A new priority for 2014: NATIONAL REDD+ STRATEGIES

- *A lesson:* Fragmented dynamics in national REDD+ processes
- Weak attention to REDD+ strategies so far: good examples (DRC) but wrong cases (Tanzania); need to offer methodological guidance

→ REDD+ strategies to be the <u>anchor</u> & <u>glue</u> for national REDD+ processes

- Right timing in the UNFCCC context
- <u>UNDP</u> is best placed {and ready} to coordinate this new work:

e.g. large experience in building national development policy, CO work, GEF/UNDP portfolio, governance and capacity-building background

- REDD+ strategies will enable countries to adapt UNFCCC agreements to <u>country circumstances/intentions</u> [*i.e.* what REDD+ means for a country ?]
- \rightarrow UNDP will provide more focused support to countries in considering their strategic options

A perennial priority: COUNTRY IMPLEMENTATION

- Three major UN-REDD implementation <u>modalities</u>: NPs, TS and Tier-2
 - → Yet a single objective: to sustain national REDD+ processes, ensuring <u>coherence</u> of actions and their right <u>sequence</u>
- Issue: UN-REDD's country delivery mechanisms are often <u>used to</u> service the agencies' interests
- Lesson: fragmented actions, "parashooting" of activities, excess "workshopping"
- Need of a close accompanying/guiding to country stakeholders
- Careful planning, with coherence and a right sequence of actions
- Ensure country implementation focuses on the two pillars of REDD+:
 - REDD+ Strategy
 - MRV System
- Country implementation also allows innovation and demonstration

The way forward: PROPOSAL FOR THE UNEP/REDD+ TEAM

- UNEP's expertise and work domains are indispensable to build national REDD+ strategies
- UNDP wishes to closely collaborate with UNEP in this new priority of supporting <u>national REDD+ strategies</u>:
 - → UNEP's leading work on the green economy, modeling and multiple benefits shall inform the definition and assessment of the strategic options for REDD+ in countries
- Crucial need to help governments to <u>sequence actions</u> in their REDD+ processes and in their building of REDD+ strategies
- Adapt technical-assistance and TS to the genuine <u>country needs</u>, while ensuring we all support a right sequence of actions
