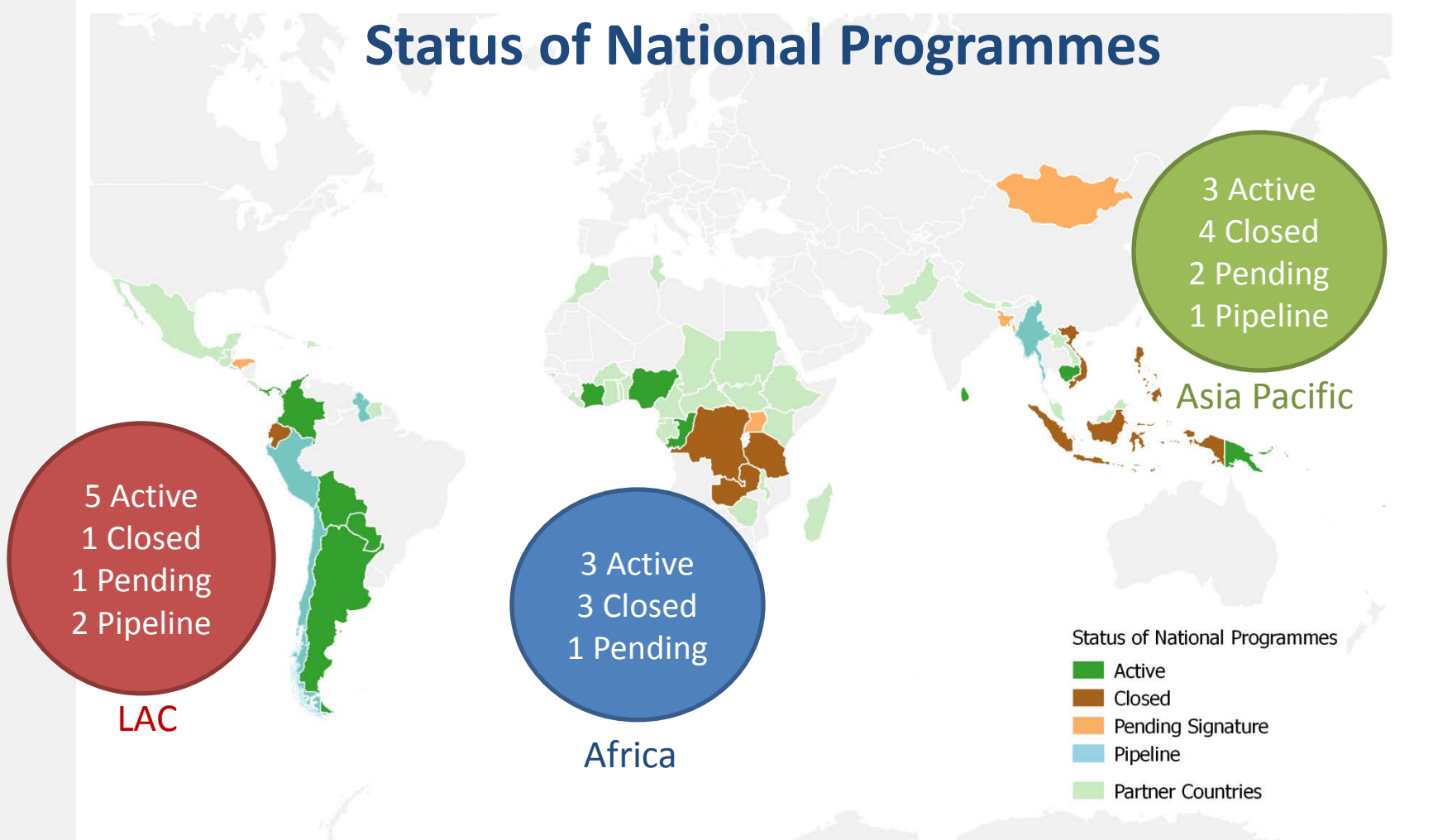

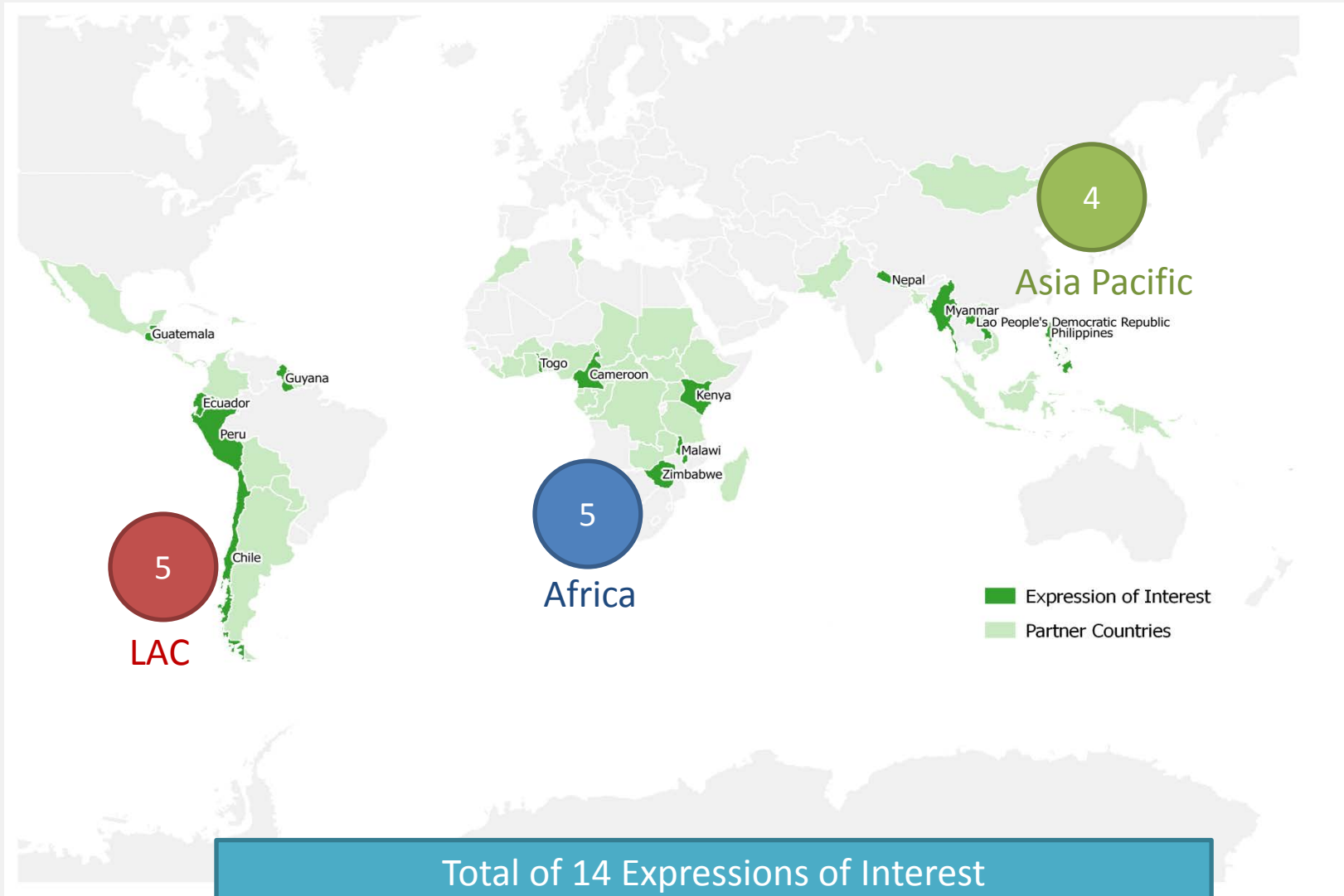

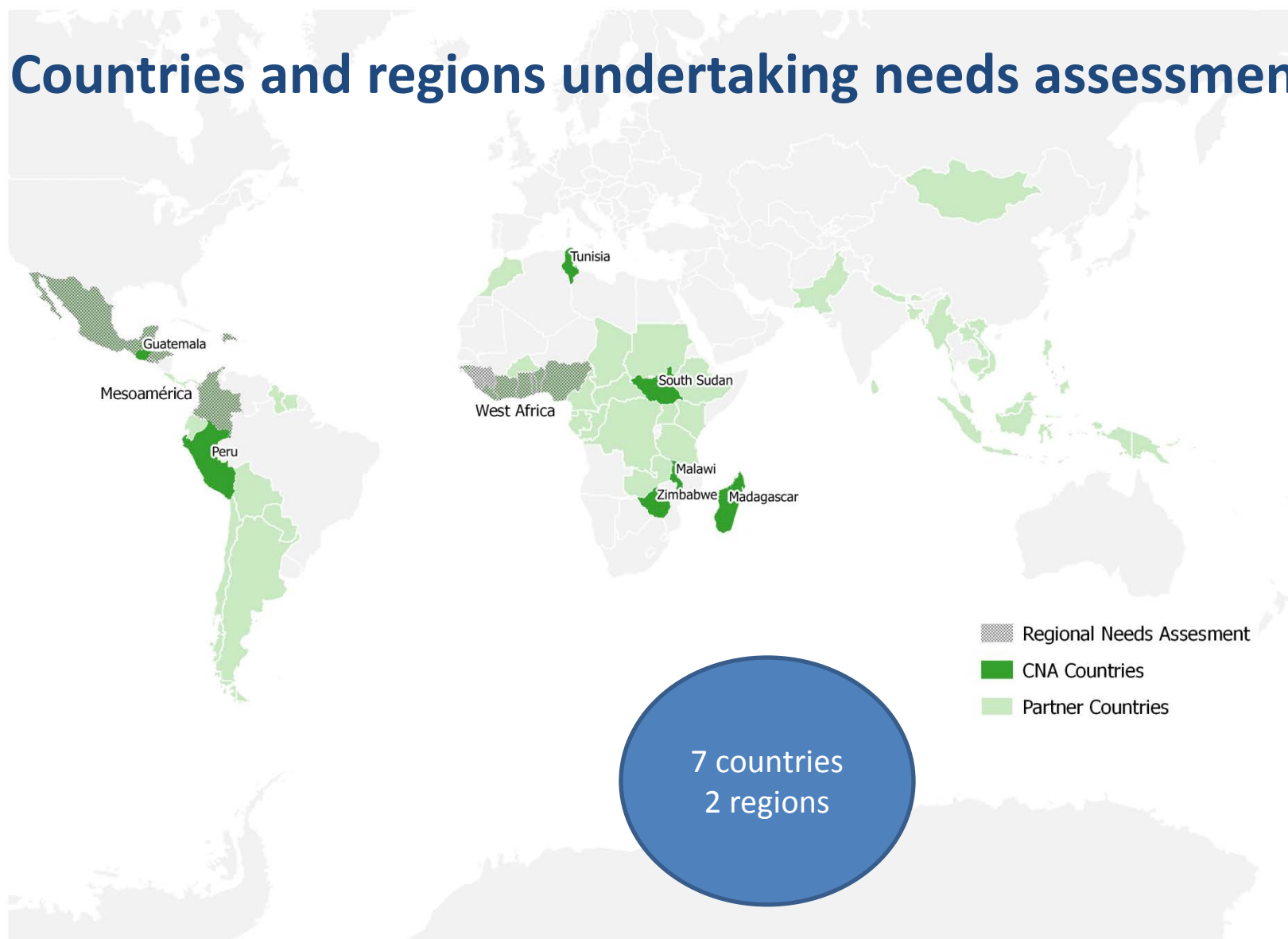

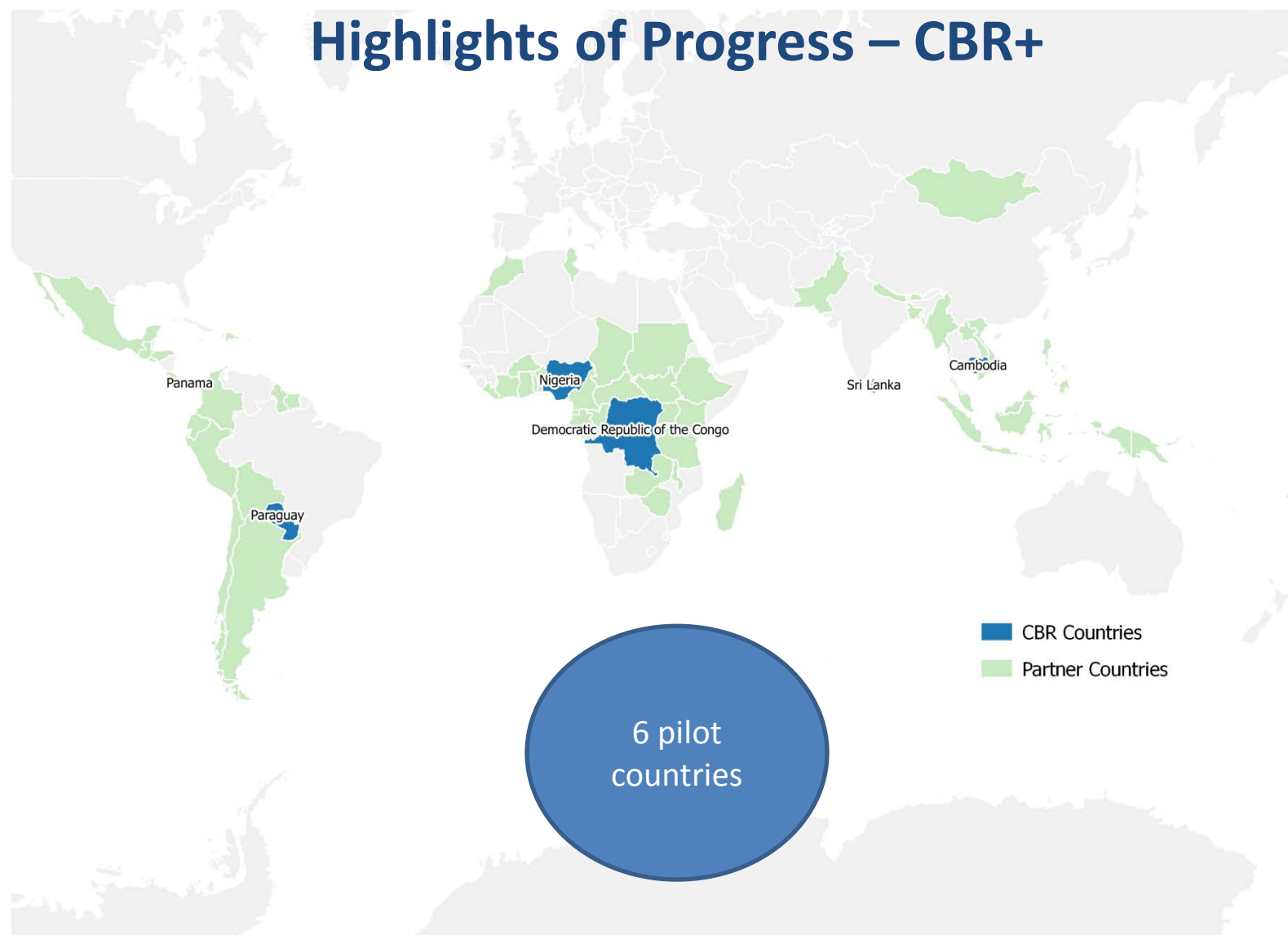

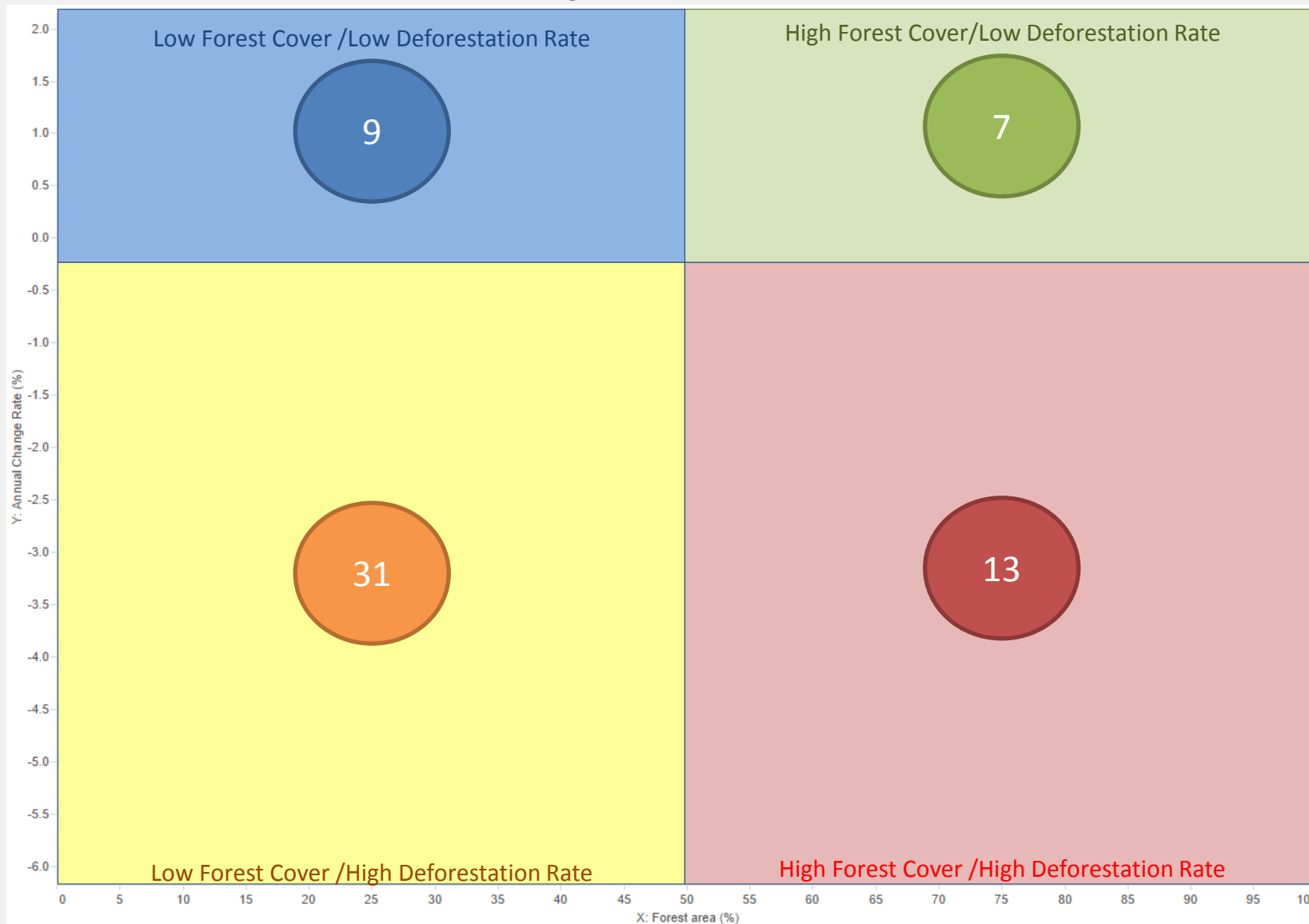

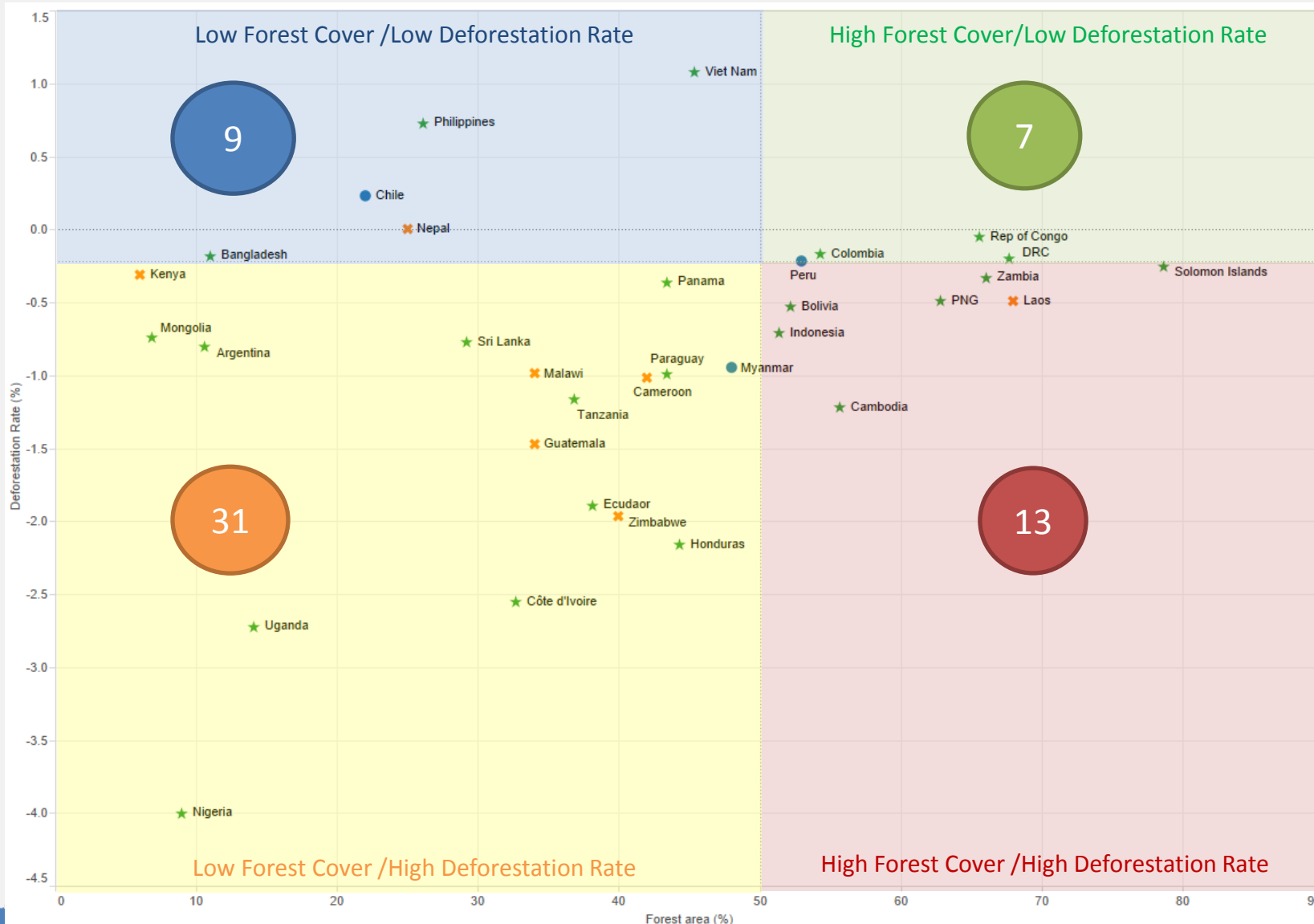

# Highlights of Progress

## Support to National REDD+ Actions

### MRV and Monitoring

- 29 countries designing/building NFMS (NFI, SLMS and GHG Inventory)

### Governance

- 6 countries with National REDD+ Strategy/Roadmap/Phase 2 account

### Stakeholder Engagement

- 27 countries have activities/mechanisms to support participation of CSO, IP and forest-dependent communities

### Safeguards and Multiple Benefits

- 6 countries have country approach to safeguards an/or incorporated multiple benefits in REDD+ planning

### Green Economy and Private Sector Engagement

- 3 countries are establishing National Platforms for key driver commodities
- 10 countries carried out key background studies and analysis for National REDD+ Strategy design

**33 regional training workshops**  
**5,000 people trained**

**24 countries operationalized tools, methods and frameworks**

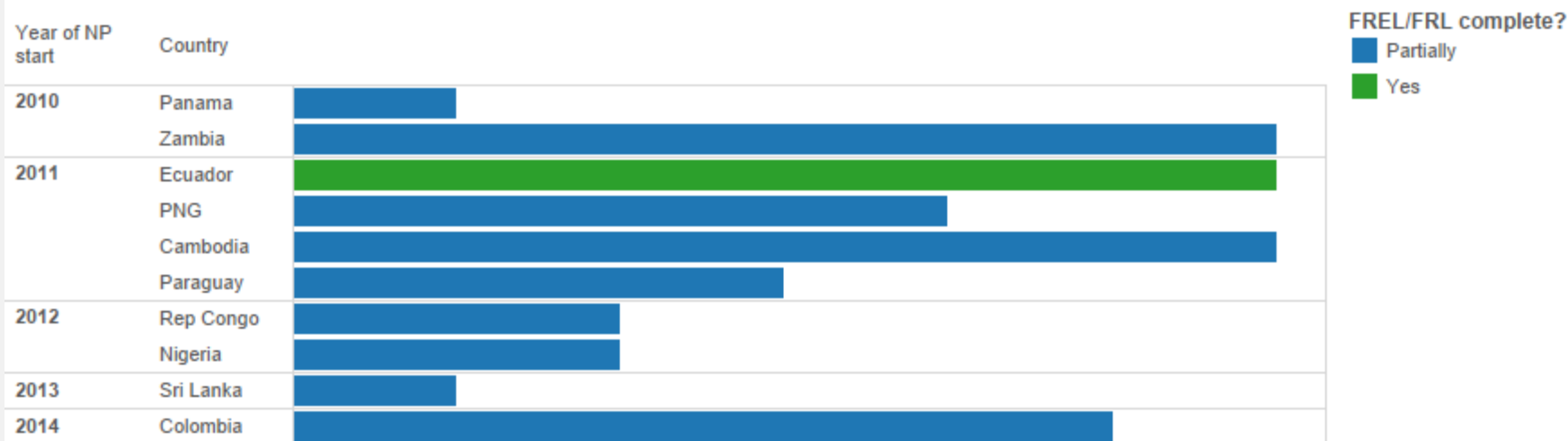

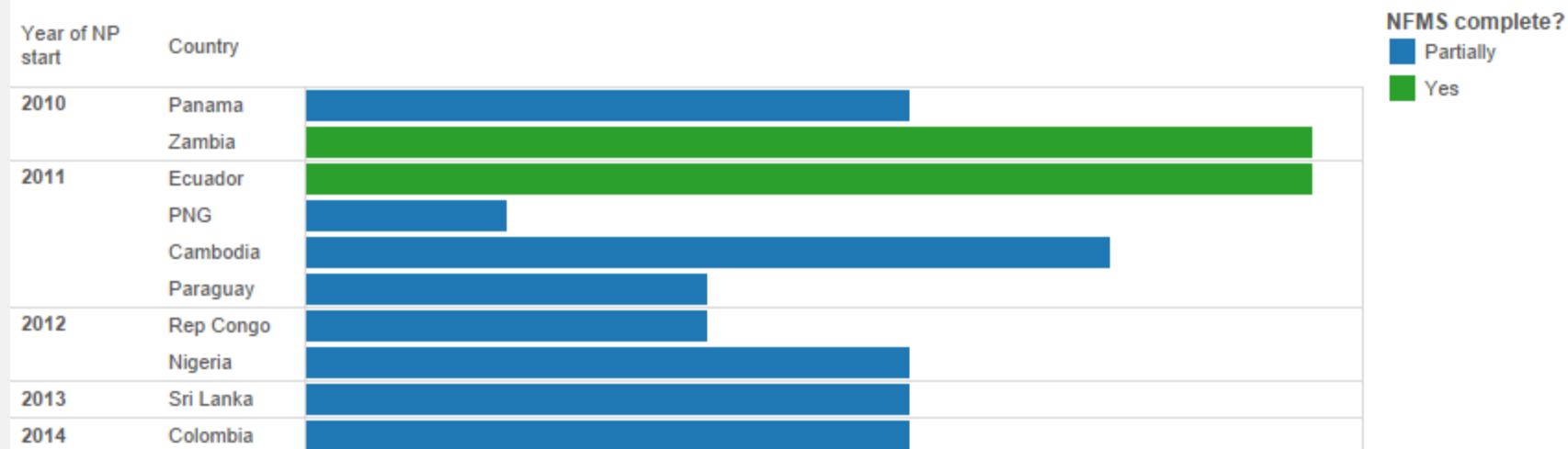

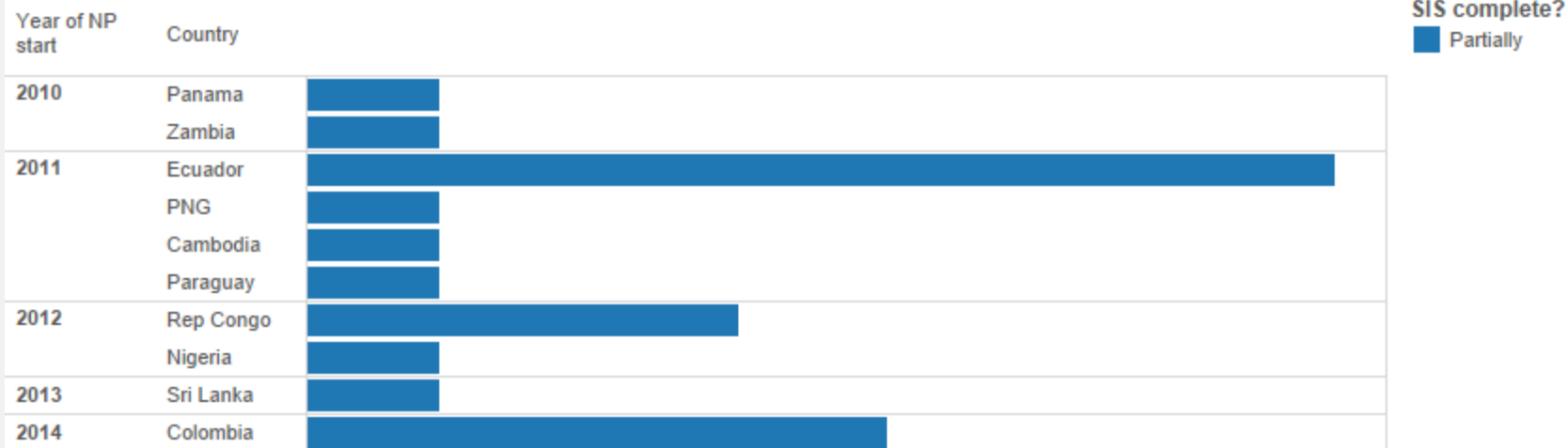

## Lessons Learned

Institutional Context Analysis: information on incentives, interest and power-relations in the country [Papua New Guinea]

Avoid over ambitious design of NP [Republic of Congo]

Simplification and standardization of administrative procedures [Ecuador]

Sustainable transfer of technical knowledge [Sri Lanka]

Stakeholder engagement key to successful implementation of NP activities [Colombia]

Representation of each stakeholder group crucial for the REDD+ process to be truly inclusive [Republic of Congo]
