Political will





Political will, national leadership, and robust partnerships between industrialized and developing countries are essential to reducing deforestation and forest degradation. REDD+ depends on the shared commitment of developing countries to contribute significant amounts of their forest resources and developed countries to provide sufficient predictable funding. **REDD+ partnerships must be flexible and** coordinated in their approach, respond to developing country needs and be based on lasting reductions in deforestation and forest degradation. No single organization

can address the complexities of implementing **REDD+ alone: it requires all of us.**
