sectors
- National ownership, avoid duplication

Drivers, Vision and Potential Policies and Measures (PAMs)

- **4 main drivers of D&D** - encroachment, infrastructure, commercial agriculture, localized drivers of degradation
- Sri Lanka's REDD+ Vision - more emphasis on cross-sectoral sustainable development

“Forests and beyond, sustaining lives and livelihoods in a greener Sri Lanka”

- **24 preliminary policies and 39 preliminary measures** to address drivers of D&D and barriers to forest enhancement
- PAMs cover a wide range, suggesting **an inter-sectoral approach**



Initial Prioritisation of PAMs

- A set of **44 prioritization criteria** were identified to narrow down a list of PAMs - identified through a consultative process (i.e. CSOs, IPs, academics, private sector, government)
- Criteria build on to **national priorities**, on **Cancun safeguards**, on potential to deliver **carbon impact and non-carbon benefits**, to ensure **feasibility** and **national ownership**.
- Each criterion was given a **weight by different interest groups**
- Multi-criteria scoring of candidate PAMs by 70+ participants – including 44 individuals from the five hotspots



Further Prioritizations & Detailing out PAMs

PLRs, Tenure, Safeg. & NCBs analysis of prioritised PAMs

- Assess technical topics/ implementation status against prioritized PAMs
- Refined or new PAMs

Profiling of PAMs

- Costing & timeframe
- Institutional roles/responsibility
- Impacts (carbon & NCBs)
- Risks & safeguards

Final prioritization of PAMs

- Carbon impact
- NCBs
- Institutional feasibility
- Acceptance on the ground

Integrated financing plan

- Inter-sectoral action planning
- Led by Ministry of Environment (w. Ministry of Finance)

Result: 22 PAMs selected , detailed and categorised into three key groups

1. Forest, Wildlife & Watershed
2. Land Use Planning
3. Other Forested Lands

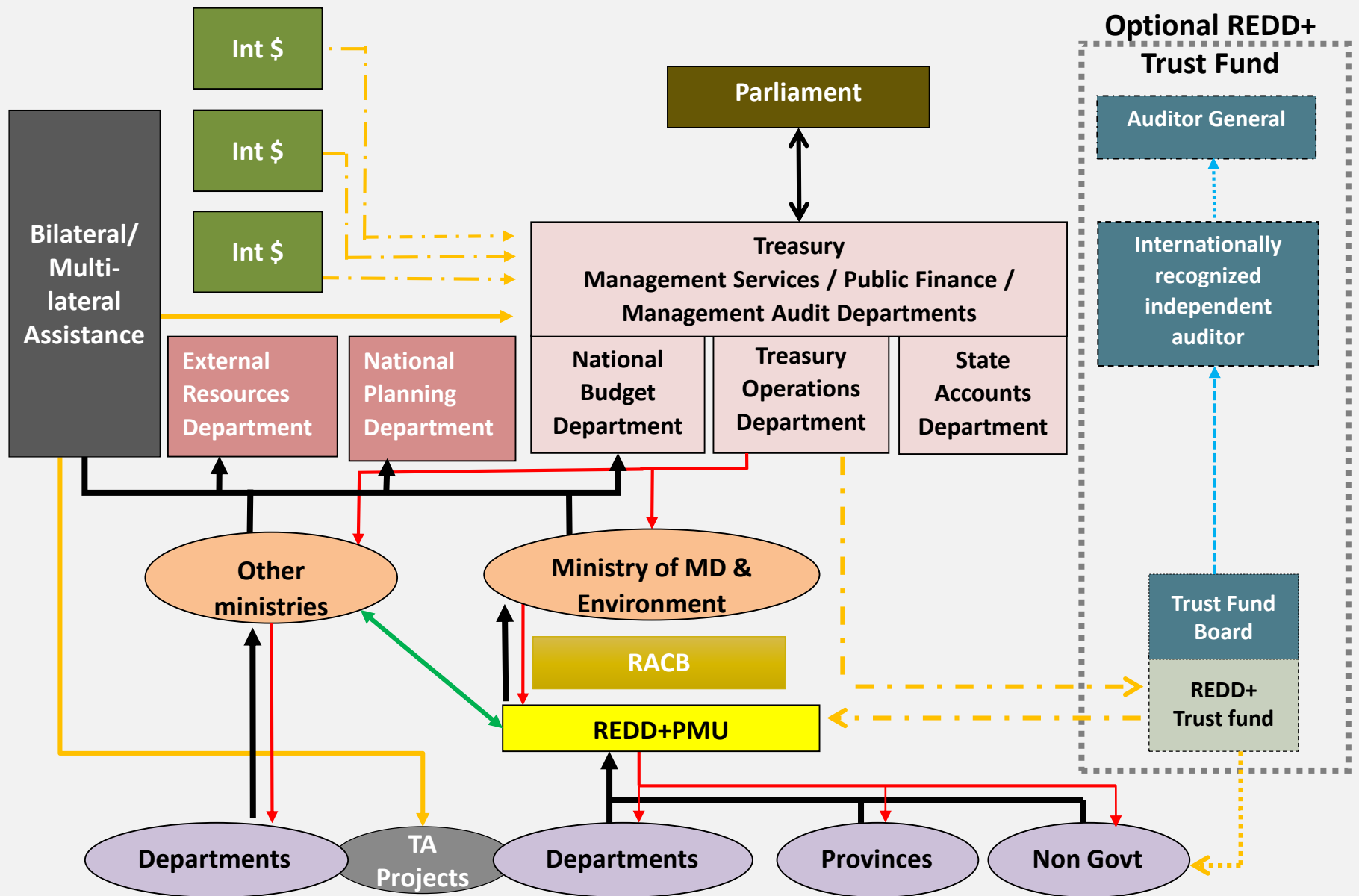
PAM1: Forest boundaries survey, demarcation and declaration to appropriate categories		
Cost	Rs 70,000,000 /yr over 3 yrs	
Description	Overall goal	Protection of forests with no clear boundary demarcation established by natural and artificial means
	Outcomes	Forest land boundary identified, surveyed, demarcated and declared
	Coordinating agency	Forest department with Wildlife Conservation Department
PAM Targets	250 km of forest boundary demarcated in the North/Western Province over 3 years (approx. 500,000 ha. of forest land) GHG emission reduction target: 150,000 tCO ₂ eq/yr. GHG removal target:100,000 tCO ₂ eq/yr.
