VACCINATION

For travel to Indonesia, yellow fever immunisation is required for all travellers arriving from a yellow-fever-infected country. Please note that travellers will be requested to provide proof of vaccination throughout their journey and upon arrival in Jakarta. The following immunisations are also recommended: Diphtheria, tetanus, poliomyelitis, typhoid fever, hepatitis A. Furthermore, preventative measures against Malaria are recommended. VISA REQUIREMENTS

A visa for entry into Indonesia may be required. Visa on arrival and free visa for short visit (BVKS) are available for participants from some countries (please see details below). For visa assistance for participants from other countries, please provide a copy of your passport and the filled Visa and Accommodation form to events@unorcid.org as early as possible.

VISA ON ARRIVAL

This visa can be obtained directly when arriving at Jakarta airport, regardless of the purpose of visit. The maximum stay permitted is thirty (30) days and could be extended (one time) for a maximum thirty (30) days

The general requirements for visa on arrival are:

- The applicant's passport must be valid for at least 6 (six) months from the date of entry.
- Round-trip airplane ticket.
- Fees:

Up to 7 (seven) days: US\$ 10Up to 30 (thirty) days: US\$ 25.

TRANSPORTATION TO/FROM THE AIRPORT

Estimated taxi fare from Jakarta Soekarno-Hatta International Airport (CGK) to JW Marriot Hotel Jakarta is around USD 20 and USD 35, for recommended BlueBird and Silverbird taxi respectively (one way). For participants staying at the JW Marriot Hotel Jakarta, limousine service pick-up (USD 54 per car, one way) can be organised.

Departure taxis to the airport can be booked with the hotel reception.

Jakarta has a hot and humid climate on the boundary between tropical monsoon and savannah. The wet season in Jakarta covers the majority of the year, running from November through June.
