
- Support requested by Norway & UK through CBFF to develop national M&MRV systems with a regional approach together with COMIFAC;

Guiding Activities (National)


- Five overarching 'guiding' activities with sub-activities:




Quick Start Phase: Operationalisation

Components

- Total: € 6,157,127 sub-divided as follows:
 - For the seven countries that do not have an R-PP:
 - € 425,575 per country;
