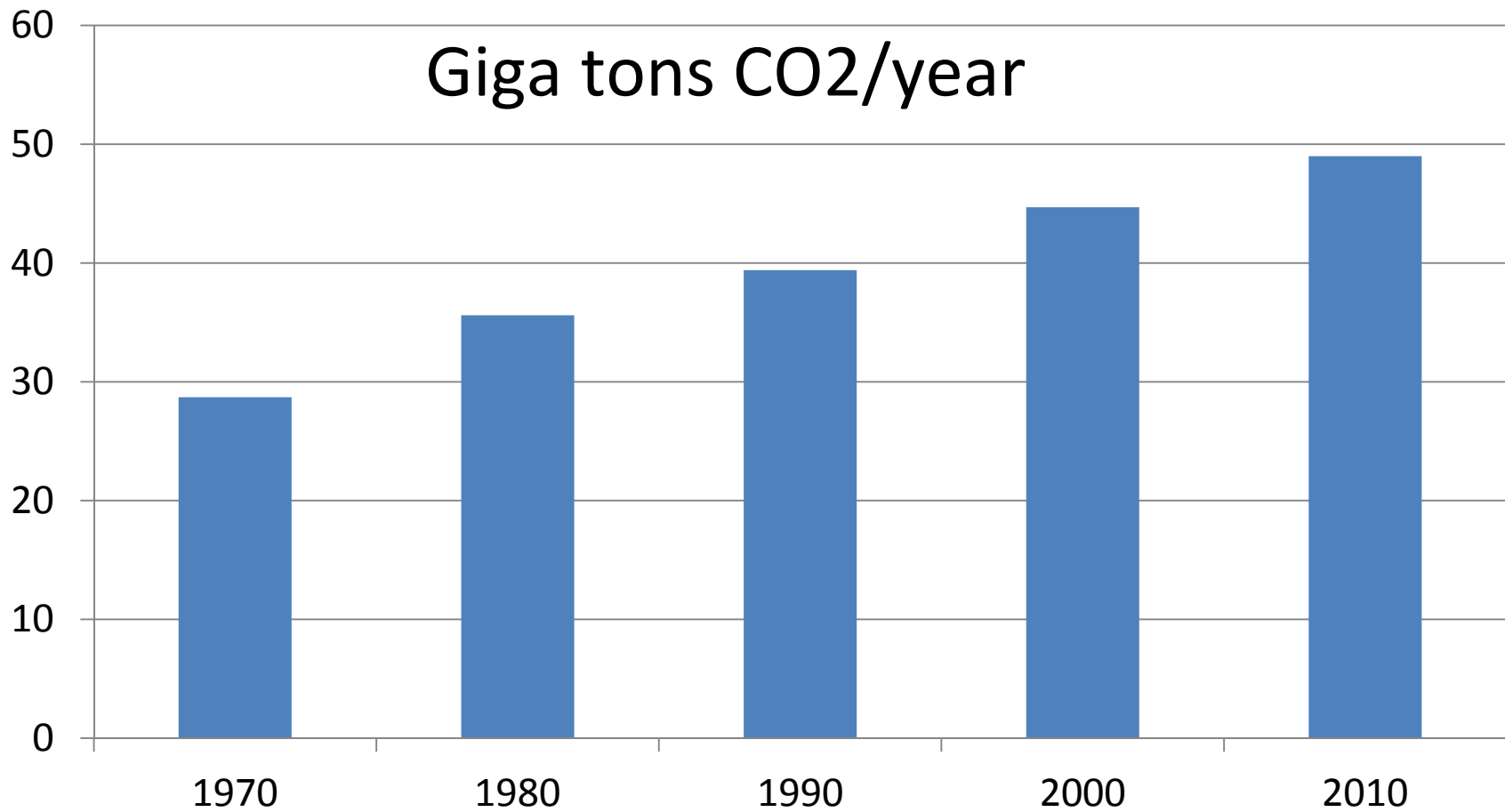

Global emissions continue to increase



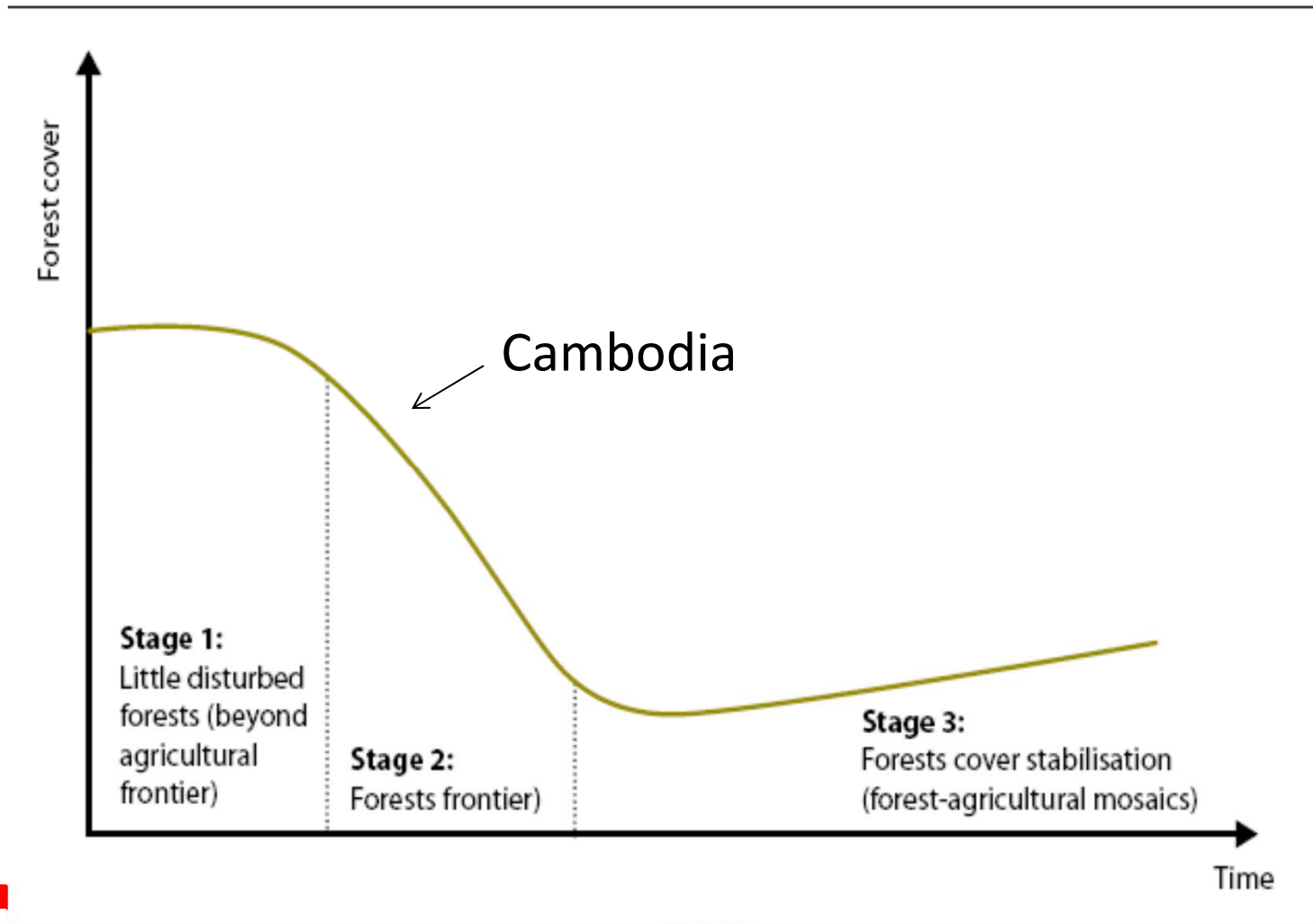
Global loss of 13 million hectares of forest every year



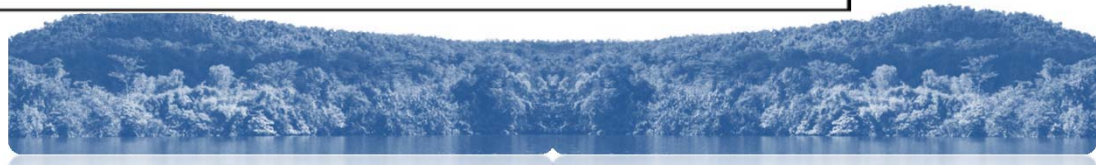
Emissions from deforestation 3 Gt CO₂/year

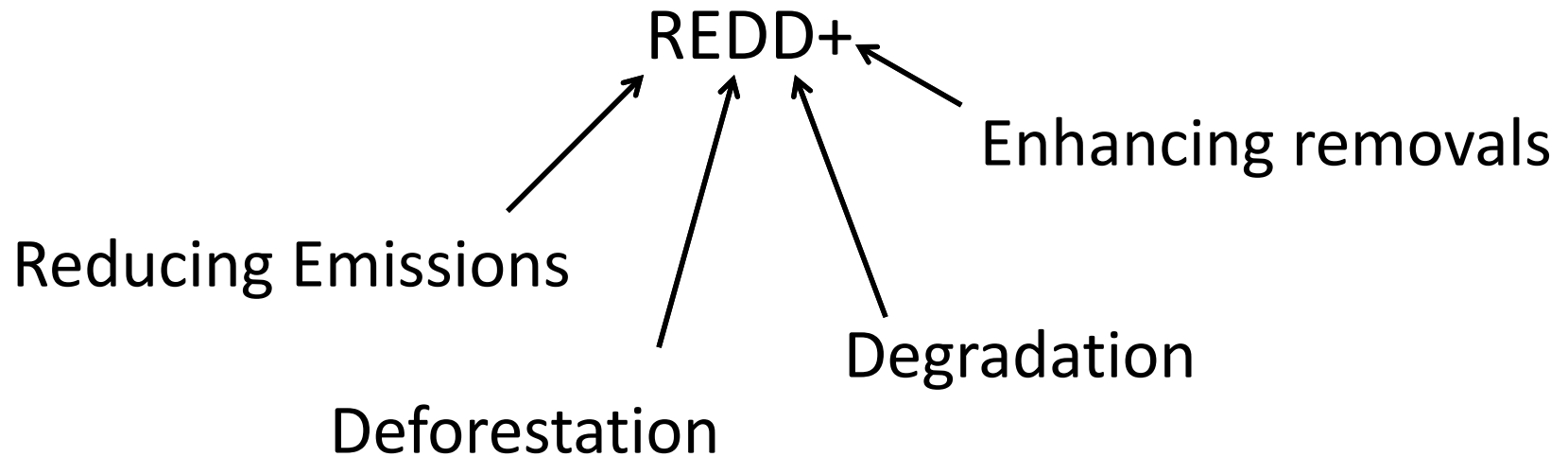


Cancun Agreements COP16 in 2010
