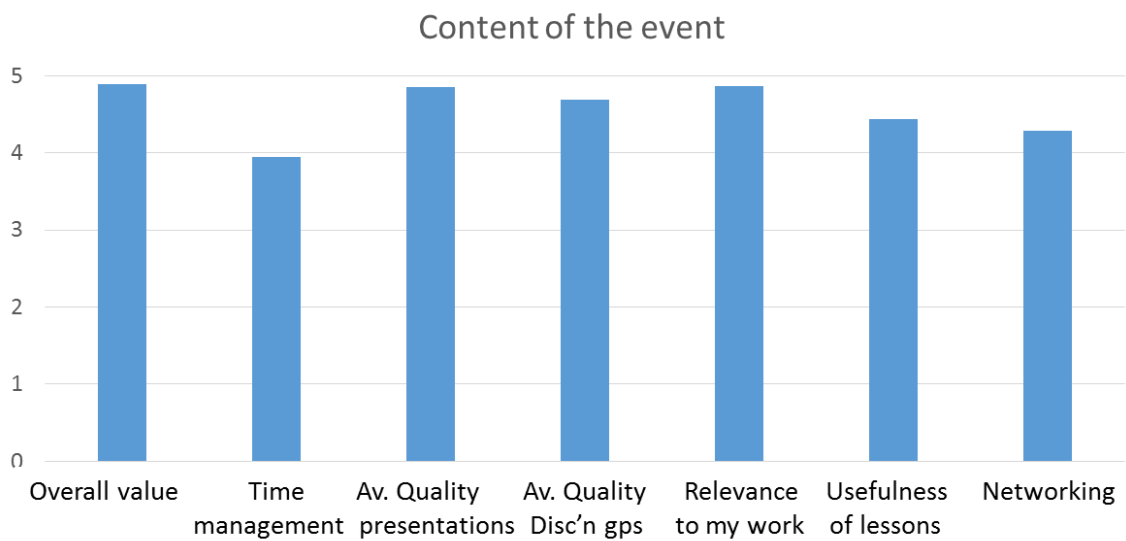


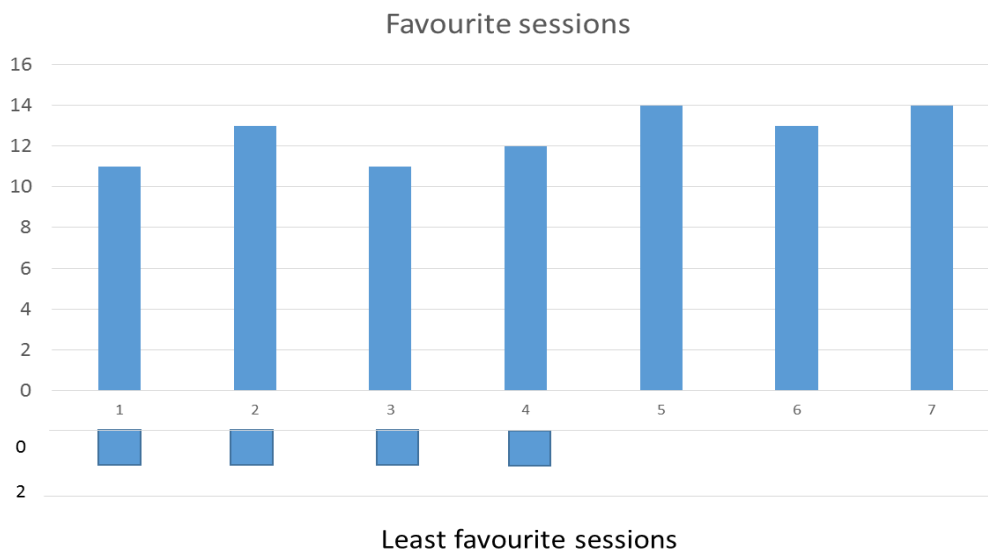
**I. Overall Assessment Results:**

**a) Content**



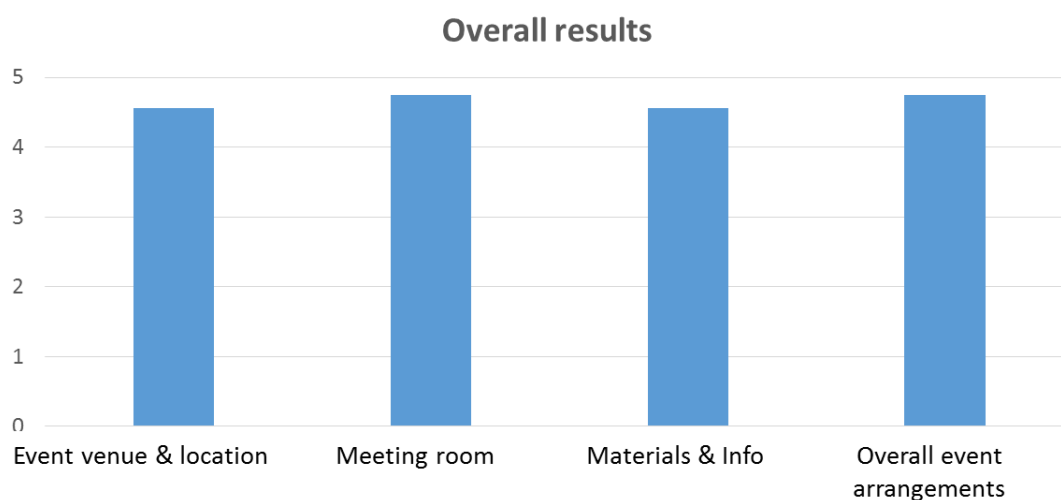
There was high overall satisfaction with the content of the event. Almost all participants found the content relevant to their work and were satisfied with the quality of the presentations and discussion groups. The lowest score was for time management.

**b) Favourite/least favourite sessions**



Sessions 5 and 6 (session 5, Evolution of REDD+ and Entry Points for IPs and CSOs, and session 6, Scoping Stakeholder Engagement Approaches and Alliances) were the most popular sessions. Only four sessions received any votes for least favourite session – one vote each.

### c) Organization



The scores for organization of the event were all very high, especially for the meeting room arrangements.

- The moderators were excellent. We had some gaps in knowledge of REDD+, therefore this was a good chance we were able to bridge.
