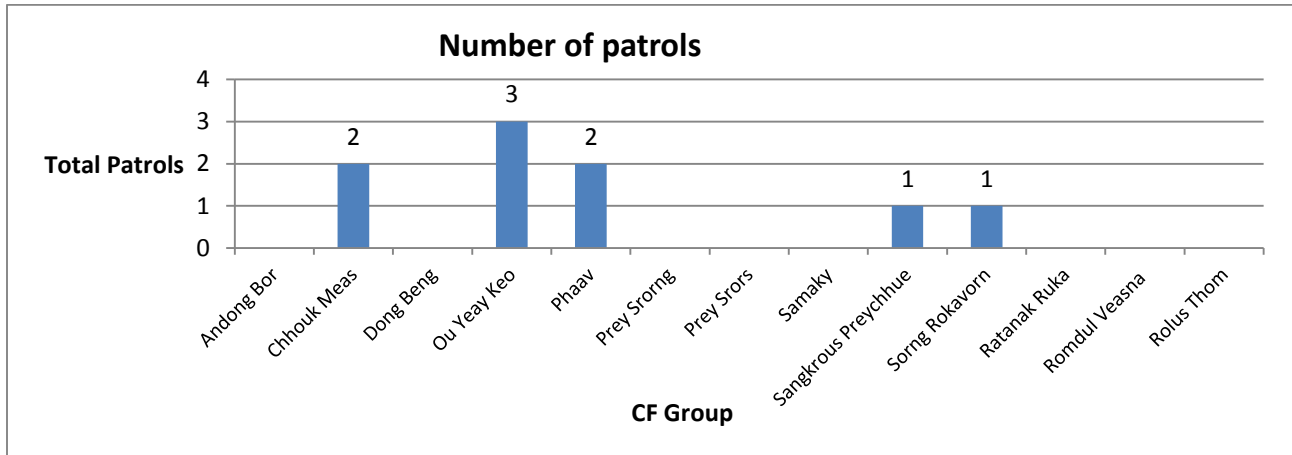


Monthly Report on Community Forest Patrolling in Oddar Meanchey – December 2012

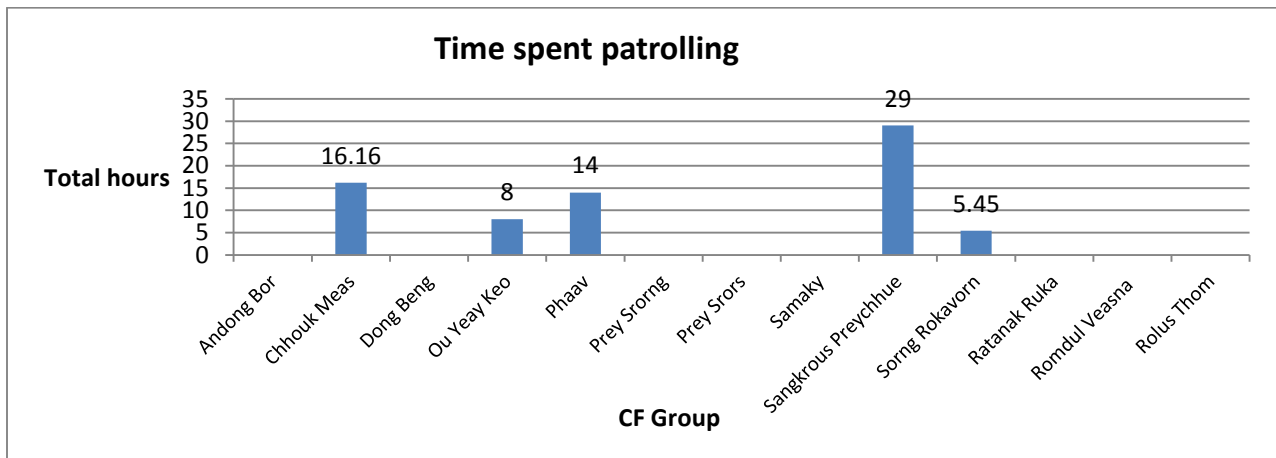


The following report documents the information received in December by the Frontline SMS patrol reporting system. A total of 9 patrolling reports were submitted by the 13 community forestry groups in December. In this month, there was a high rate of biodiversity sightings and forest fires reported in some of the community forestry areas.

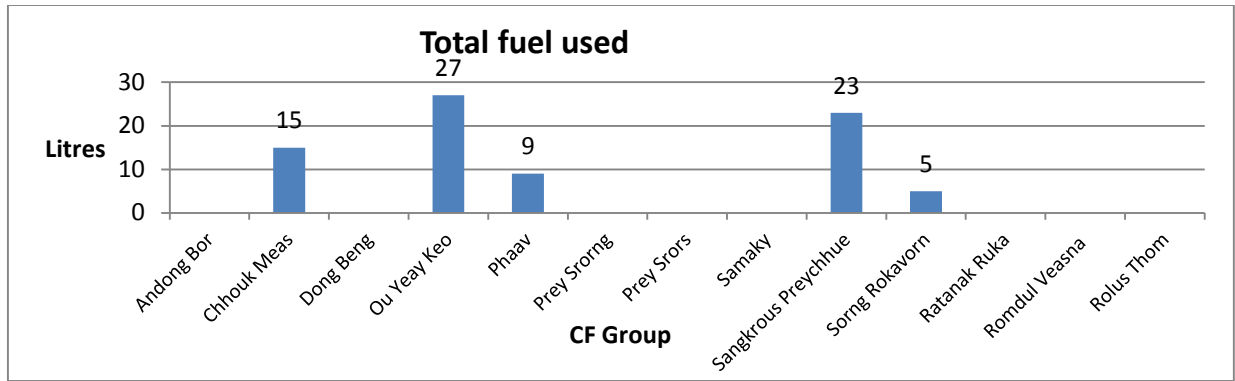

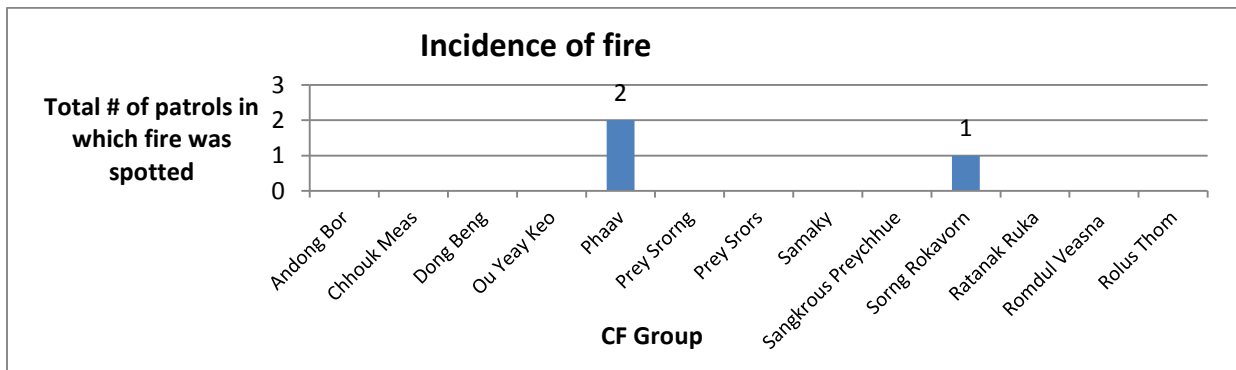

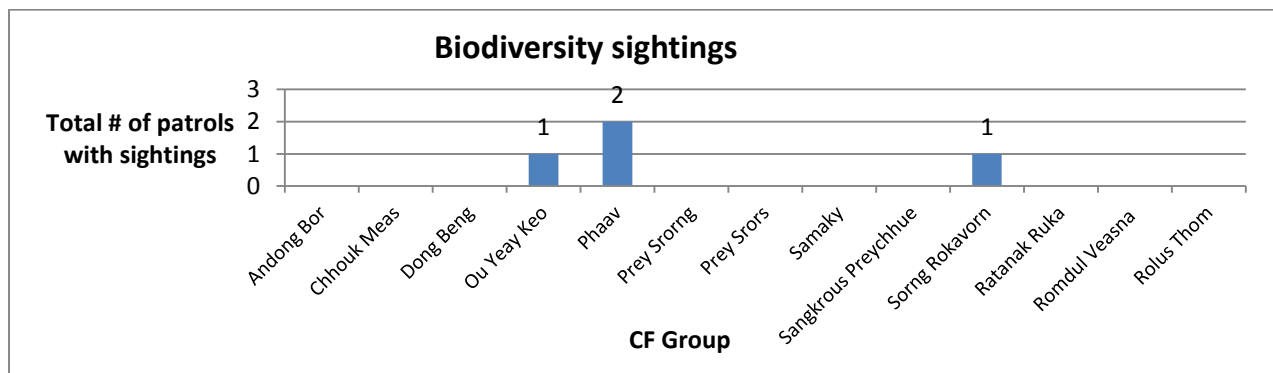

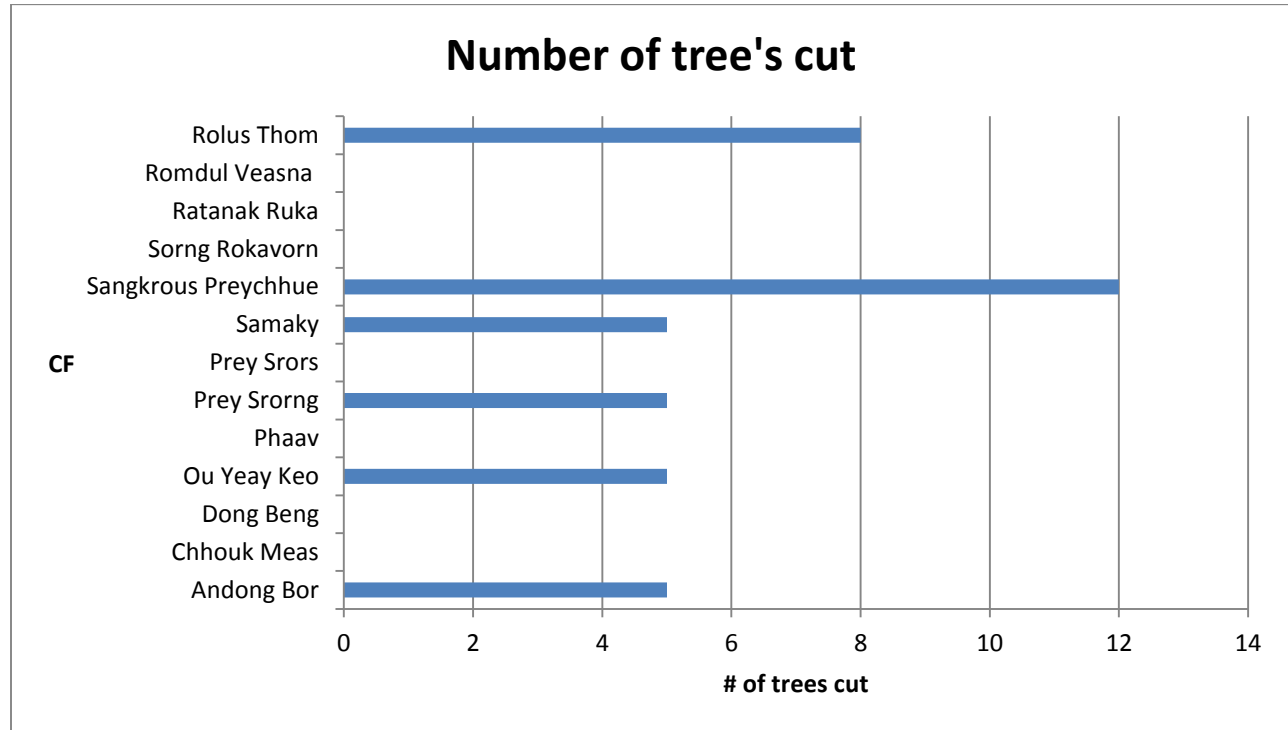

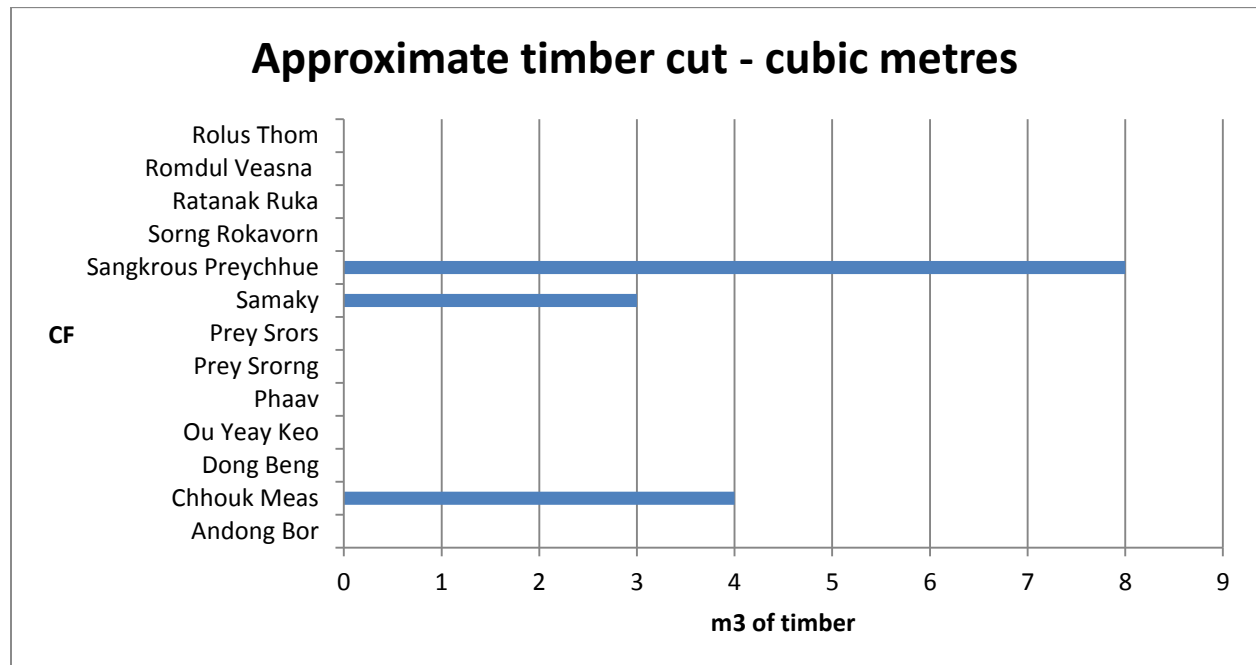

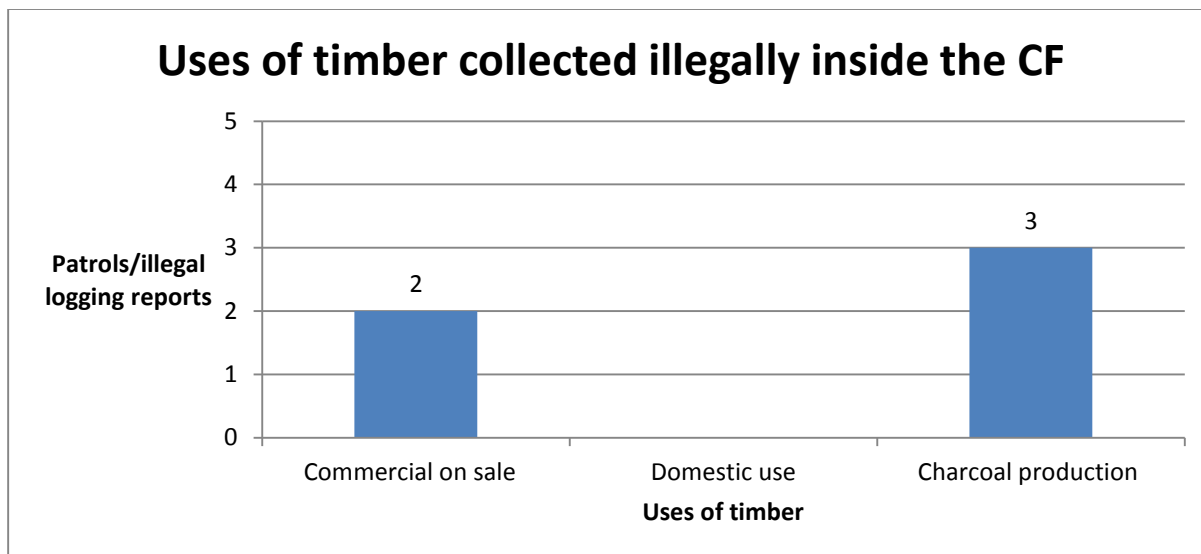
Illegal Logging Information – collected from Frontline SMS reports

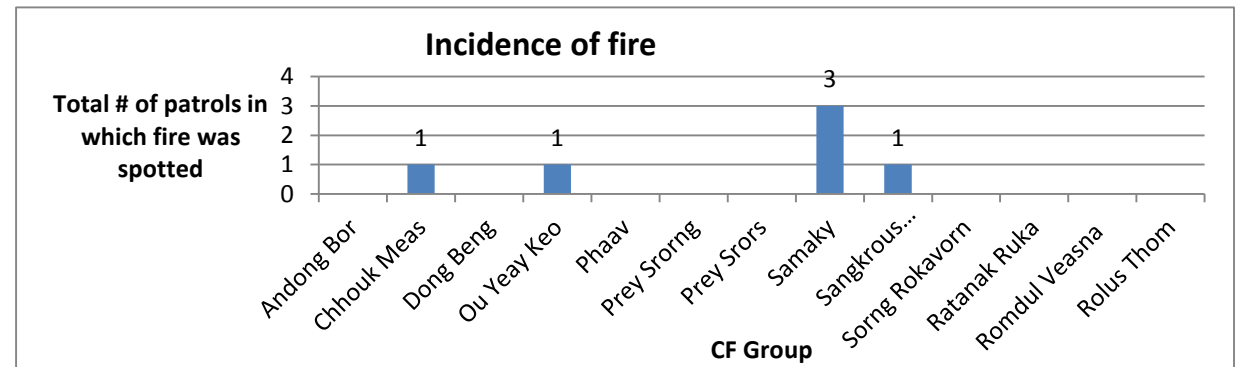

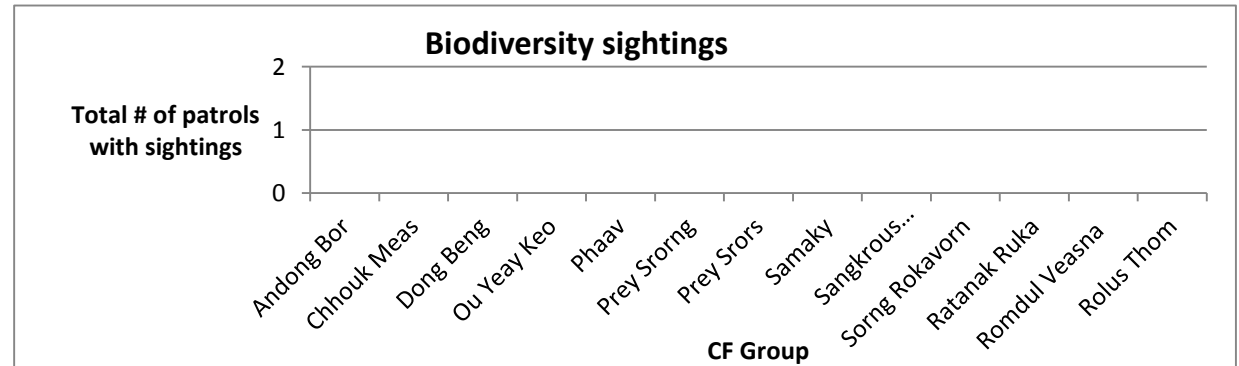

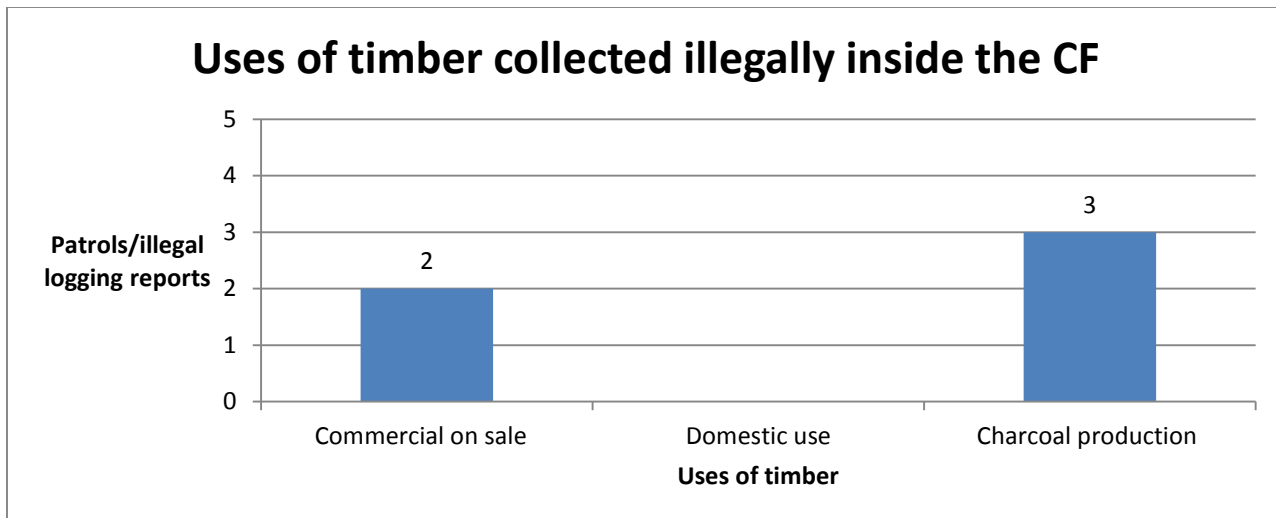
Illegal Logging Information – collected from Frontline SMS reports

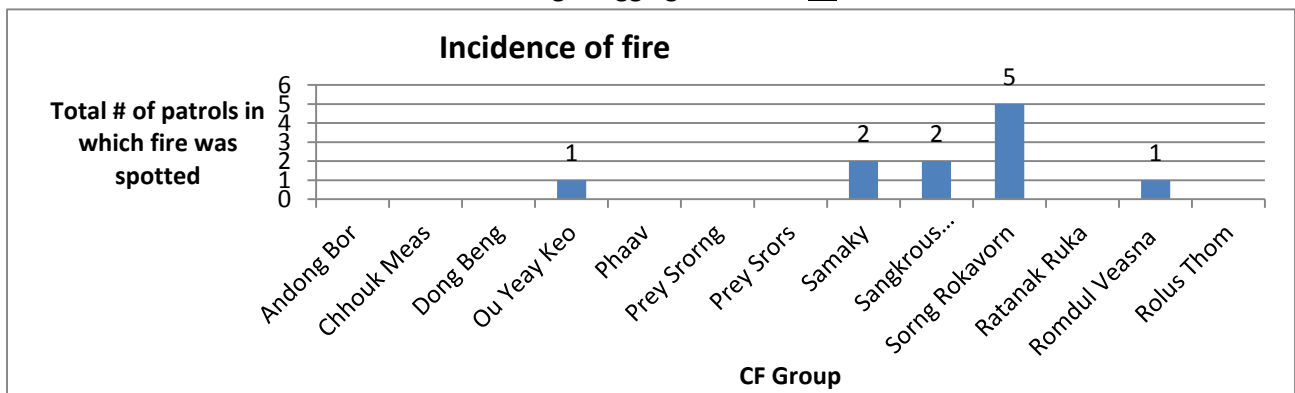

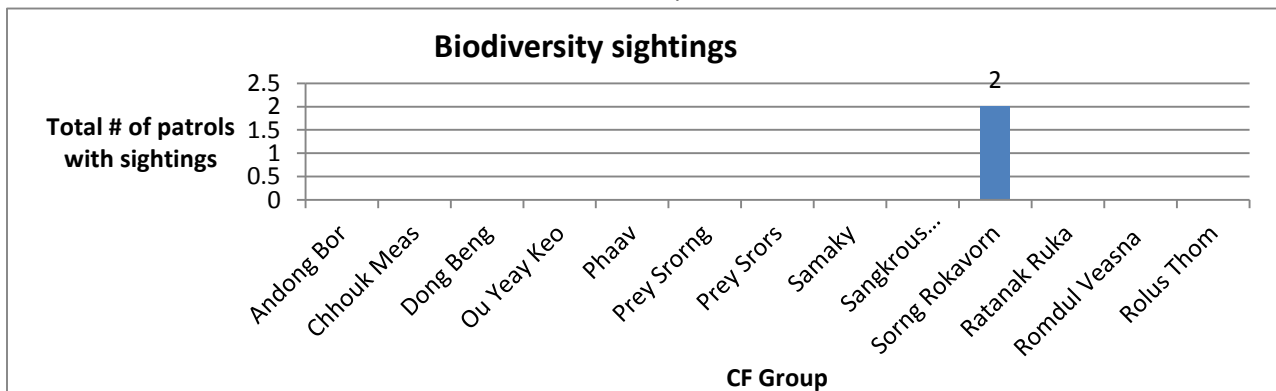

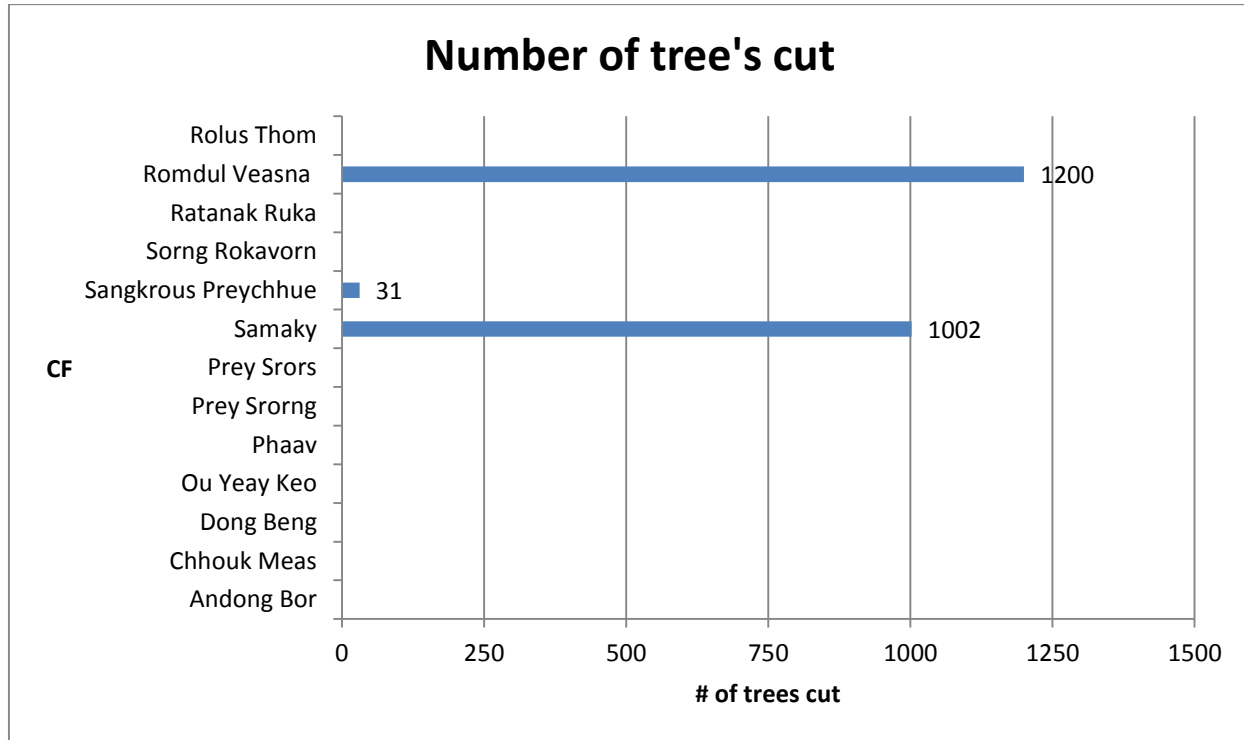

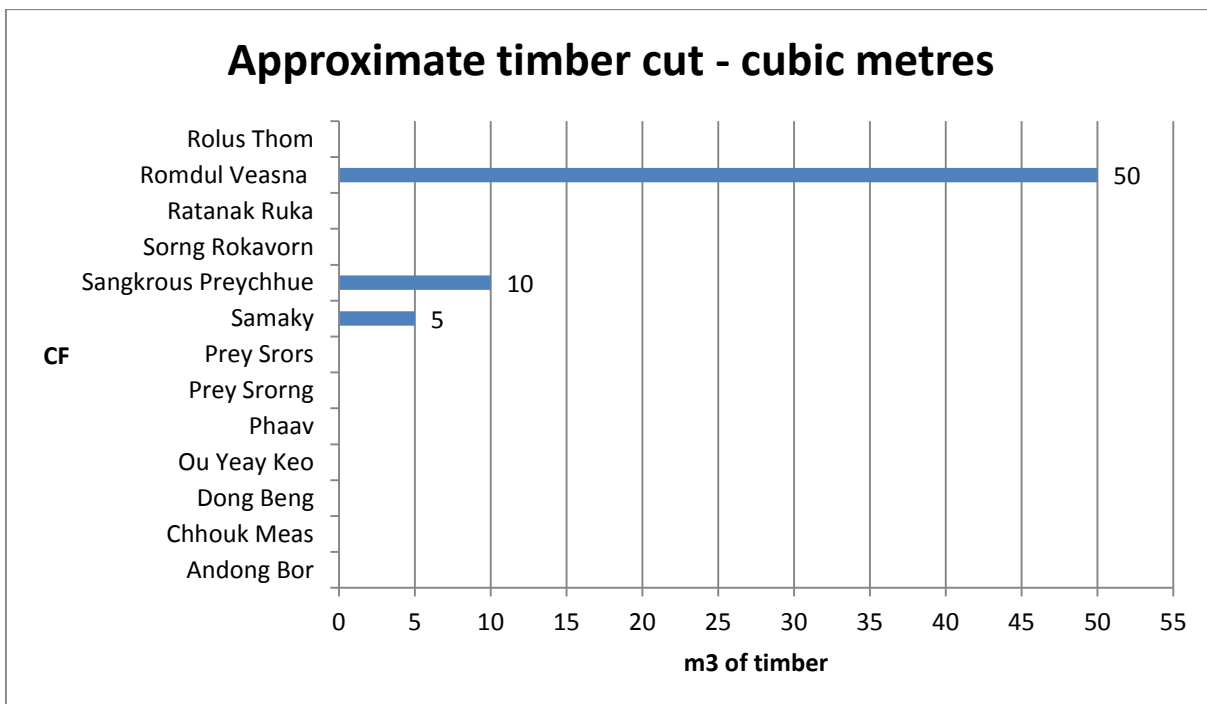

Illegal Logging Information – collected from Frontline SMS reports

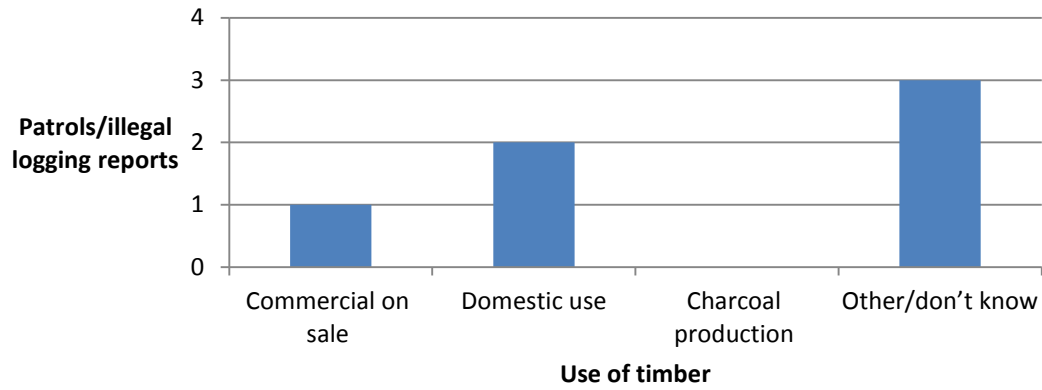

Uses of timber collected illegally inside the CF

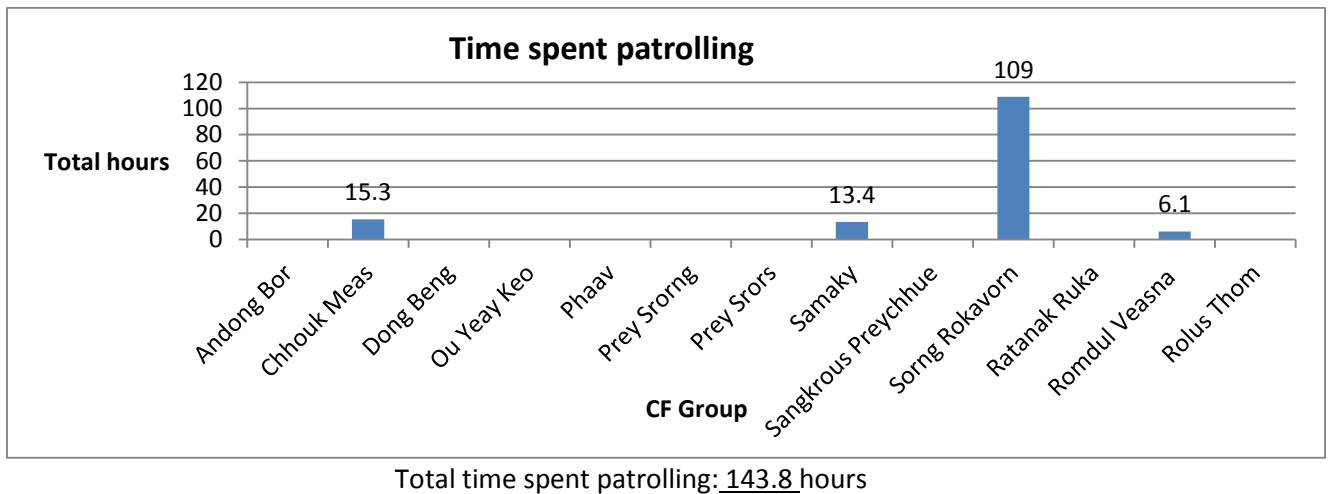
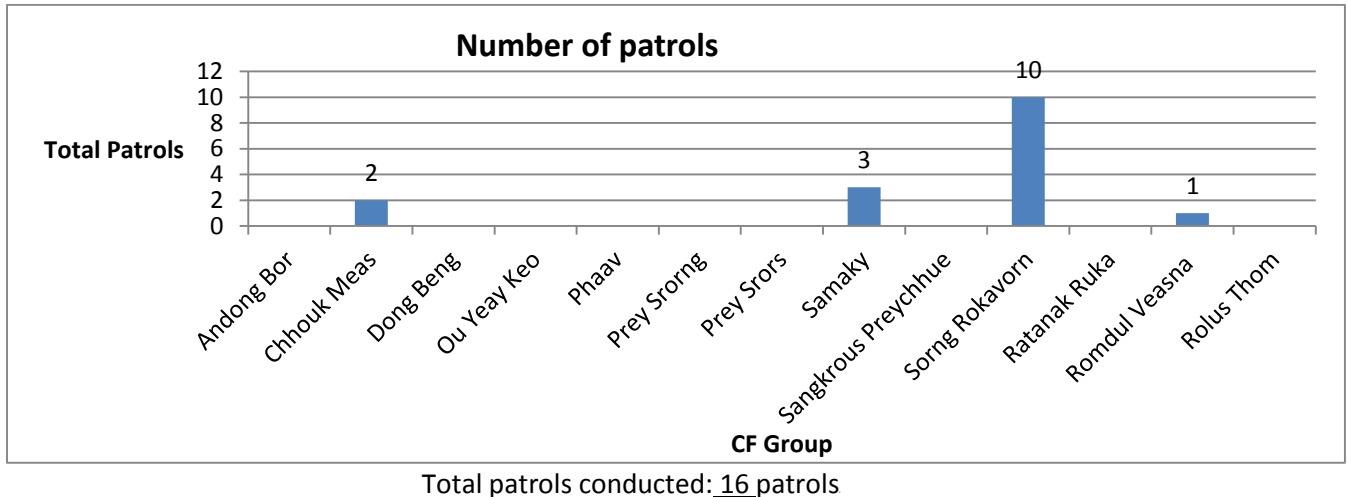

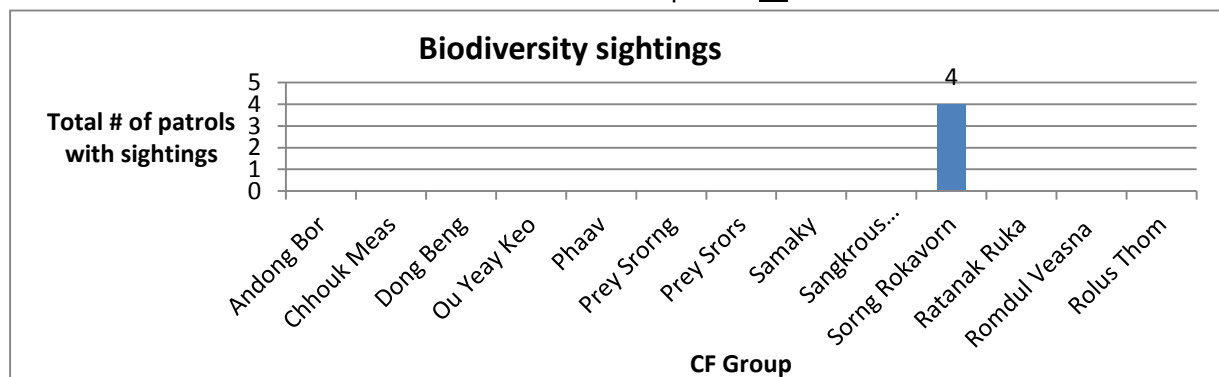

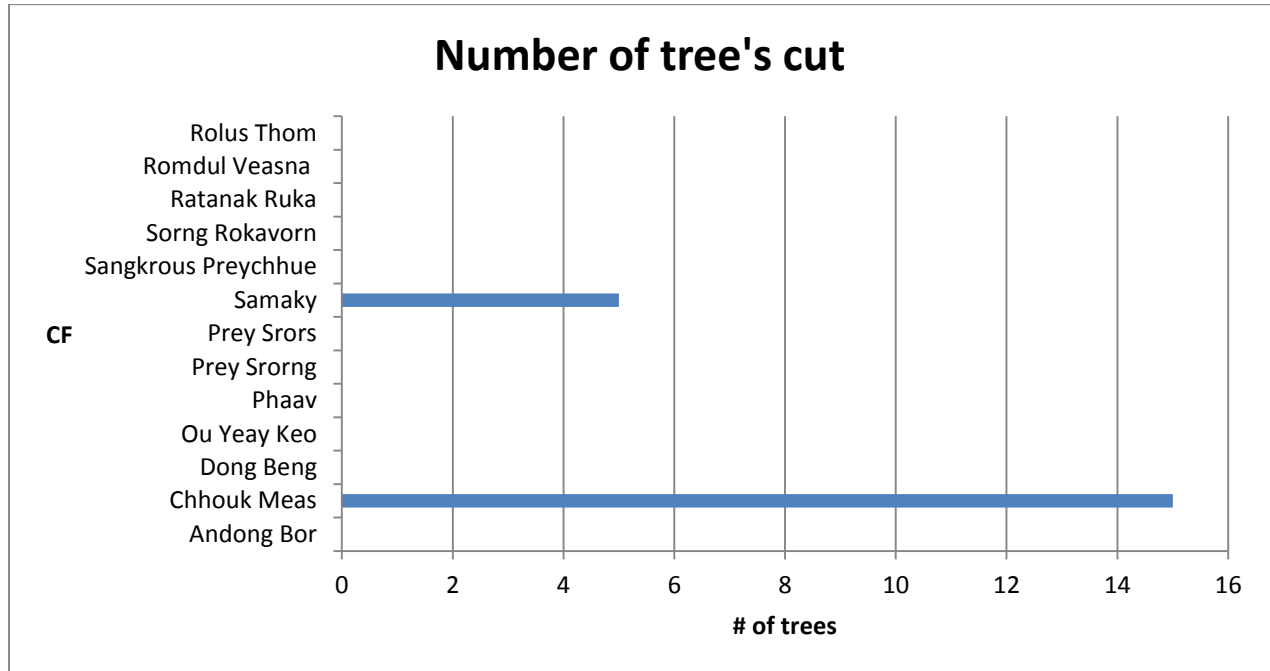

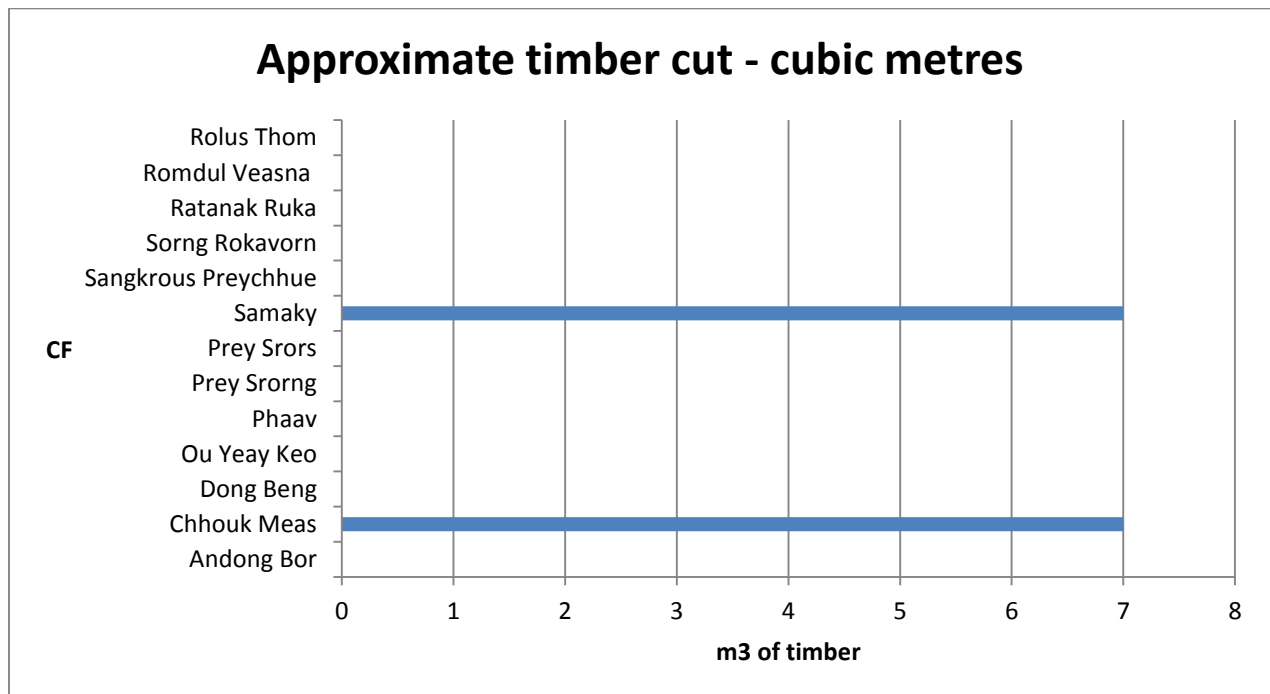

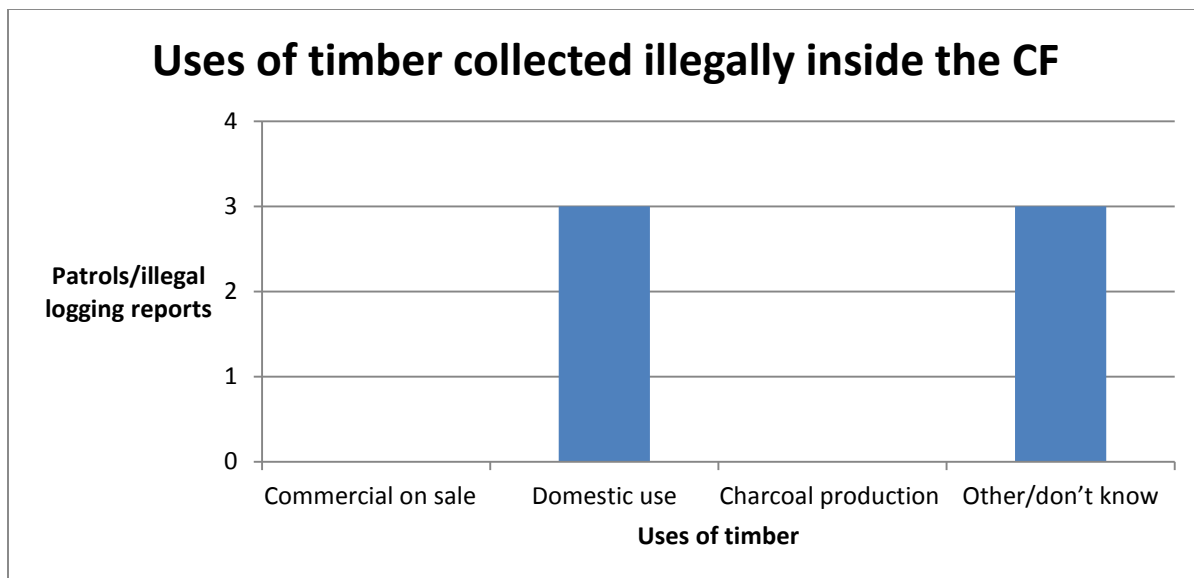
Illegal Logging Information – collected from Frontline SMS reports

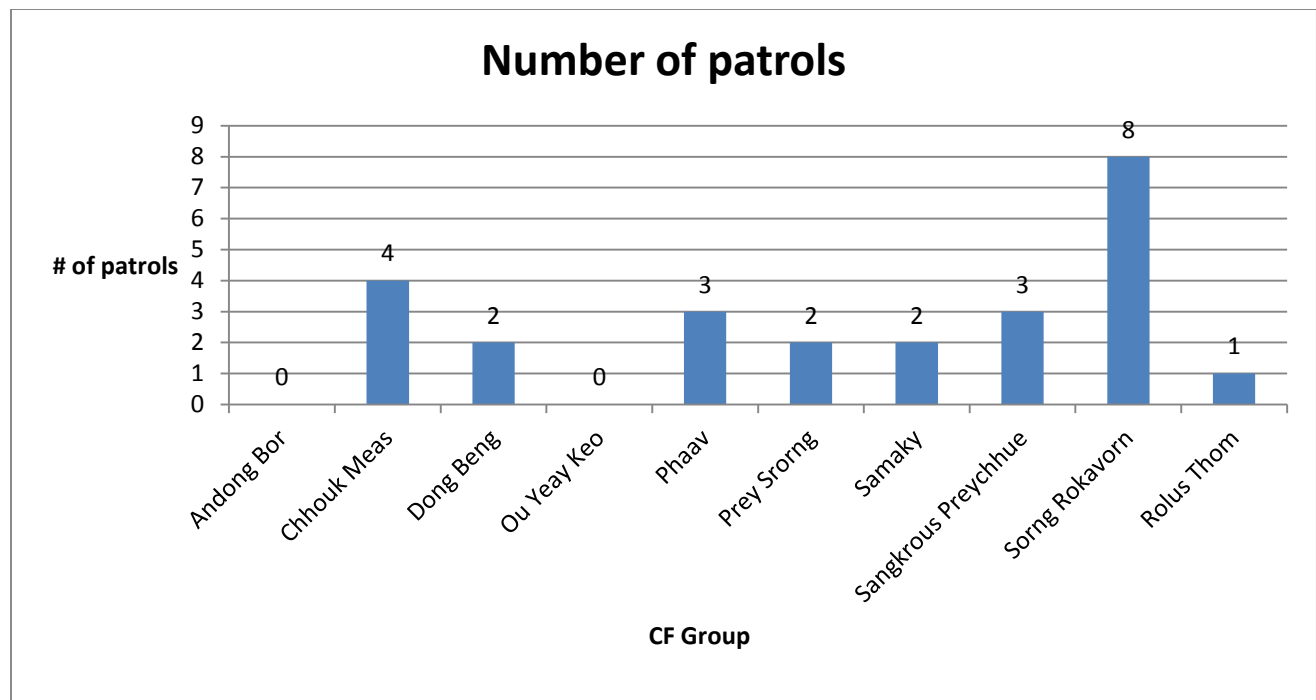


Monthly Report on Community Forest Patrolling in Oddar Meanchey – April 2013



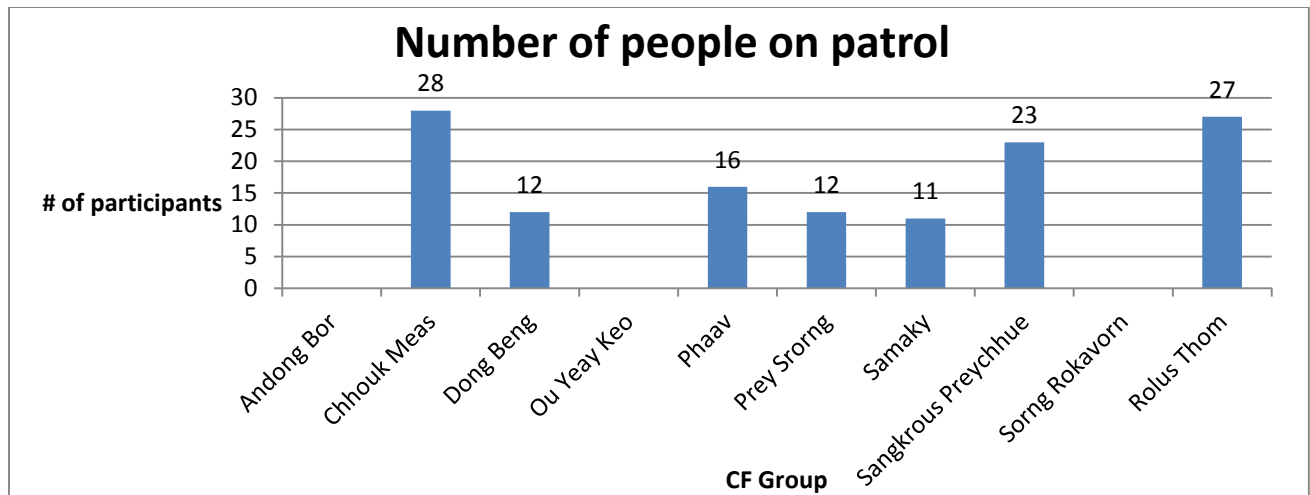

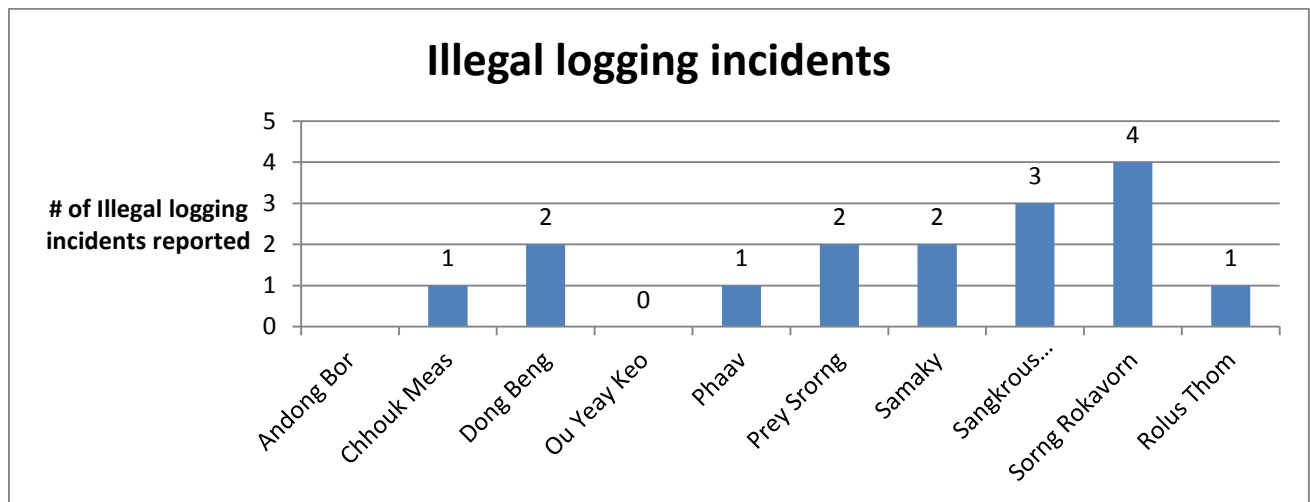

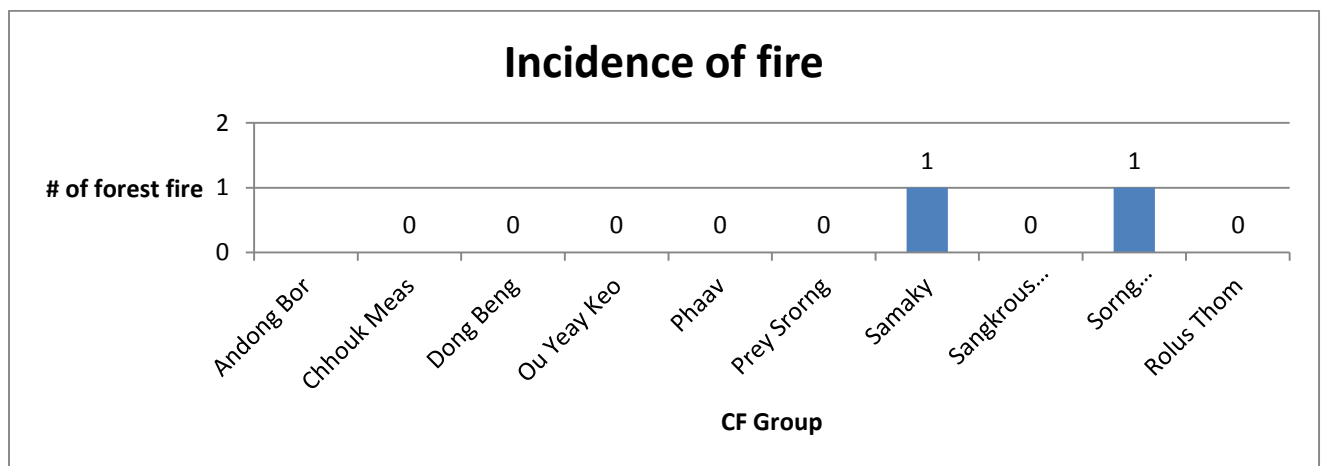

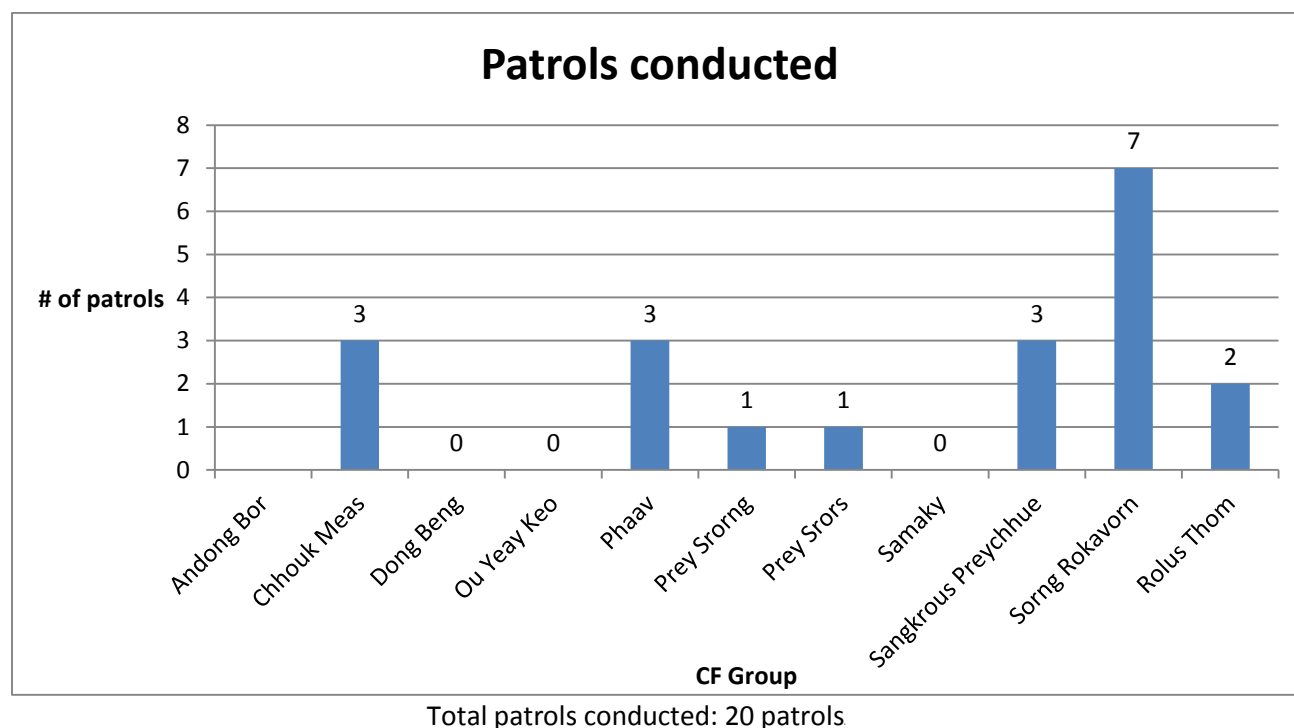

Monthly Report on Community Forest Patrolling in Oddar Meanchey – May 2013

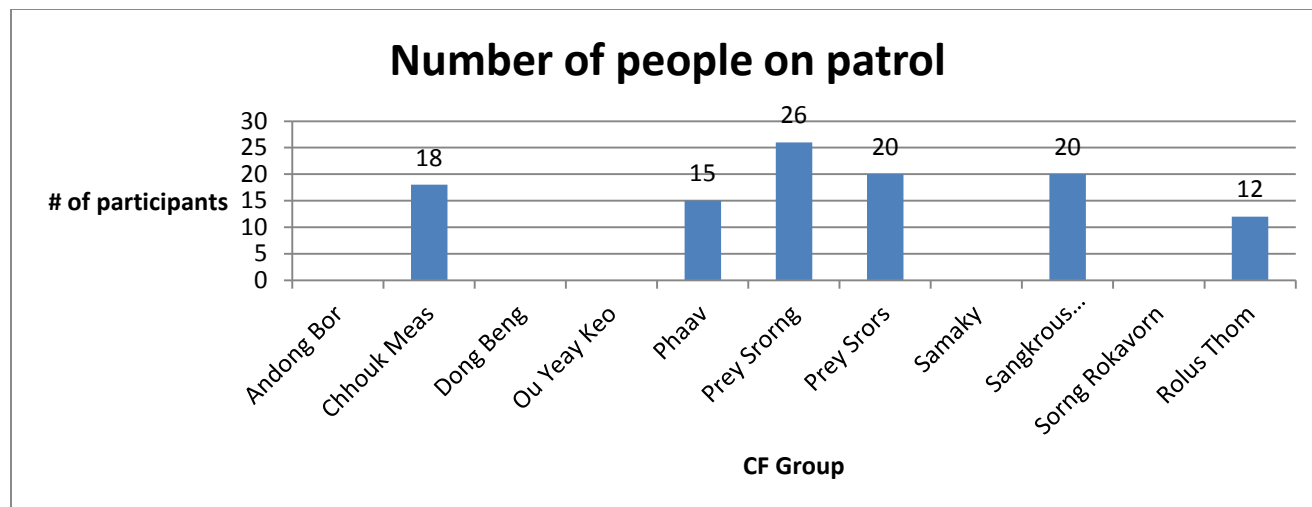

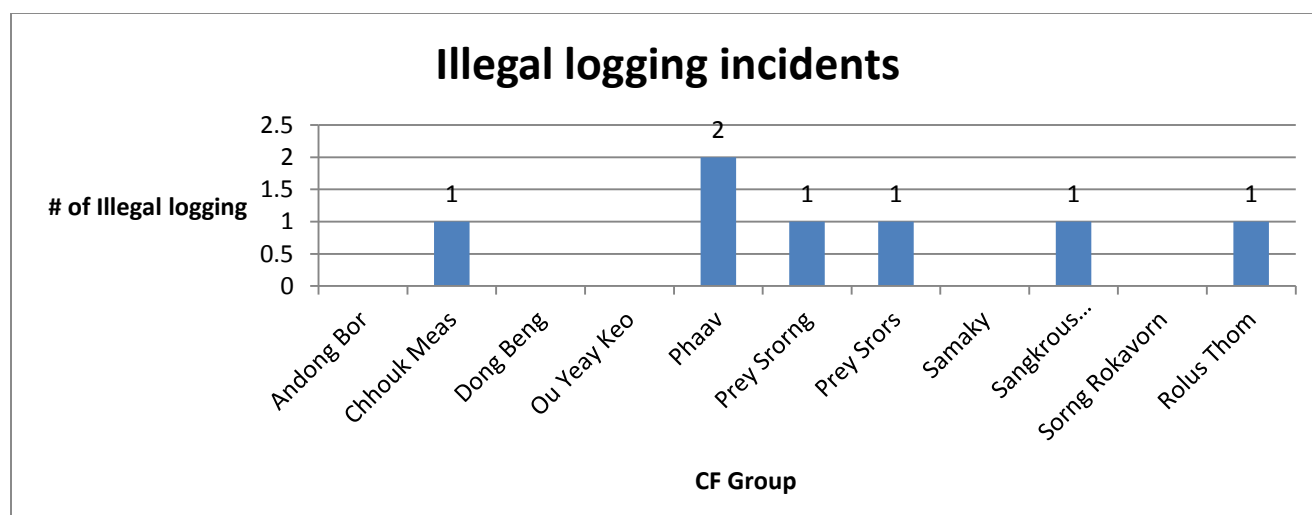

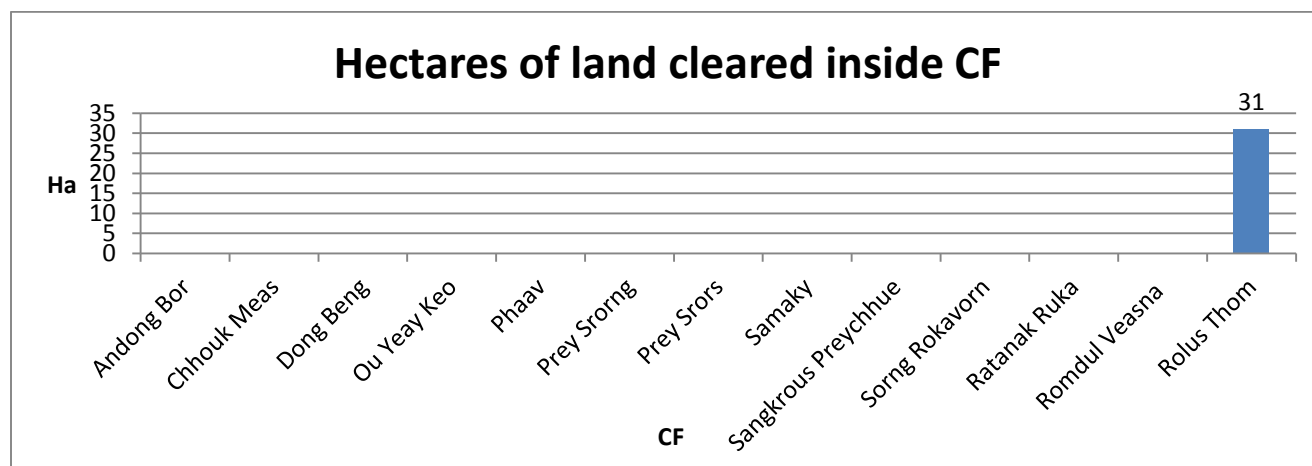
