TRANSPORTATION FROM GENEVA AIRPORT

Please note that no airport pick-ups will be provided.

For those staying at the Etap hotel, you can take bus number 10 from the airport (Airport-Rive) to Pailly (Balaxert), the fifth stop. The ride should not take more than 10 minutes. Etap hotel is in walking distance of the office.

Participants not staying at the Etap hotel may take to reach the meeting's venue:

- Tram 14 to Balaxert (see map)
- Bus 22, 5 or 19 to Chatelaine

The bus or tram fare is 3.50 CHF, payable at the bus stop (exact change needed)

Geneva, February:

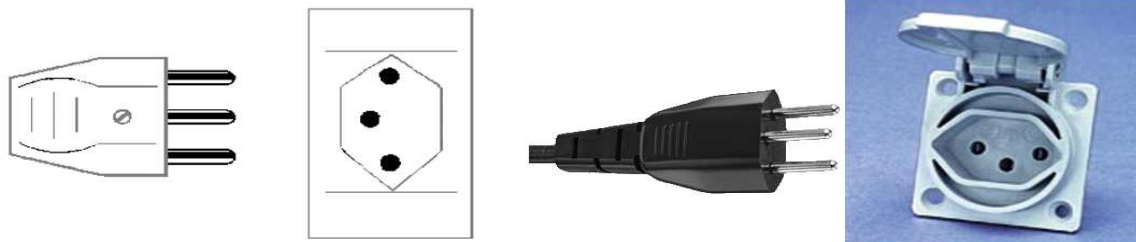
Average high temperature: 6 C/43F

Average low temperature: -4 C/25F

Note that temperatures for the week of the FPIC Guidelines workshop will be particularly cold (-15C/5F)
