Access

- Any body or agency, whether national or international, governmental or non-governmental UNFCCC registered
- Co-chairs shall be informed
- No objection by at least one third of Partners
- Co-chairs shall decide on closed sessions under the direction of Partners

Participation

- Invitation from Co-chairs
- Opportunity to briefly address Partners at the meeting
- No objection by at least one third of Partners
- Observers status

Notification and nomination

- Co-chairs shall notify entitled observers of the date and venue of any meeting of the REDD+ Partnership
- Nominations limited to maximum 2 for each body or agency

Attendance

- Co-chairs in consultation with the host country (venue capacity) shall determine the number of participants
- Aiming to foster an effective working environment with an appropriate balance of participants
- Balanced geographic and perspective representation is encouraged
- Co-chairs shall notify the necessary information on the meeting to the stakeholders and in the event of limited venue capacity request them to select their representative attendants taking into account geographic and perspective balance.
