The TdRs for an environmental economist and GIS specialist have been already developed jointly with IDEAM, the national counterpart. It has been agreed that during the second semester of 2015 UNEP and IDEAM will define the methodology to be applied in these studies. IDEAM has been keen to invest time in discussing methods and data before launching the studies. UNEP is supporting the country on that. We understand this process as part of capacity building and we will strive to regain time later during the study.	The process of defining methods, though important, may take longer than expected. IDEAM has informed it wants to be fully comfortable with method before proceeding.
