9. Brief summary of the mission
This provincial consultation workshop aimed to **a)** present the findings of the ICA; **b)** discuss the overall governance situation - what has and has not worked to identify shortcomings at the Lam Dong level, and **c)** ultimately agree on set of priority governance issues that the PGA in Vietnam should cover. Workshop participants were CSO and community representatives, government staff (both from the federal and state level), academia and media.

This mission was also an opportunity to discuss with the internal PGA team in Vietnam and agree on the immediate next steps and discuss challenges related to waiting for Phase 2 of Vietnam’s REDD+ process to commence.

9.1 Results achieved (key outputs)

- Preliminary findings from the Institutional and Context Analysis presented and validated
- List of criteria for selection of Advisory Group members for further consultation through stages 2 & 3 of the PGA agreed
- Governance issues which the PGA process in Viet Nam will be covering prioritized and agreed as follows : **a)** Participation in the REDD+ process, **b)** Law enforcement, and **c)** inter-sectorial collaboration
