Project Highlights

Goal: To develop and enhance capacities of the Royal Government of Cambodia to tackle deforestation and forest degradation as well as for measuring, reporting, and verifying (MRV) emission reductions.

Objectives:

- Effective National Management of the REDD+ Readiness process and stakeholder engagement in accordance with the Roadmap principles;
- Development of the National REDD+ Strategy and Implementation Framework;
- Improved capacity to manage REDD+ at sub-national levels;
- Design of a Monitoring System and capacity for implementation.

The FCPF project undertakes work on **MRV/NFMS, BDS, Safeguards, Policies and measures, National REDD+ Fund.**

Beneficiaries: The project builds capacities of government agencies and non-governmental stakeholders.

Lessons Learned/Achievements:

- Grievance mechanisms: At the local level there are well-established systems for conflict avoidance and conflict resolution. However, these systems cannot address grievances at a larger scale, or where the parties are unequal in terms of power relations. Therefore, the major challenge for grievance mechanisms for REDD+ in Cambodia is to establish a transparent, fair and non-threatening process to avoid and resolve disputes under such circumstances.

Challenges: Overall coordination on REDD+ readiness. Capacities need to be developed to allow effective coordination of all partners.
