Concept note For National Consultation Workshop on CSOs and IP Engagement in National REDD+ Strategy Development

1. Introduction

The Royal Government of Cambodia through the Forestry Administration acknowledge REDD+ Mechanism for the protection of natural forest in Cambodia through the commitment of the REDD+ Roadmap development/Readiness Preparation Proposal (R-PP) last year. According to its R-PP, the RGC, through FA will implement the R-PP to develop its "Cambodian National REDD+ Strategy" during the period from 2012-2015.

The government is on the process to develop its National REDD+ Strategy which will require the participation and engagement from relevant CSOs and IPs in Cambodia in this process. Some of the Cambodian CSOs and IPs have been involved with the FA through meetings and consultations on the REDD Roadmap development since late 2010.

Following a workshop in the early February 2012 with key representatives from civil society and indigenous people's networks and organisations, a process was agreed to select initial representatives from these groups to represent in the National REDD+ Programme – the Program Executive Board, REDD+ Consultation Group and the initial technical teams.

Therefore, some members of the NGO Forum on Cambodia in collaboration with the Cambodia National REDD+ Programme have proposed and will organize a workshop on "CSOs and IP **Engagement in National REDD+ Strategy Development**" in order to select initial representatives and have effective engagement in this national program process.

2. Objectives

The objectives of this workshop are to:

- Provide awareness raising to relevant CSOs and IPs on REDD+, REDD+ Roadmap.
- Provide some experience of REDD+ strategy development from regional and international NGOs/CSOs.
- Share information, experience and challenges from different CSOs and IPs of their initiatives in relation to REDD+ implementation from international and national contexts.
- Explore and discuss on how CSOs and IPs involvement in the development of National REDD+ Strategy.
- Select interim CSOs and IP representatives to the REDD+ Consultation Group, the Program Executive Board and the initial technical teams to be formed under the National REDD+ program.

3. Expected Output

The National Consultation Workshop will be for three days and will invite around 90 participants from national and international organizations, civil societies and indigenous people. The expected results from this consultation workshop include:

- The participants have gained knowledge and experience via information sharing, lessons learnt related to the REDD+ mechanism and strategy development processes.
- Civil society groups and indigenous people understand government management arrangements and CSOs engagements.

- The representatives are selected to represent in the national REDD+ program.
