
Reduced emissions - REDD revenue




REDD+

- 50% of tropical deforestation caused by subsistence farmers
- Deforestation will stop when farmers have a future
- Future = employment and equity in planted forests and industries
- Planted forests protect remaining native forest
- Sulbar Habitat:
 - Forests and people of Sulawesi Barat
 - Profitable timber plantations, wood products and biomass electricity
- Based on REDD+ principles
- Not based on REDD+ revenue

 - Will it damage my brand?


Rewards
