and civil society

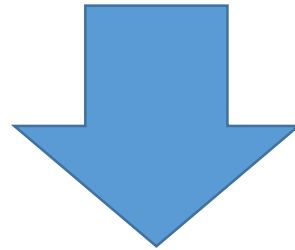
- is necessary

# BUT

- lots of confusion
- high expectations
- too many topics
- technical complexity
- wide range of stakeholders
- stakeholders in all power levels: *from the grassroots to the policy-makers*
- engagement requires: **TIME + LABOUR + FINANCE**

# WHAT TO DO ?

1. Understand well **what REDD+ is** and is not: *the boundaries*
2. **Focus** on key issues and entry points for REDD+ that reflect concerns of the CSO and IP constituencies
