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Fiji REDD Plus Activities

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Population: 896,758) as of 2013.

322 islands and over 500 small islets. Around 110 are inhabited,

87% of the population lives on the two biggest islands Viti Levu and Vanua Levu.

The islands are spread over 194,000 km² of which 18,270 km² (less than 10%)

Major industries are tourism and sugar. Exports also include garments, gold, timber and fish.







Fiji REDD+ Milestones

- 2009 Fiji REDD Plus Scoping Study
- 2009 ongoing: Wide awareness-raising and training for involved sectors and local communities & Training of relevant technical officers in technical areas
- **2010**: Endorsement of Fiji National REDD+ Policy (developed through extensive stakeholder consultation); Establishment of First Project Site (7,000 ha)
- **2011**: Formalisation of the Fiji REDD+ Steering Committee an official body, with multi-sectoral membership, to guide and monitor REDD+ activities in the country; Establishment of Second Project Site (2,000 ha)
- Inclusion of carbon measurements in Fiji PSP data collection



Fiji REDD+ Milestones

- 2011: Carbon financing and formal approval process for forest carbon projects added into draft Forest Decree
- 2011–2012: Calculation of Fiji carbon stock and forest cover change; including staff capacity building
- 2011-2013 Drafting of the National REDD+ Strategy through multistakeholder consultation process
- **2012** The Government of Fiji provides capital funding of FJD 300,000/year for REDD+ preparedness activities.
- 2013 Fiji Presents R-PP at the FCPF Participants Committee; Consultation on carbon rights
- **2014** Signing of the FCPF Agreement for funding of Fiji REDD Plus Readiness Activities (US\$3.8m) for 4 years.
- Fiji Accepted as UNREDD Program Partner Country

REDD+ Activities:


- a) Development of a National REDD Strategy
- b) At least one carbon/climate related contract arising from a pilot project
- c) Assessment of historical changes in forest carbon at the national level for the establishment of the national reference level.
- d) Design and implement national forest carbon monitoring programme
- e) Establishment of legal and institutional infrastructures associated with REDD+.
- f) Independent, external, expert third party review of the Fiji REDD+ Programme

ackling the drivers of deforestation and forest degradation

- For Fiji to successfully undertake REDD+, the country will need to:
 - address drivers of deforestation and forest degradation, and
 - promote drivers of forest expansion and conservation.
- The 3 main forms of deforestation in Fiji are:
 - Agriculture clearance
 - Infrastructure development
 - Settlement establishment
- The 2 main forms of forest degradation are:
 - Selective logging
 - Bushfires



Fiji National REDD+ Programme

- Driven by government and stakeholders, and follow international guidelines and standards.
- Began in 2009, and its activities are guided by the National REDD+ Policy, the National Climate Change Policy and the draft National REDD+ Strategy.
- The Ministry of Fisheries and Forests is the lead agency for the National REDD+ Programme and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation is the national climate change lead agency and political focal point.
