9. Brief summary of the mission:

As the field of REDD+ has grown substantially in the past five years and continues to evolve, the Programme has grown from supporting nine initial pilot countries to 48 partner countries in Africa, Asia-Pacific and Latin America and Caribbean. The rapid expansion has generated new knowledge and a global network of REDD+ practitioners and the need has arisen to be more systematic in the way that the Programme captures and manages knowledge in an effective way.

The mission looks at four aspects: (1). To discuss further on an in-country event with relevant people, (2). To discuss knowledge management and sharing plans between country and regional offices (with PMU team), (3). To meet staff of some relevant REDD+ initiatives on communications activities and collaboration, (4). To discuss with Communications Officers how to better move forwards with communications activities and strategy

9.a Findings

- To discuss further on an in-country event with relevant people:
 - Met Mr. Phu Hung, his colleagues, and representatives from Viet Nam Forestry University to discuss about how to move forwards with the organisation of in-country event (the REDD+ academy like-concept)
 - Suggestion is the event will look at involving two key potential universities in setting up the process and while the event will be conducted as TOT training with key relevant institutes and universities as participants
 - The process will be carried as in the following steps:
- 1st Step: Identify a Core Working Group and a TOR for the group
- 2nd Step: Development of training arrangements and process, including: development of materials and documents for the training, identification of participants and date of the event, etc.)
- 3rd Step: Organisation of the event
- To discuss knowledge management and sharing plans between country and regional offices (with PMU team and CO)
 - o Presentations on KM and Communications were made to key relevant people, Anders, Mr. Nguyen Thanh Phuong, and the two Communications Officers; and discussion held about KM. Outcomes to be acted on:
- Look at activities of other REDD+ partners to ensure coordination on communications activities and awareness raising activities

- Study and improve the coordination and communications flow between the UN-REDD programme and other initiatives and how to share and work together
- Establish a communications mechanism flow and where UN-REDD programme support staff (Communications Officer(s)) will take an initial step in facilitating processes and presenting a new proposed communications mechanism plan organising meetings with key initiatives to discuss how they want to move forward.
- Details will be presented in a proposal/concept note.

- To meet staff of relevant REDD+ initiatives on Communications activities and collaboration:

- The visits to different initiatives were to learn and understand better of how their knowledge and communications plans have been done and will be done. There were visits to FCPF, VFD, SNV. RECOFTC, GIZ
- O Discussions were held to finds way how they can all work together to ensure consistent messages and information sharing; as well as to avoid duplication of efforts in producing materials and other awareness raising activities, etc.

- To discuss with Communications Officers to how better moving forwards with communications activities and strategy

- Due to some complicated approval process, the national Communications Strategy was only developed as an action plan and no higher approval process.
- o Recommend that the strategy should be developed and with broader outlook by involving key and higher decision makers of the programme for approval and while at the same time practicing the existing action plan.

9.b Results achieved (key outputs)

- KM and Communications plan and strategy were discussed.
- Meetings with different partners and initiatives were made.
- An idea of organising an in-country were consulted with key stakeholders for inputs.
- A plan for knowledge management for UN-REDD in Asia/Pacific that was presented and ensure that it is in line with countries' needs.

9.c Expected outcomes and impacts

- An in-country event will be organised with efficient and effective way.
- Communications mechanism will be improved and implemented by the UN-REDD programme as a lead facilitator and in collaboration with the consulted initiatives and partners.
- On-going support to the Communications Officers will be available.
