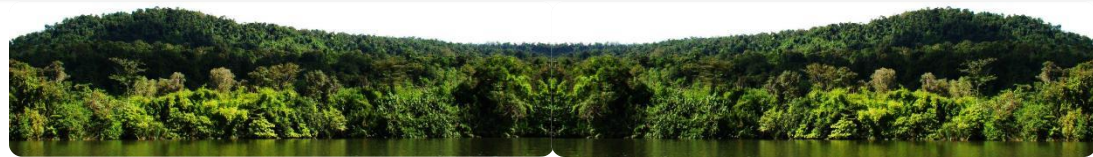

# Background to the FCPF

The Forest Carbon Partnership Facility assists developing countries in their efforts to reduce emissions from deforestation and forest degradation and foster conservation, sustainable management of forests, and enhancement of forest carbon stocks by providing value to standing forests.



# Background to the FCPF

The FCPF was launched at the 13th session of the Conference of the Parties to the UNFCCC in Bali, and became operational in June 2008.

Currently there are 44 participating countries, and 15 donors or contributors from both the public and private sectors are supporting the FCPF financially.



# FCPF and REDD+ Phases

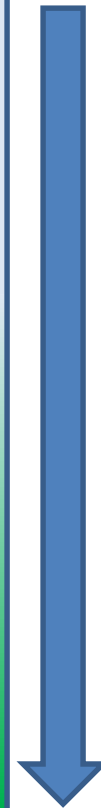
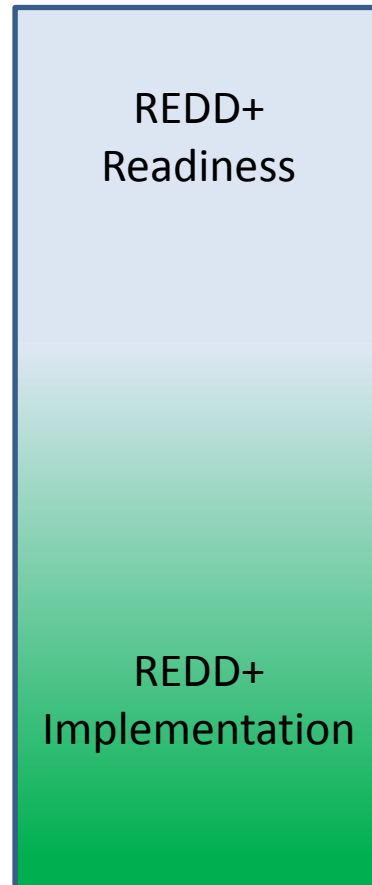
Phase 1: Development of national strategies and capacity-building



Phase 2: Implementation of national policies and measures and strategies, possibly with further capacity-building, technology development/transfer and results-based demonstration activities



Phase 3: Results-based actions that should be fully measured, reported and verified

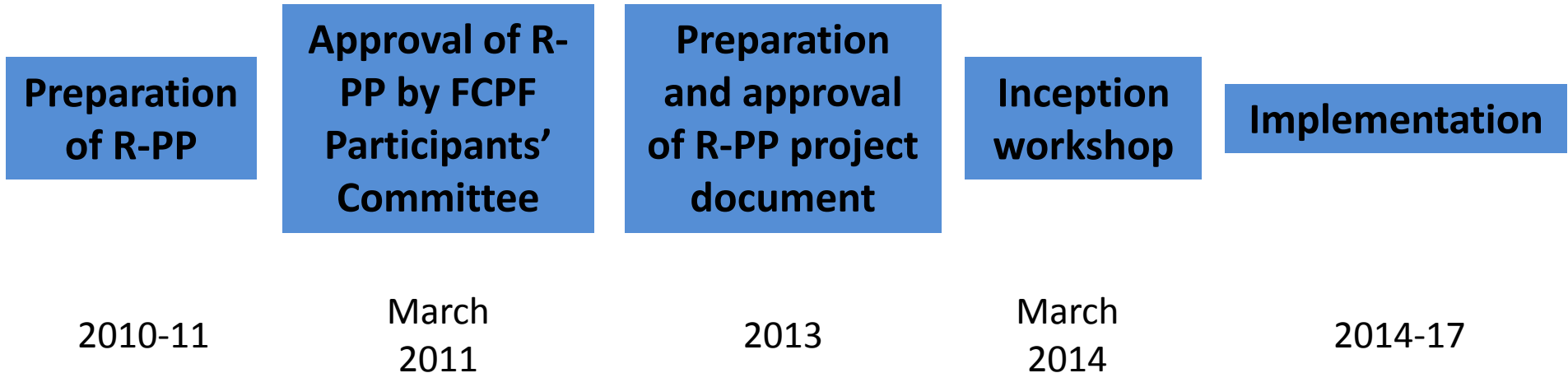
