- South-South exchange on national fund design currently involving 6 countries: Brazil, Colombia, DRC, Ethiopia, Indonesia and Viet Nam.

- Increasingly focused on results: output achievements.
- New section "opportunities and challenges".
- Financial report at output level and per SNA category of support.









### Boosting and backstopping NFMS and clarifying M/MRV

- Report National Forest Monitoring Systems: M&MRV in the context of REDD+.
- Enhanced NFMS and MRV capacity in 20 countries through sharing experiences (South-to-South) and technical support on remote sensing and forest monitoring.
- Regional databases on tree allometric equation.
- Strengthened GHG inventory capacity.

### REDD+ legal frameworks, policies and measures

 Argentina, DRC, Ecuador, Guatemala, Kenya, Mexico, Paraguay and Peru.

### Increase in awareness of the risks of corruption in REDD+

### **National Programmes - key figures**

- 16 partner countries allocated a total of US\$ 67.4 M for National Programmes (NPs)→ US\$ 57.1 M transferred
- 3 countries held inception workshops and started implementing activities
  - Nigeria-October 2012
  - Congo- January 2013
  - Sri Lanka-June 2013
- 2 partner countries completed operations
  - Viet Nam- June 2012
  - Indonesia- October 2012 (the Philippines –April 2013)
- First final independent evaluation completed for Viet Nam's NPphase 1 (Session 3) and tasked for Indonesia's NP









## NP achievements - Readiness management arrangements and stakeholder consultations

- Capacity development and consultation activities on REDD+ at national and provincial/state levels in DRC, Ecuador, Nigeria, PNG, Paraguay, the Philippines, Tanzania and Zambia
- 2. Coordination structures established in Cambodia, PNG and the Solomon Islands
- 3. Formal coordination with other initiatives established & inter-ministerial agreements for REDD+ in Ecuador and Zambia











### NP achievements -Readiness management arrangements and stakeholder consultations, cont.

- 4. Participation mechanisms defined in Cambodia, the Philippines, Ecuador, Paraguay, and Zambia
- 5. Mid-term review conducted in DRC and Tanzania
- 6. Stakeholder engagement in Nigeria, Paraguay, Solomon Islands and technical networks established in PNG











## NP achievements - National REDD+ strategies

- 1. A REDD+ registry and National REDD+ framework strategy established in DRC
- 2. Guidelines for a REDD+ registration system completed in Ecuador
- 3. National REDD+ fund established and signed in DRC
- 4. Ministerial resolution for forest conservation approved in Paraguay
- 5. Study for estimating cost-elements for REDD+ completed for Tanzania









### NP achievements - NFMS & RLs



- 1. Capacities for NFIs, remote sensing, GHG inv. developed in nine countries
- 2. Drivers of deforestation and forest degradation assessed for DRC and Tanzania
- 3. NFMs and web-based portals and video developed for DRC
- 4. Forest cover maps and deforestation models completed in Panama
- 5. Half of the plots for the NFI sampled in Ecuador















- 1. Safeguards framework and guidelines prepared in the Philippines
- Capacity development and consultations for SESs and safeguards in Ecuador, Tanzania and Paraguay











### National Programmes – key messages

- NP activities are instrumental in supporting coordination of readiness activities → synergies and increasing cost-effectiveness of other interventions
- Delivery rates have improved in NPs, along with a growing understanding of the complexity and time needed
- When countries and the Programme acknowledge and assimilate these, results are realized → flexibility key is for sustainability of the readiness process
