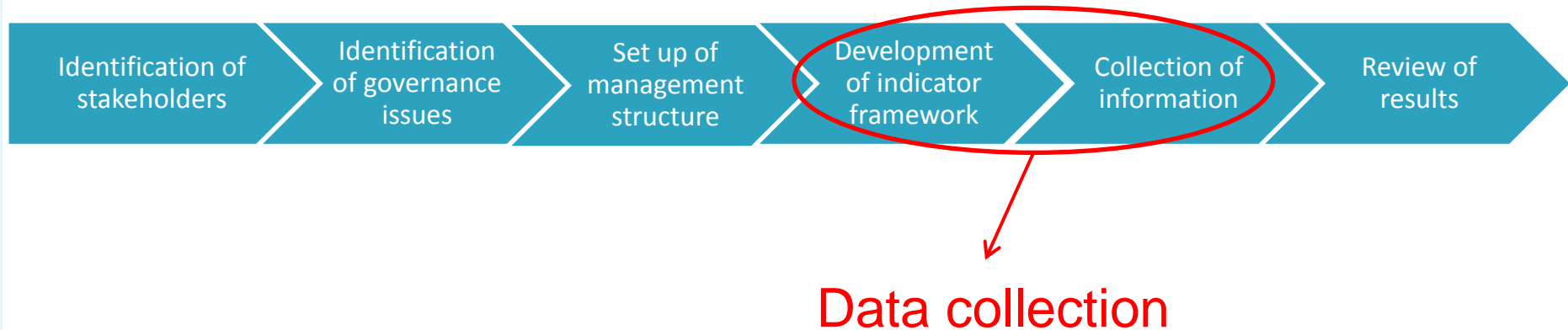

Data collection in the PGA



- Defining indicators, developing indicator frameworks, identifying verifiers, mapping data sources, selecting data collection methods, etc.



FAO's experience in forest data collection

- Global Forest Resources Assessment (FRA) – collating forest data from 200+ countries
- National Forest Monitoring & Assessment Programme – support countries to update, expand and manage forest information
- FAO-WB Framework for Assessing and Monitoring Forest Governance



Support to PGA pilots

- Technical input on data collection aspects
- Indicator training workshop
 - Indonesia, January 2012
 - Vietnam, August 2012
 - Nigeria & Ecuador coming next
- Based on first experience in Indonesia – exploring options to support the collection of information in the PGAs
- Collaborative process (UN-REDD, FAO, WB, ACP-FLEGT, WRI, FERN, etc.) to develop international guidance on data collection
