



Request for Policy Board Inter-Sessional Decision on no-cost Extension for Zambia National Programme 8 October 2013

Recalling decision nine taken by the Policy Board at the ninth Policy Board meeting¹:

9. The Board decided that requests for no-cost extensions of National Programmes with a duration of more than three years should be submitted for consideration by the Board intersessionally, justifying the reasons for the request, including proposed actions to enhance implementation.

Noting that, as reported in semi-annual and annual reports, Zambia's National Programme experienced significant delays in implementation.

Also noting that, in June 2013 the UN-REDD Programme received a <u>request from Zambia</u> for a nocost extension of the National Programme from August 2013 to December 2014, including a <u>revised</u> <u>action plan</u> and other supporting documentation.

Noting section 1.1 of the UN-REDD Programme Rules of Procedure allowing for decisions of the Policy Board to be made between meetings (referred to as "Inter-Sessional" decision-making).

Given the above, the Policy Board members are hereby requested to approve the following:

The Board approves, on a no objection basis, a no-cost extension for Zambia's National Programme until December 2014.
