UN-REDD PROGRAMME TENTH POLICY BOARD MEETING

25-28 June 2013 Lombok, Indonesia

VENUE

The Tenth Policy Board meeting will be held from 25 to 27 June 2013 in the **Santosa Villas and Resort in Lombok, Indonesia** (Bima Ballroom).

HOTEL ACCOMMODATION

The UN-REDD Programme has secured a block booking at the **Santosa Villas and Resort** with a group rate of USD\$ 70 (standard room) \$80 (superior room) per night inclusive of breakfast and taxes. Please note that blocked rooms are limited and will be designated on a first come, first serve basis.

Hotel rooms have been secured and paid for by the UN-REDD Programme for **sponsored participants** at the Santosa Villas and Resort, however, sponsored participants will be responsible for covering any incidental expenses (such as room service, phone calls, etc.). Please note that it is standard practice for hotels to request a credit card or cash deposit upon your arrival to cover incidentals.

The reservation period for IP and CSO sponsored participants is from **23-28 June 2013**, and partner country sponsored participants from **24-28 June 2013**, unless otherwise indicated by the participant. As in past practice, hotel rooming arrangements for sponsored participants are being made in coordination with the FCPF FMT to ensure that reservations for participants attending the FCPF PC 15 meeting will be extended as required.

TRAVEL FOR SPONSORED PARTICIPANTS

Funded participants are entitled to a return air ticket in economy class from their home country to Lombok, Indonesia at the least costly fare and most direct route, in accordance with UN rules. **Ms. Rosa Andolfato**, (Tel: +41-22 917 8946, Email: rosa.andolfato@un-redd.org) will process travel arrangements of sponsored participants and will send their electronic air ticket by e-mail. Please note that once itineraries are confirmed by the traveller no further changes can be made. If you prefer to arrange your own travel please advise accordingly.

TRANSPORTATION TO/FROM AIRPORT IN LOMBOK

Lombok's Bandara international airport (http://www.lombokairport.com/index.html) is located near the city of Praya on Jalan Raya, Tanak Awu Lombok Tengah in central south Lombok and is approximately 40 km south of Mataram (capital city of Lombok), and 55 km southeast of the established Senggigi tourism district of West Lombok. We recommend taking the airport taxi, which takes about 45-60 minutes to the venue (approximately IDR 150.000 = US\$16/one way). Sponsored participants will be provided with terminal expenses to cover the transportation costs between the airport and the hotel in Lombok and their respective home country, in accordance with UN rules.

DAILY SUBSISTENCE ALLOWANCES (DSA) FOR SPONSORED PARTICIPANTS

DSA for sponsored participants_will be issued at the meeting venue upon presentation of passport data page and original airline ticket stubs for your journey to Lombok. The DSA is calculated to cover incidental costs, dinner, and travel days outside the official meeting dates, in accordance with the UN rules. Accommodations, breakfast, lunch and coffee breaks during PB10 meeting days are covered. DSA will be issued during lunch break on 26 and 27 June. The focal person for DSA issuance in Lombok is Ms. Frances Lim (frances.lim@unredd.org), UN-REDD Events Coordinator, *ad interim*.

VISA REQUIREMENTS

A visa for entry to Indonesia is required. Holders of national passport from the following countries are eligible to obtain a short visit Visa on Arrival (VOA), valid for up to 30 days:

The short visit VOA costs (visa up to 30 days) costs US\$ 25.00.

The following 12 countries are eligible for an entry visa free of charge for a short visit of up to 30 days: Brunei Darussalam, Chile, Ecuador, Hong Kong SAR (Special Administration Region), Macao SAR, Malaysia, Morocco, Peru, Phillipines, Singapore, Thailand, and Viet Nam.

In the case where a participant lives in a country where there is no Indonesian embassy, consulate general or consulate, the Secretariat will liaise and coordinate with the Government of Indonesia to facilitate the issuance of a Visa on Arrival authorization letter. A scanned copy of the relevant passport pages (information including name, gender, number of passport, type of passport, nationality, country of residence, and occupation) must be sent to the Secretariat to facilitate the issuance of the authorization letter prior to arrival in Indonesia. WEATHER

The average daily temperature in Indonesia is a high of 36° Celsius and a low of 25° Celsius. Indonesia is located within the tropical latitudes, and experiences alternating periods of dry and wet climate. Light summer clothing is practical for outdoors while business attire/smart casual is recommended for meetings and/or workshops. Wet season usually starts around the end of October and lasts through early April.
