Background to the process of providing a summary of information in Malaysia

- Two parts:
 - Stakeholders input through accreditation
 - Public input
- Summary of information will be generated through as report
- Summary of information will be organized in the following manner

Safeguard	Description	Associated law and Principle	Achievement	Remarks

The process of providing a summary of information

- The Content of the National Communication has not been finalized and maybe part of the National Circumstances or annex or Lima REDD+ Information Hub
- The analysis and summary of information will be done by NRE
- Responsibilities:
 - ✓ Updates on law, regulations and policies – NRE & Sub Nat
 - ✓ Compliance of principles, C&I – MTCC based on auditors report
 - ✓ Aichi Targets - NRE
 - ✓ FPIC – Sub national
 - ✓ Benefit sharing – sub national (national purpose)
- Consultations will be conducted at sub national level

Results, achievement and status of providing a summary of information

- The SIS system will be developed this year
- The content of SIS and the type of information to be incorporated have been agreed.
- The data collection process identified
- FPIC process at sub national, if applicable
- The process is transparent and verified against a list of criteria, indicators and verifiers

Challenges encountered in the process to provide a summary of information:

- Risk of reversals
- Risk of displacement
- New Permanent Reserved Forest without forest certification
- The positive benefits generated by REDD+ actions
- Gender representation



Questions/advice to UN-REDD:

- How to provide information on risk of reversal?
 - Would this mean allocating buffers or plans to ensure reversal of actions will not take place?
- Would risk of displacement include analysis of drivers and risk management
