2. Update and discuss to mobilize more on application submission There were 29 applications up to July 16th. The numbers of candidates by stakeholder group are listed below:

Action: Potential Candidates to do more outreach:

- Rithiny will follow up with the CFi network again to mobilize additional candidates.
- 3. Finalize and short list applications
 - Femy already provided some contacts and Heang already sent emails.
 - Femy hasn't contacted WWF yet but Rithiny will contact WWF.
 - Rithiny already contacted others.
 - Note: for IPs applicants, there will be 15 more from 15 provinces once the IP selection process is done by Mr. Racy.
 - It was concluded that since the IP constituency has its own candidate selection process, the two IP submissions received by email should be considered invalid.

4. Reviewing the online survey monkey designing form

- 9 separate links will be created, one for each stakeholder group. In emails sent to the eligible voters of each stakeholder group, the relevant link and password will be sent.

5. How the selection process will operate

There are 3 Voting Options:

- 1. Online Voting: It will begin three weeks before the workshop and will close two days before the workshop to allow the votes to be counted.
- 2. Postal Voting: It is designed mainly for the three community network, who have a low rate of internet access and will have low attendance at the workshop; the other stakeholder groups are considered to have adequate internet access for on-line voting or voting in person at the workshop. Therefore, postal voting will be required only if the number of candidates exceeds 2 for any community network. Currently, therefore, postal voting is not required. Furthermore, it would be extremely difficult to organize postal voting in the remaining time available. Therefore, while efforts should be made to secure two candidates per network, ideally the number would not exceed two for any network.
- 3. In-person voting: It will take place on the second day of the workshop. (*Please find separate file for detailed information*)
 - Femy will write intro for pre-email assessment and Intro for email survey to explain about the CG process and voting for the email sending out.
 - Femy will send Heang the contact list of INGOs.
 - Rithiny will send Heang the contact list of National NGOs and CSOs.
 - Menglim will send Heang the contact list of Academia group.
 - For private sector, Menglim already sent to Heang since the last meeting.
