### Stakeholder Mapping

- Accurate assessment of stakeholders underpins:
  - Effective consultation
  - Awareness raising programme
  - Capacity Building needs assessment
- Based on analysis of:
  - Influence
  - Interest and motivation in REDD+
  - Potential roles in REDD+
  - Scale of action (local to national) REDD







### **Consultation Processes**

- Initiate formation of REDD+ Stakeholders' Forum (RSF)
  - Key multi-stakeholder advisory body within the REDD+ management structure
  - Ensure accountability of REDD+ decision-making to all stakeholders
  - Starting point for all consultation processes under REDD+
- Safeguards WG will facilitate launch of RSF in March 2012 UN-REDE







### Review of Materials

- Initial stage of Awareness Raising Programme
- Review REDD+ materials from:
  - UN-REDD, REDD-net, RECOFTC,
    CIFOR, ForestCarbon Asia, others
- Facilitate translation and adaptation to Bangladesh context











# Process for Free, Prior and Informed Consent (FPIC)

- A key element of REDD+ Social Safeguards
- Ensuring customary forest tenure and use rights are upheld
- The right to FPIC for indigenous peoples and all forest-dependent communities; no activities related to REDD+ which will affect their tenure and use of forest resources without their consent
- Using customary decision-making systems (Matbars, Headmen), linking these systems to REDD+ management structure

PROGRAMME

Establish a process of continuous communication and negotiation



### Grievance Mechanism



Village Courts

**Local Commissions** 

- Dispute resolved: report to Local commissions
- Dispute unresolved: refer to Local commissions



- Conduit between Village Courts and Special Court
- Consist of 3 tiers of local elected representatives



• In parallel with an Independent National Commission on Environmental Issues







## REDD+ Social and Environmental Standards (SES)



 System of verifying performance against S+E Safeguards under Cancun Agreements



 Developed by southern civil society groups with support of CCBA and CARE International



 Key source for UN-REDD Social and Environmental P&C and other guidelines











### Principles for REDD+ SES

- International SES Principles and Criteria cover 'doing no harm' and 'doing more good':
  - 1. Rights to land are respected
  - 2. Benefits are shared equitably
  - 3. REDD+ improves long-term livelihood security
  - 4. Contribute to broad sustainable development and good governance
  - 5. Maintains and enhances biodiversity
  - 6. Full and effective participation
  - 7. FPIC
  - 8. Compliance with local, national and international laws and obligations











### National indicators for REDD+ SES

- Principles and Criteria are standard internationally; Indicators must be developed for national context
- Safeguards WG will develop draft indicators
- Two rounds of full multi-stakeholder consultation to finalise indicators
- Development of a SES monitoring plan based on indicators
- Draw on experience from Indonesia and Nepal
