Cambodia REDD+ National Programme invites photographers to enter our Photography Competition. The contest is open to all Cambodian people in Cambodia.

#### THE CONTEST

The Cambodia REDD+ National Programme with support from the UN-REDD Programme, a collaborative initiative among the Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO), the United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP) and United Nations Development Programme (UNDP), is organizing its first photo contest in the country, to highlight the role of REDD+ as a way to protect, better manage and wisely use forest resources and to contribute to the global fight against climate change.

The objective of this photo contest is to create awareness in Cambodia of the meaning behind Reducing Emissions from Deforestation and Forest Degradation (REDD+) and its linkages to Forest Protection. The contest will harness photo talent from Cambodia in order to illustrate and convey the many linkages between REDD+ and Forest Protection. Photographers can submit individual photos inspired by the theme: *Our Forests for a Green Planet - Reducing Emissions from Forests to help control Climate Change*.

## WHO is Eligible to Enter the Contest?

- Cambodian national age over 18 and currently living in Cambodia;
- Either professional or amateur photographer;
- Each contestant can submit six photographs at the maximum.

**Not eligible to enter the contest:** employees of Cambodia REDD+ National Programme, the immediate families of such employees, and the people who are helping in organizing the competition.

#### **THEMES**

The image should depict one or more of the following:

- Protected areas, forest reserves, conservation;
- Livelihoods diversification and good land management;
- Forest dependent people in forest ecosystems, especially women and indigenous peoples;
- Farmers producing more on less land using agro-ecosystems and thus avoiding clearance of new forest;
- Good agricultural practices: such as agroforestry, alley cropping, inter cropping of trees and crops, trees produced on farms, tree apiculture, trees on pasture.

#### **HOW TO ENTER:**

Each photo must be submitted electronically, by one (and only one) of the following two methods:

- **Email** To submit your photos via email, please send to <a href="redd.secretariat@cambodia-redd.org">redd.secretariat@cambodia-redd.org</a> together with include the subject of the image, caption information, the date and location the image was taken, and the name of the photographer(s). However, the correct image size will be asked once it is shortlisted. Please find application form

### **DEADLINES:**

Entries can be submitted starting on 15 May 2013. Deadline for submitting entries is at 5:00pm on 07 June 2013.

Entrants may be asked to supplement their submission (such as a paragraph about their photo, the highest resolution version of their photo, or a watermark-free version of their photo) anytime during the contest period. Three (03) top grand prize winners and nineteen (06) additional honorable winners will be announced on or before 14 June 2013.

Cambodia REDD+ National Programme reserves the right to adjust any deadline(s) as the result of causes beyond its immediate control.

### **WINNING PHOTOS:**

The winning image will be printed in the 2014 Cambodia REDD+ National Programme publications and communications materials. All entrants featured in the publications or communications materials will receive a copy of each publication/communication material.
