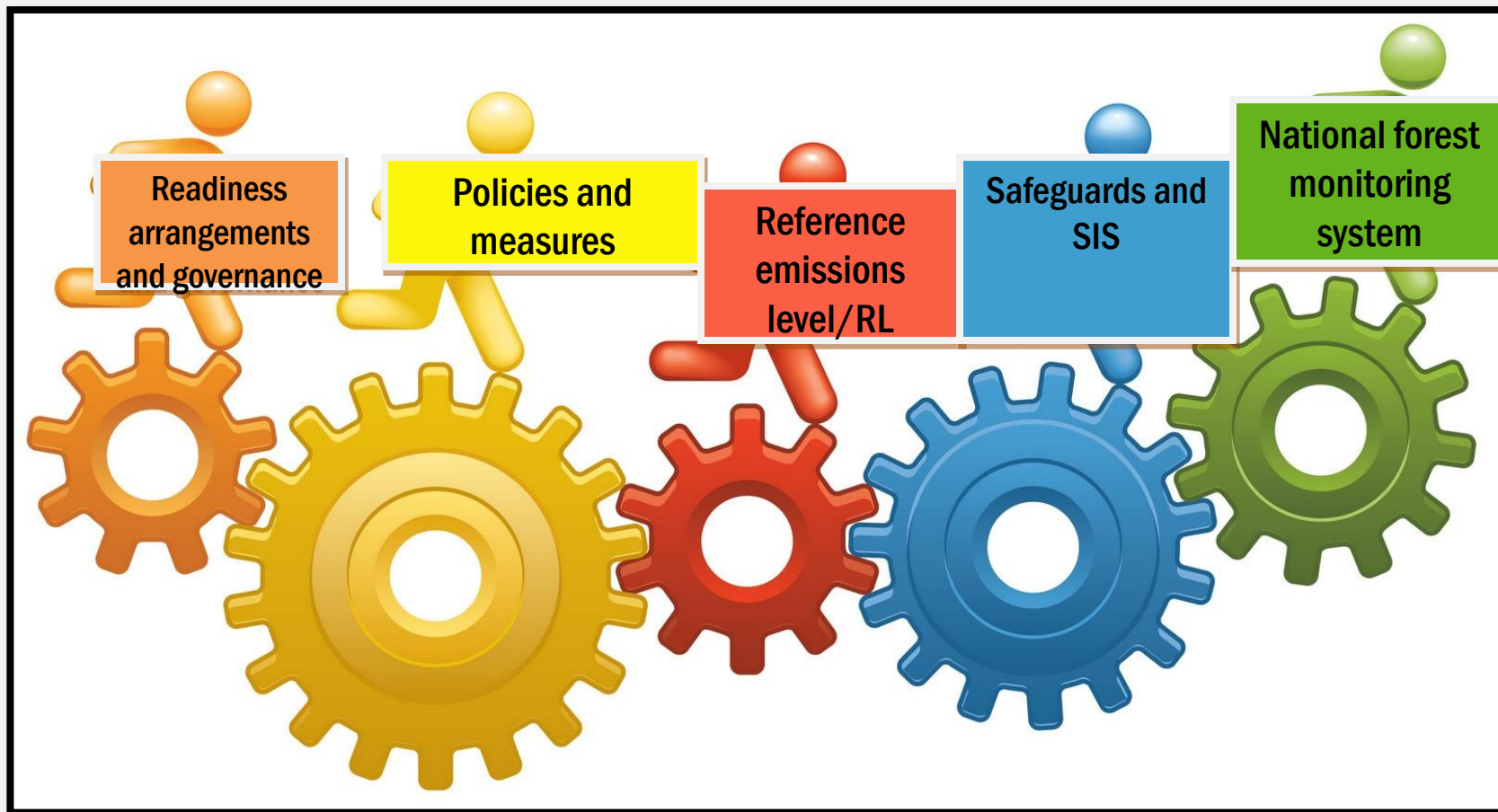

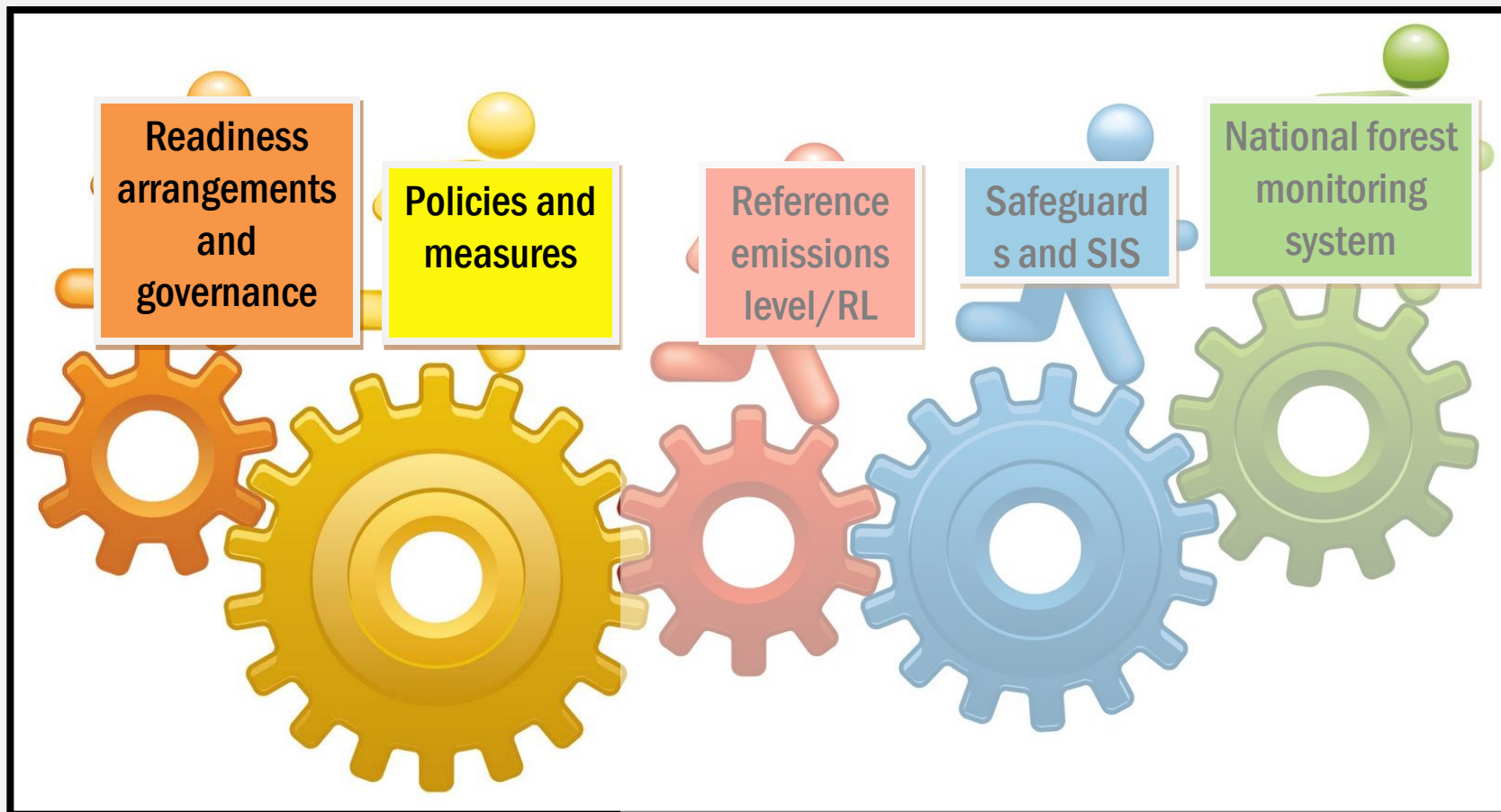

Key Parts of a REDD+ System

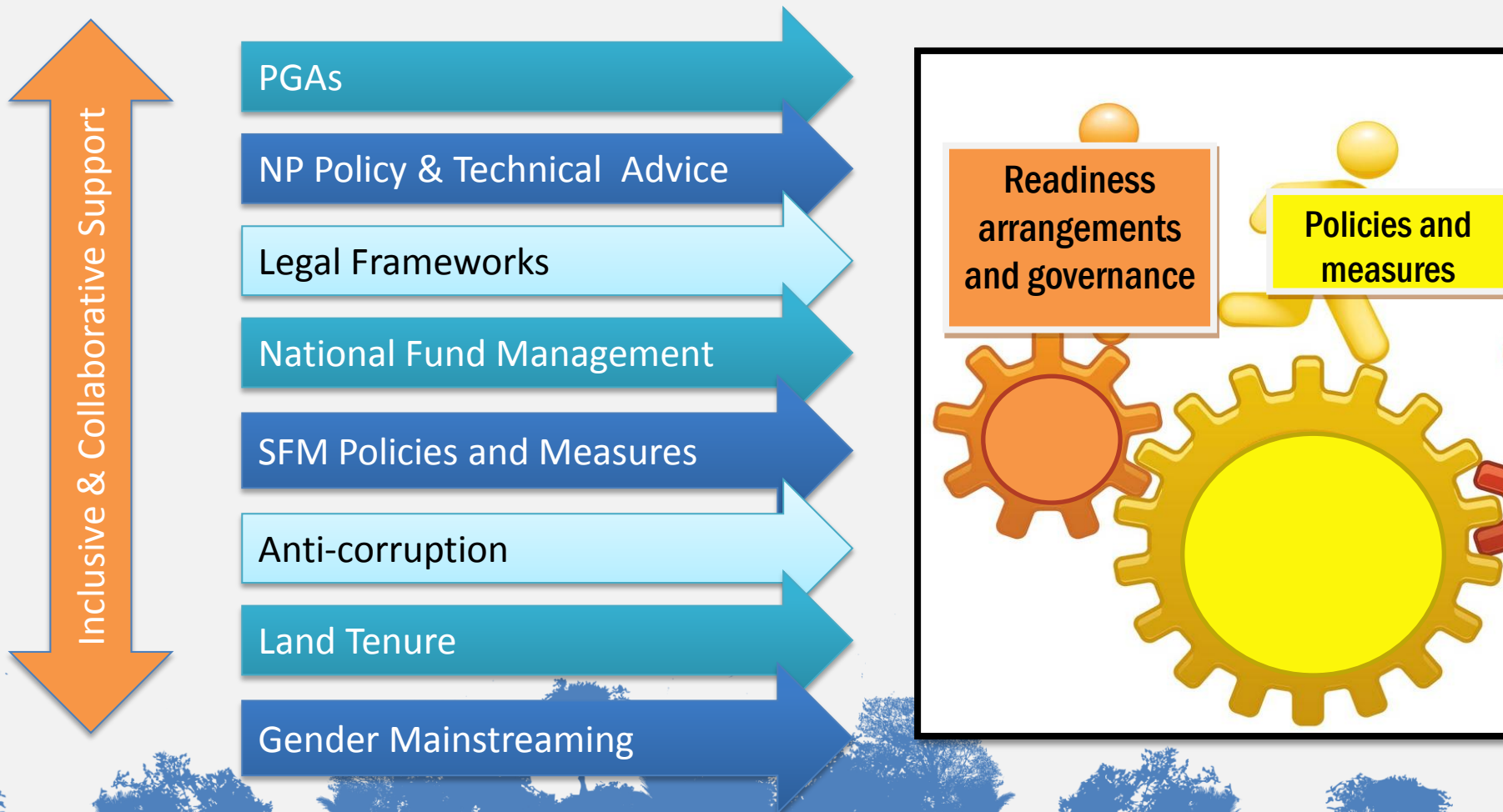

Advisory services to countries on national fund design

DRC & Ethiopia including support in the development of the following documents:

- Operational manuals
- TORs for governance bodies (Board of Trustees, technical committees etc.)
- Development of performance indicators for REDD+ funds
- Funding flows
- Investment plans and programming documents
- Capacity building and transition plans etc.



South-South exchange on national fund design

- Currently involving 6 countries: Brazil, Colombia, DRC, Ethiopia, Indonesia, Vietnam – more countries will join
- **Fund governance** (structure, funding flows, multi-sector/level coordination, how to ensure technical capacity of executing agencies)
- **Modalities of fund disbursement** (targeted allocation vs. competitive bidding, large scale vs. communities, bundling PES, results based payments)
- **Aligning national funds and strategic goals** (role of the funds mainstreaming REDD+ into domestic policies and ODA, additionality)
- **Sources of funding** (uncertainty, long-term sustainability, private sector, leveraging domestic resources)
- **Safeguards** (coherence b/w different standards, implementation and enforcement, grievance mechanisms)
