#### **Objective of activity** (one sentence):

To design the 8<sup>th</sup> meeting of the PEB

#### Justification (100 words or less):

At its 6<sup>th</sup> meeting, the PEB decided that it would modify its operations to have a closed session for decisions on programme implementation, and an open session for information exchange, with the new arrangement being introduced for its 8<sup>th</sup> meeting. At its 7<sup>th</sup> meeting, the PEB re-affirmed this decision and set the date for the 8<sup>th</sup> meeting on 7<sup>th</sup> August, 2014.

#### Approach(400 words or less):

At its 7<sup>th</sup> meeting, the PEB proposed that the closed session of the PEB would take place on the morning of 7<sup>th</sup> August, and the open session would take place in the afternoon.

Based on further discussions with PEB members, it is proposed that the closed session in the morning should be very similar to past PEB meetings, with the exception that no observers will be invited. Therefore, for the closed morning session, the only people present will be PEB members and RTS staff as resource persons. Additional resource persons may be invited to join for specific agenda items – for example, to give a presentation on a topic – if necessary.

A draft agenda for the closed session is attached as Annex 1.

For the open session in the afternoon, it is proposed that all partners of the Cambodia REDD+ Programme be invited to participate. An indicative list of partners is attached as Annex 2. Since it is not feasible to invite all partners to give presentations, the partners should be invited to prepare displays of their work, have available publications for distribution, etc. This means that there will need to be an area suitable for setting up displays, and in planning for the event, it is recommended that sufficient space be reserved for 10 displays. However, the number of partners wishing to prepare displays should be established as soon as possible.

In addition to the displays, it is proposed that there should be two "discussion fora" on selected issues, and that specific partners should be invited to give brief presentations on their on-going work, with sufficient time allocated for discussion. For the 8<sup>th</sup> meeting of the PEB, the two discussion fora could be on "Forest Monitoring" and "Safeguards", for example.

A proposed agenda for the open session is attached as Annex 3.

The outputs of the activity will be:

- Decisions on programme implementation made efficiently and effectively
- Awareness raised among partners about each other's contributions to REDD+ readiness
