SURINAME

- Geography
 - is a small country in the Caribbean that borders with Brazil, Guyana and French Guyana.
- Population
 - Indigenous peoples, descendants of slaves (tribal peoples- maroons), immigrants from India, Indonesia and China etc.
- Indigenous and Tribal peoples
 - Indigenous peoples (4 tribes) 3% of the population

Maroons (6 tribes)%

THE CONSULTATION OF INDIGENOUS AND TRIBAL PEOPLE

How?

- Through Traditional Authorities
- Through representatives appointed by Traditional Authority/Community (NGO's, CBO's)



THE CONSULTATION

 Traditionally the Government involves the Indigenous people and Maroons through their conventional structures



THE CONSULTATION

- On a regular base consultation between the Government and these communities are taking place safeguarding local involvement in the formulation
 - of public policies on the use of resources,
 - development planning
 - potential relocation,

among others, in areas traditionally inhabited by indigenous and tribal communities.



THE CONSULTATION

When?

- The Ministry of Regional Development has regular consultations whereby various developmental issues regarding the districts and the communities are being discussed based on partnership and consultation e.g
 - Krutu at village/ community level
 - Gran krutu at tribal level



NATIONAL JUDICIAL FRAMEWORK

- FPIC not embedded in the Law
- No laws or other legal instruments put in place for the consultation of indigenous and other tribal people



FPIC IMPLEMENTATION

 Engage in a process of developing a model according to international standards



CHALLENGES

- How to develop a bill or a protocol which meets international standards according national law (Lack of technical expert and experience)
- Develop an acceptable model for FPIC in Suriname



OPPORTUNITIES

- Improved relationship between government and Indigenous and tribal People
- REDD+ to implement FPIC
