# Project Information

## Expected Output from Entire CRA Project

1. REDD-plus Corruption Risk Assessment Tool
2. Final Report
  - a. Prioritized list of corruption risks in REDD-plus in the Philippines;
  - b. Proposed measures to mitigate short, medium and long-term risks;
  - c. Preliminary budget and identified responsibilities for implementation of aforementioned measures; and
  - d. Extracting lessons that may be applicable in other countries.

The focus of this project is on **corruption**, **NOT** wholesale governance.

# Stage One: Stocktaking

Gathering data on corruption risks in relation to REDD-Plus in the Philippines, through interviews, workshops and consultations.

- Desk Review
- Key Informant Interviews
- Focus Group Discussions
- Workshops

Viewed from the lens of the PNRPS.

Names/identities of informants will not be disclosed unless given permission to do so.

## Stage Two: Policy and Institutional Analysis

Data gathered from stocktaking activities shall be analyzed and clustered based on underlying trends and policy or institutional implications.

- Expert group discussions and consultations
- Completion and dissemination of first report, to elicit feedback and comments from stakeholders
  - Target date: November 15
  - Due date (feedback, etc.): November 29
- Evaluation of methodology

## Stage Three: Corruption Risk Analysis

Based on results of step 2, the tool applied will be adjusted accordingly, resulting in a crystallized and nationally-owned corruption risk assessment tool.

- Validation of the tool through workshops in early 2013
- Use the tool to establish set criteria for the determination of a prioritized list of corruption risks

# Stage Four: Recommendations

Drafting of the final report incorporating the following:

- workshop results and validated tool
- prioritized list of corruption risks
- proposed budget
- proposed measures
- identified responsibilities for implementation
- lessons that may be applicable to other countries
