The Participatory Governance Assessment (PGA) process in Ecuador is:

- ✓ One activity under Outcome 2 of the Joint National UN-REDD Programme (JNP).
- ✓ A participatory process for the development and improvement of governance indicators within the SIS (→ Outcome 5)
- ✓ A tool to strengthen participatory processes in REDD+, with a specific focus on the subnational/local level (→ Outcome 2)
- ✓ A process whose mechanisms as well as results are the property of Ecuador (State and society), with support from UN-REDD.
