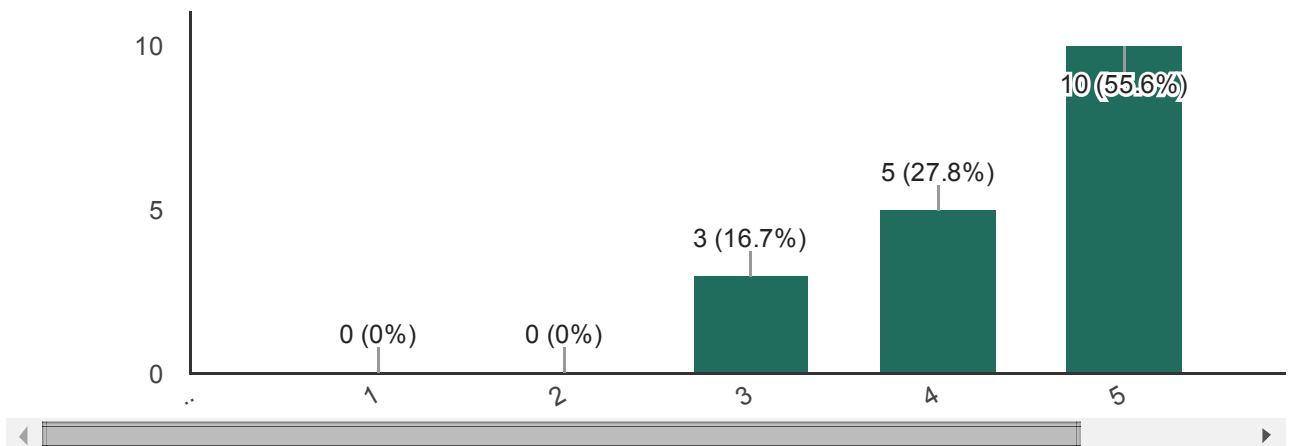

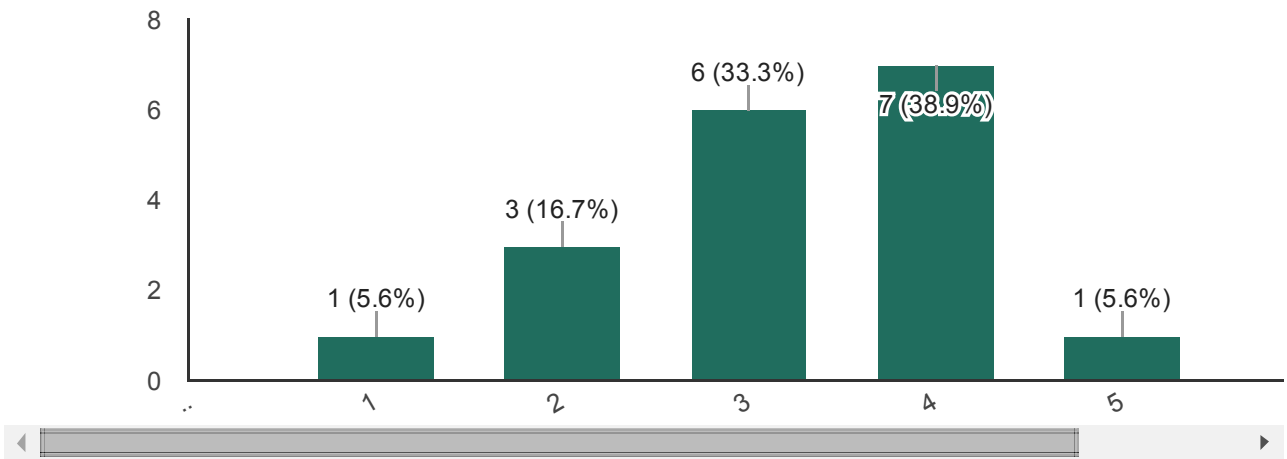

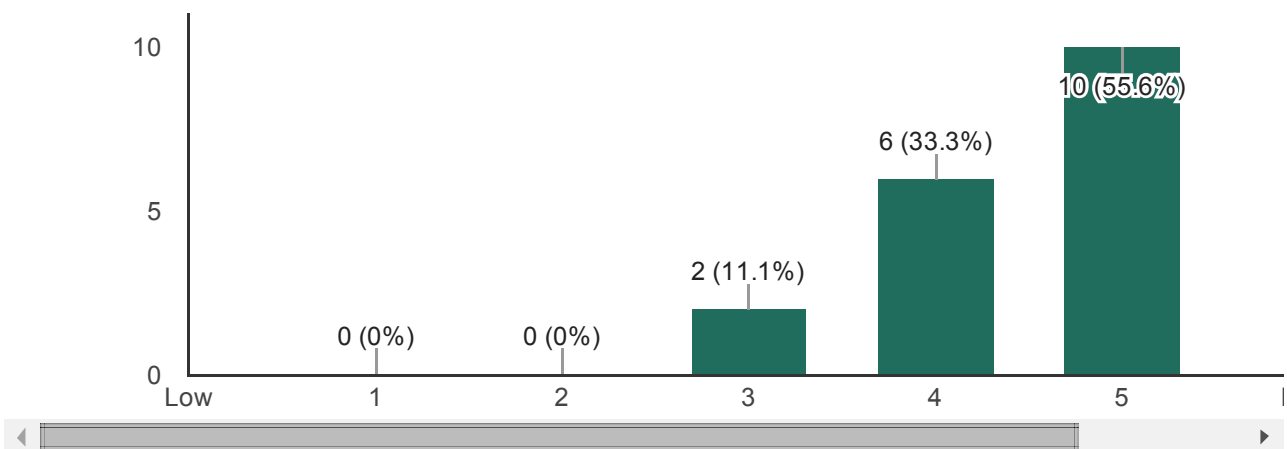

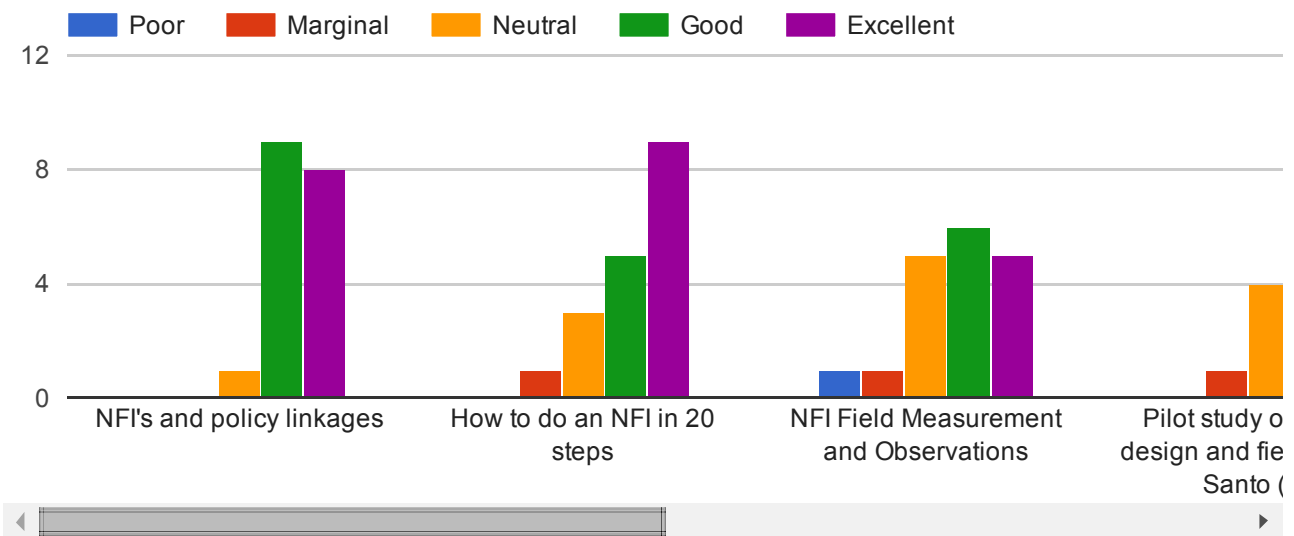

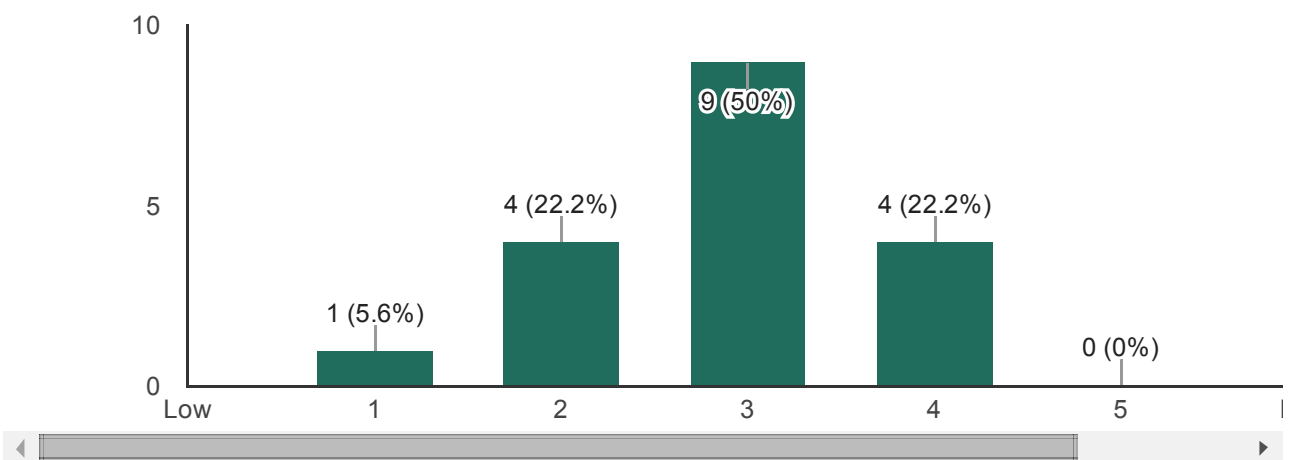

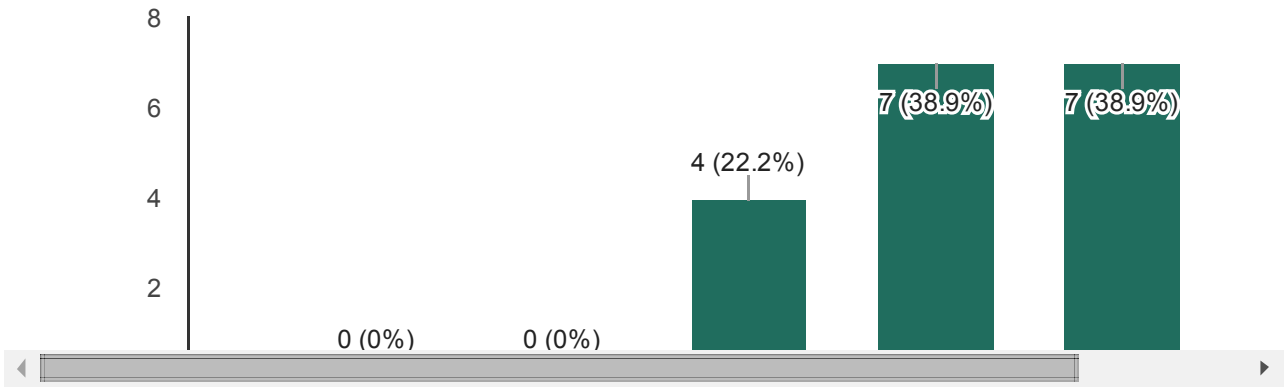
8a. How would you rate your level of knowledge on the NFI's and policy linkages, BEFORE attending the workshop?

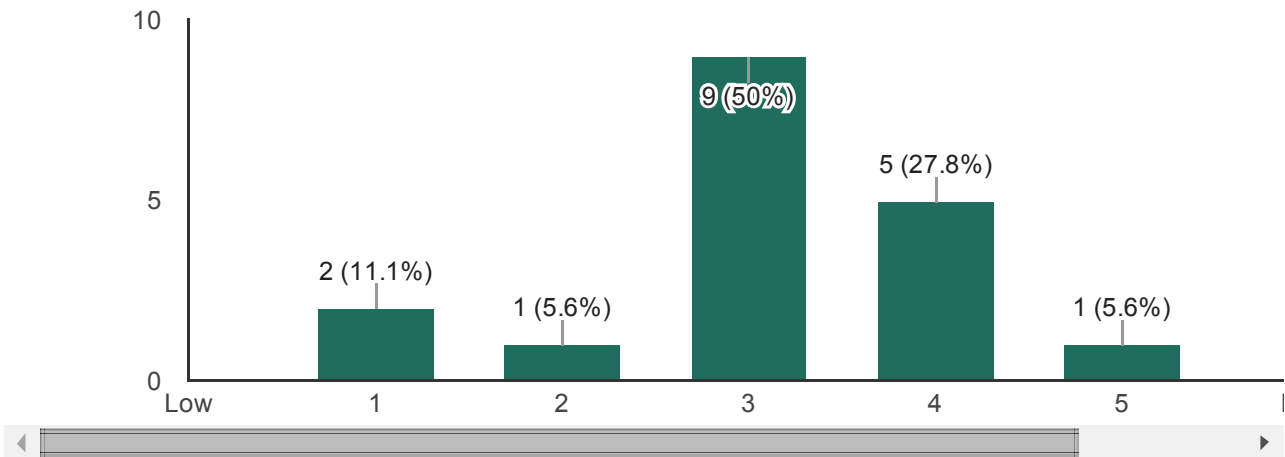
8b. How would you rate your level of knowledge on the NFI's and policy linkages, AFTER attending the workshop?

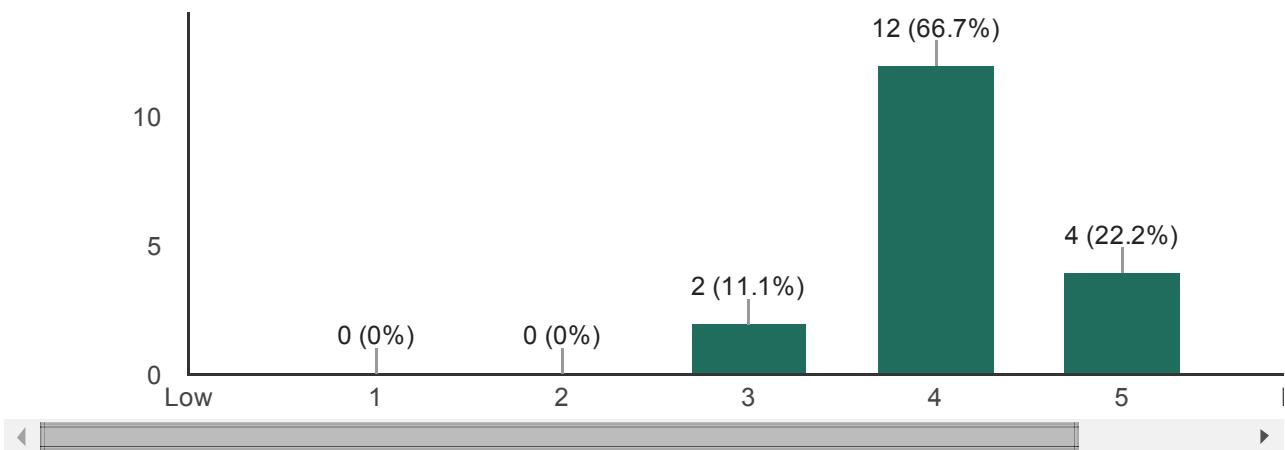
9a. How would you rate your level of knowledge on the how to do an NFI BEFORE attending the workshop?

9b. How would you rate your level of knowledge on the how to do an NFI AFTER attending the workshop?

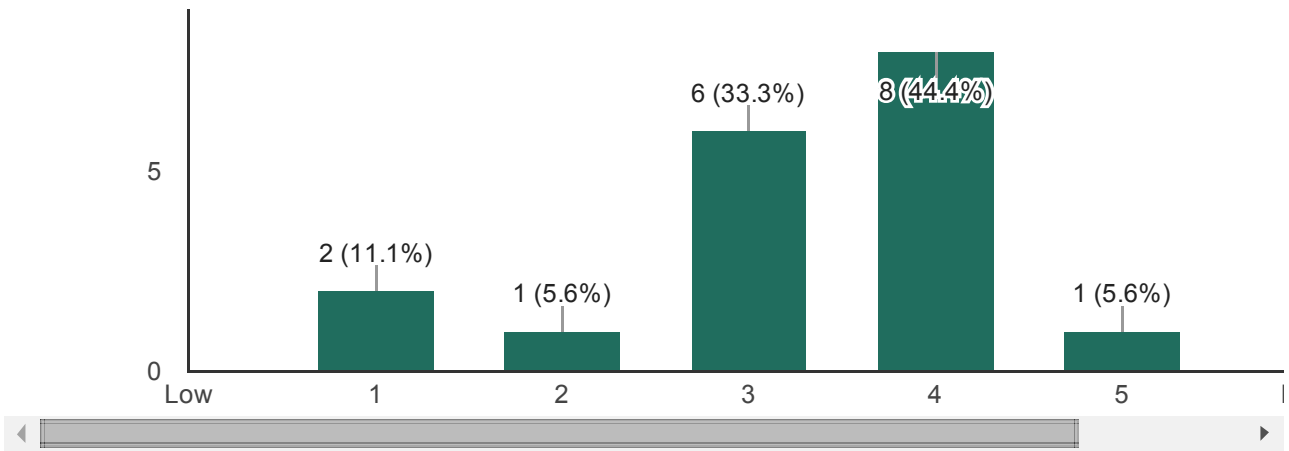

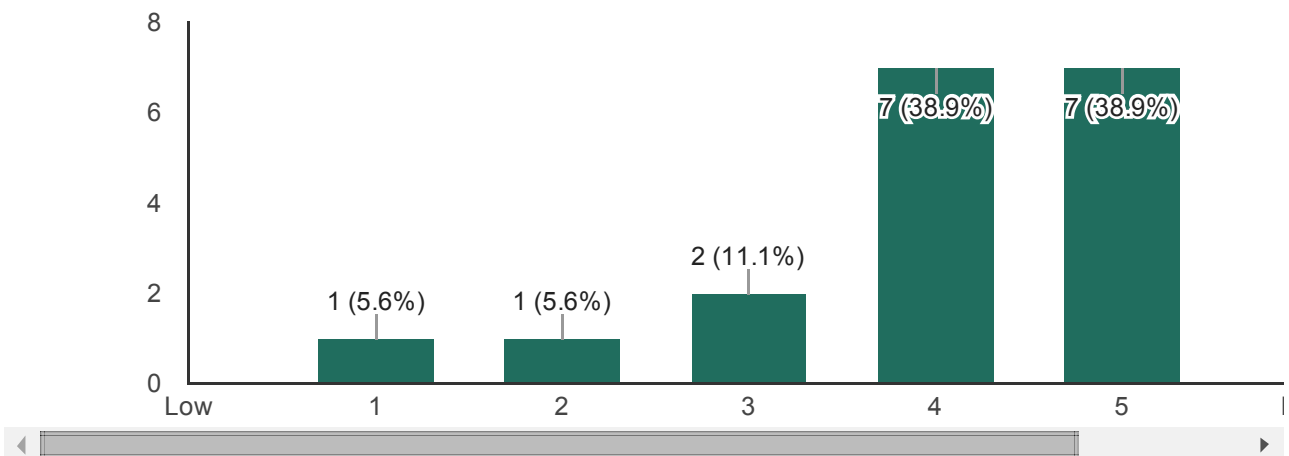

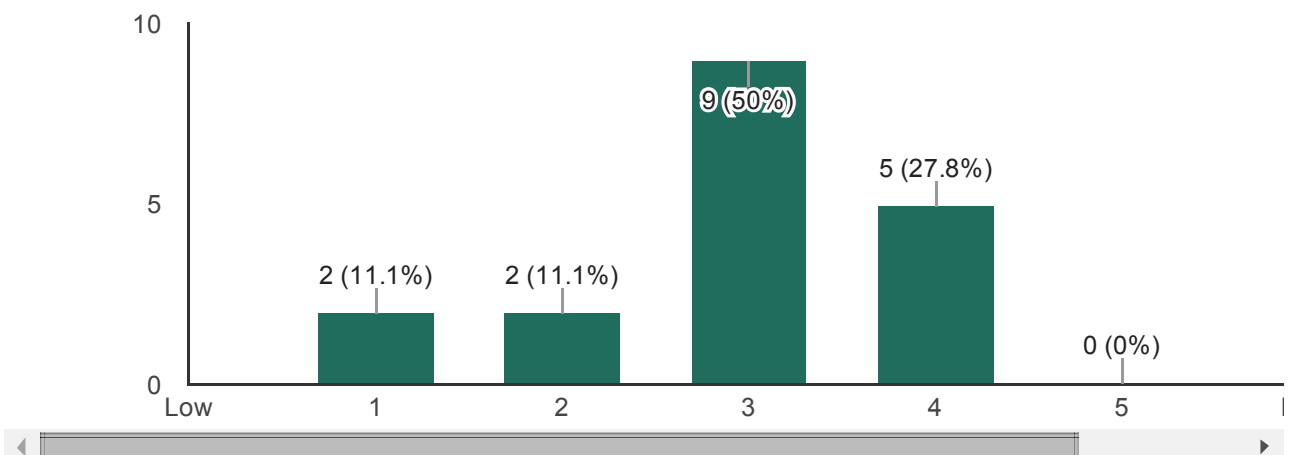
10b. How would you rate your level of knowledge on NFI Field Measurement and Observations AFTER the workshop?

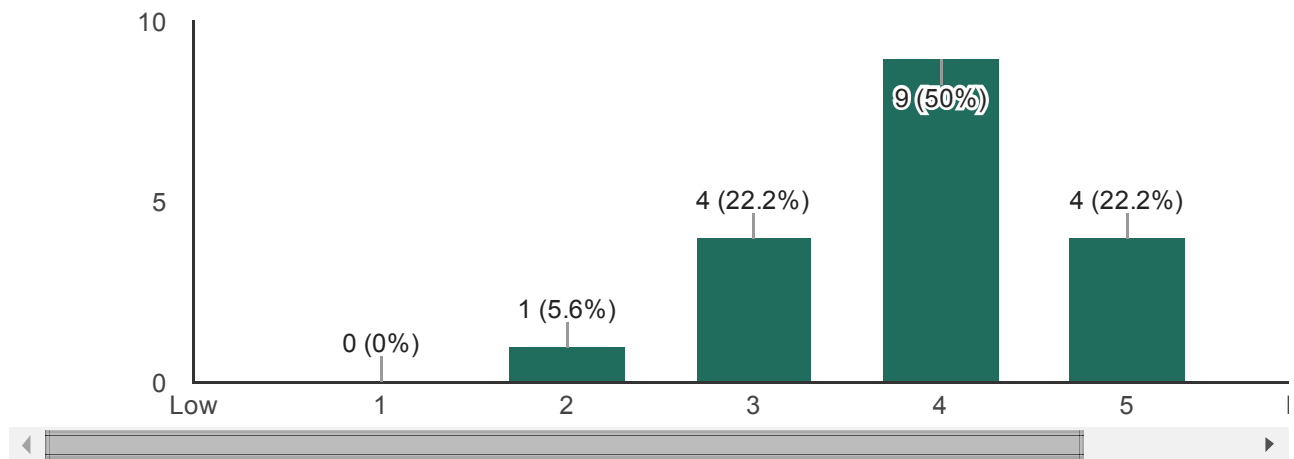
11a. How would you rate your level of knowledge on Data collection through interviews BEFORE attending the workshop?

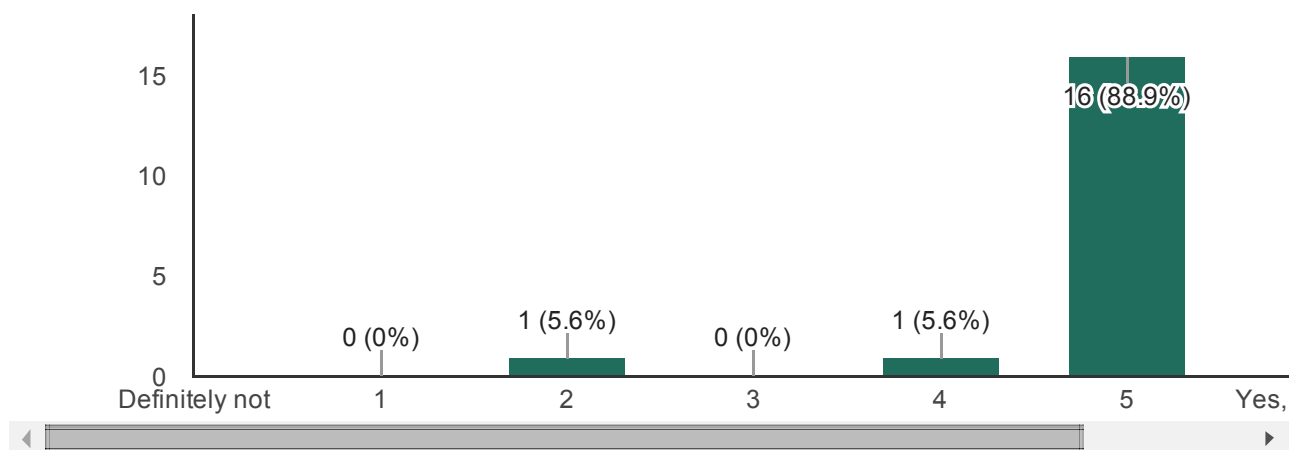

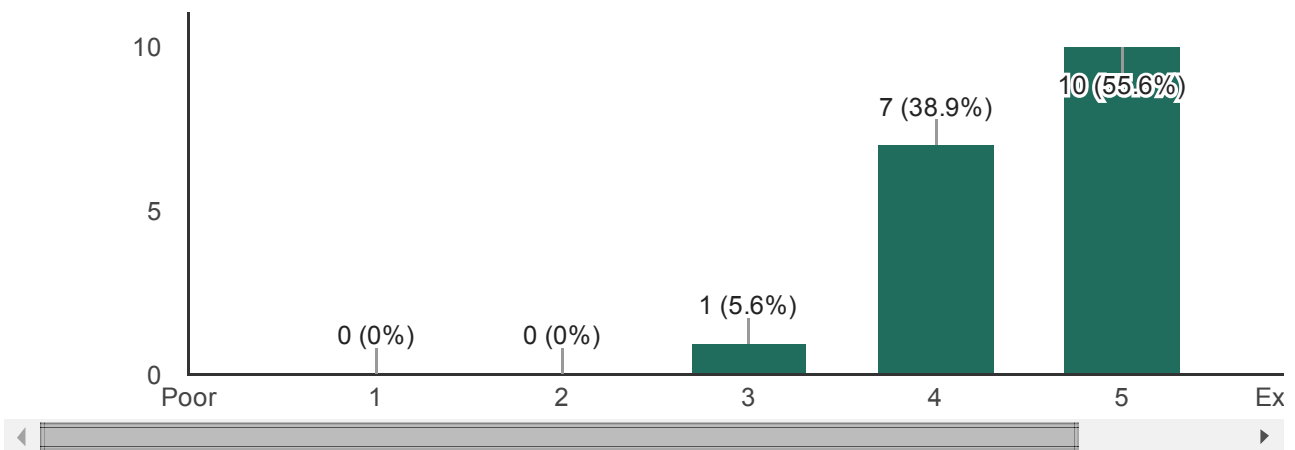
