





UN-REDD Bangladesh Process to date



- March 2010: Bangladesh submitted request for inclusion under UN-REDD programme
- May 2010: Bangladesh becomes observer of UN-REDD programme





- Feb-March 2011: Government request to UNDP country office for expedited support
- June 2011: Country office decision for core funding; invites UNDP regional office mission to Bangladesh
- August 2011: REDD+ Readiness Roadmap technical DD team formation and first mission



Preliminary REDD+ Strategy








- Legal and Policy Framework analysis, including:
 - Compilation of existing legal instruments and policies
 - Analysis of existing policies against REDD+ objectives
 - Outcomes of Social Forestry and Co-management policies
 - Policy conflicts between forestry and other land use sectors
 - Land tenure systems in different forest types and areas
- Analysis of drivers of deforestation/ degradation and constraints to forest sector
- Mapping and analysing existing initiatives and projects
- Potential REDD+ Strategies in 3 forest areas UN-REDD



REDD+ Readiness Management Structure



- Examine management structure options, including existing institutions
- Create multi-stakeholder forum











REDD+ Capacity Building Strategy







- Map existing initiatives contributing to capacity development
- Develop competency framework for REDD+
- Capacity assessment of forest sector institutions and stakeholders
- Identify requirements for:
 - Training forest sector stakeholders
 - Infrastructure
 - Awareness raising
 - Institutional development
- Cost estimate for capacity building strategy D



Timeline







Novmeber:

- Identify capacity building requirements
- Capacity building strategy and cost estimate
- Identify co-financing opportunities and development partners
- Draft Roadmap

December:

- Assessment of existing carbon monitoring approaches and recommend national MRV system
- Analyse data on forest area and quality and establish preliminary reference scenarios
- Consult and finalise Roadmap





Further activities







- Operational Plan for preparation of UN-REDD Country Programme Document (or equivalent)
- Feasibility Study and Operational Plan for preparation of 'Phase 2' (pilot) activity proposal
- Evaluate emission reduction potential of region-specific REDD+ strategies
- Continued development of consultation process
- Communication with UN-REDD policy board
