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Why engaging parliaments and MPs in REDE

- Parliament has a key role to play in mitigation of and adaptation to climate change.
- Parliament sets the development vision of a country, promoting renewable energy, energy efficiency, forest conservation or new agricultural methods
- New legislation needed. Legislation, and new budget priorities, must be approved by Members of Parliament.

Parliament: 3 key roles



- Legislative role
- Parliamentary oversight (approves budget, monitors government)
- Representative role (channels views of population)
