DEFINITION:

Is the principle that a community has the right to give its consent to proposed projects or activities.

OBJECTIVES:

- To ensure that the proposed project or activities take place.
- The resources are share equitable and sustainably.


OUTCOME:


Mutual agreement in a forum that gives affected community enough leverage to negotiate conditions under which may proceed and an outcome leaving the community clearly better off.


WHAT DOES FPIC MEAN TO FOREST PEOPLES?


It means:

- the communities must involve into negotiations;
- They have the right to decide whether they will agree to the project or not;
- □ They participate in the plan of activities.

Capacity Building

Continual Monitoring

Maintenances

RECOMMENDATIONS

- Capacity building in FPIC for:
- I. Forest staff
- Beneficiaries (men, women, children, youth) + vulnerable and the marginalization groups.
- Capacity building in Monitoring and evaluation.

HOW TO APPLY THE FPIC IN GEDAREF

- Select degraded forest resulted from severe communities practices;
- Collect basic data about community (Socio-economics data).
- Selection of suitable project that satisfy the needs of community on a sustainable basis.
