Common Approach

- Uses a performance-based approach to ensure Delivery Partners' social & environmental standards are “substantially equivalent”
 - Refers to material elements of *applicable World Bank* environmental and social safeguard policies and procedures; and
 - Compliance with *FCPF requirements*

WB Environmental and Social Safeguards Relevant to FCPF Readiness Fund

1. Environmental Assessment
2. Natural Habitats
3. Forests
4. Physical and Cultural Resources
5. Indigenous Peoples
6. Involuntary Resettlement

FCPF Requirements

- Strategic Environmental & Social Assessments (SESAs);
- FCPF/UN-REDD Guidelines on Stakeholder Engagement in REDD+ Readiness Preparation;
- Disclosure of Information; and
- Grievance & Accountability:
 - assistance to Pilot Country compliance with Guidelines for Establishing Grievance and Redress Mechanisms; and
 - DP accountability mechanism to respond/address claims related to the Common Approach
