Minutes of the National Validation of the National REDD+ Roadmap for Mongolia

Venue: 6th Floor meeting room, UN House, Ulaanbaatar

Date: 5 June 2014, Thursday, 9:00-13:30

Facilator: Mr. Ts.Banzragch, Director of Division of Forest Conservation and Reforestation Management, MEGD and UN-REDD Programme Operational Focal Point

Objectives:

- To present the National REDD+ Roadmap for Mongolia to participants and obtain their feedbacks.
- To reach an agreement on validation of Mongolia's National REDD+ Roadmap.

Notes of the validation workshop:

A total of 50 participants representing different stakeholders including government ministries, NGOs, CSOs, development partners, media, academia and forest groups came together to validate Mongolia's National REDD+ Roadmap. The validation workshop was opened by Mr. Ts. Banzragch, MEGD and Mr. Thomas Eriksson, Deputy Resident Representative, UNDP Mongolia. Mr. Banzragch noted the importance of the event, expressed his hope for a postivie outcome of the meeting and urged the participants to provide inputs to the document. Mr. T.Eriksson highlighted the priorities of the readiness process and importance of aligning the REDD+ initiative with a national green development strategy, thanked the stakeholders for their active collaboration throughout the process and expressed his hope for the programme in the future, as well.

During the workshop, the stakeholder groups discussed and rewieved the REDD+ readiness process since Mongolia became a partner to the UN-REDD programme in 2011. At the same time, the participants were provided with opportunities to provide inputs to the programme to be submitted and presented at the UN-REDD Policy Board meeting to take place on 8-9 July 2014 in Lima, Peru (See Annex 1 for Workshop programme).

The National REDD+ Roadmap was presented in detail (Introduction of four Components, Proposed institutional arrangements to manage REDD+ readiness process, Proposed reults' framework of the Roadmap) and the partcipants worked on the validation of the National REDD+ Roadmap in 4 groups (Annex 2):

- Group 1: National REDD+ management arrangements and stakeholder awareness and effective engagement (facilited by Ms. B. Bunchingiv, Environment Team Leader, UNDP)
- Group 2: National REDD+ strategy (facilitated by Mr. Ts. Banzragch, MEGD)
- Group 3; Forest reference emissions levels and forest reference levels (facilited by Ms. B. Enkhtsetseg, UNDP/FAO)
- Group 4: National forest monitoring system and safeguards information system (facilited by Ms.
 D. Khandarmaa, Coordinator for Environmental Governance Project, UNDP/MEGD)

The workshop continued by presentation of summaries of the Break Out Group Discussions and Participant's overall feedback.

The Main Outcomes of the discussions are as the following:

- Importance of involving scientists and researchers as a part of advisory and technical working groups was hinglighted, as well as of an appropriate representation of the forestry NGOs and professional companies in the process.
- For capacity building for RELs/RLs (Component 3), it is advisable that the majority of resources allocated in the first two years, as capacity development activities would be predominantly undertaken during that period of time. More specifically, allocations for activity 3.1.1 are proposed to be distributed as 47%, 33% and 20% for three years, instead of equal distribution within three years.
- To promote clarity of understanding through translation into the Mongolian language, a glossary of REDD+ terminologies need to be developed in the Mongolian language and added to the REDD+ Roadmap as an annex once Roadmap is presented at UN-REDD Policy Board. In this regard, a number of improvements were proposed into the Mongolian version of the Results framework.

Specific recommendations for re-formulation and amendment of the Results Framework are tabulated as below.
