Background

REDD+ is one of the many options to mitigate Climate Change.

Overall benefits doing REDD+:

- Enhances protection of natural ecosystem (PNG has a very rich flora and fauna in the world);
- Enhances sustainable forestry resource management (through proper land use planning and management);
- Potential income earning opportunity (through international carbon market); and
- Enhances sustainable development.

Background

Australia Forest Carbon Partnership:

- Strategic Policy Dialogue on REDD;
- Forest Carbon Monitoring & Measurement (MRV); and

Participation in Global Carbon Markets.

Activities funded to date

Past Activities

- Technical Assistance to PNG FA and OCCD (2009 – 2010); and
- General Capacity Building Support to PNG workshops on MRV and REDD, and REDD study tour of GoPNG officials to Indonesia (2010 – 2011).

Activities funded to date

Current Activities

- Village / Community REDD+ Demonstration project in Manus (May 2012 June 2014). Project implemented by Wildlife Conservation Society (WCS);
- Village / Community REDD+ Demonstration project in Madang – Adelbert Range (May 2013 – December 2014). Project implemented by The Nature Conservation Society (TNC); and
- Supporting UNREDD program 2013 Annual Work Plan (AWP) outcomes – REDD+ Readiness.

Total Expenditure

\$3.8 million has been expensed to date for all the activities.

Future Support

- AusAID is about to start designing a new Disaster, Environment and Climate Change Risks Management program (PNG).
- All key Stakeholders will be consulted during the design process.
