UN-REDD

- Launched in September 2008.
- Collaborative initiative between there UN agencies (FAO, UNDP, UNEP).
- Objectives:
 - Assisting developing countries to "get ready" for participation in a future REDD mechanism.
 - Supporting the development of guidance and standardized approaches based ion sound science.
- Pilot countries.
