- Systematized and disseminated lessons learned
- Handbook for National Programmes and other National activates
- Principles for implementation of National Programmes
- Improved the reporting system
- Developed joint evaluation process for NPs
- Thematic coordination and with other initiatives or actors based on country ownership

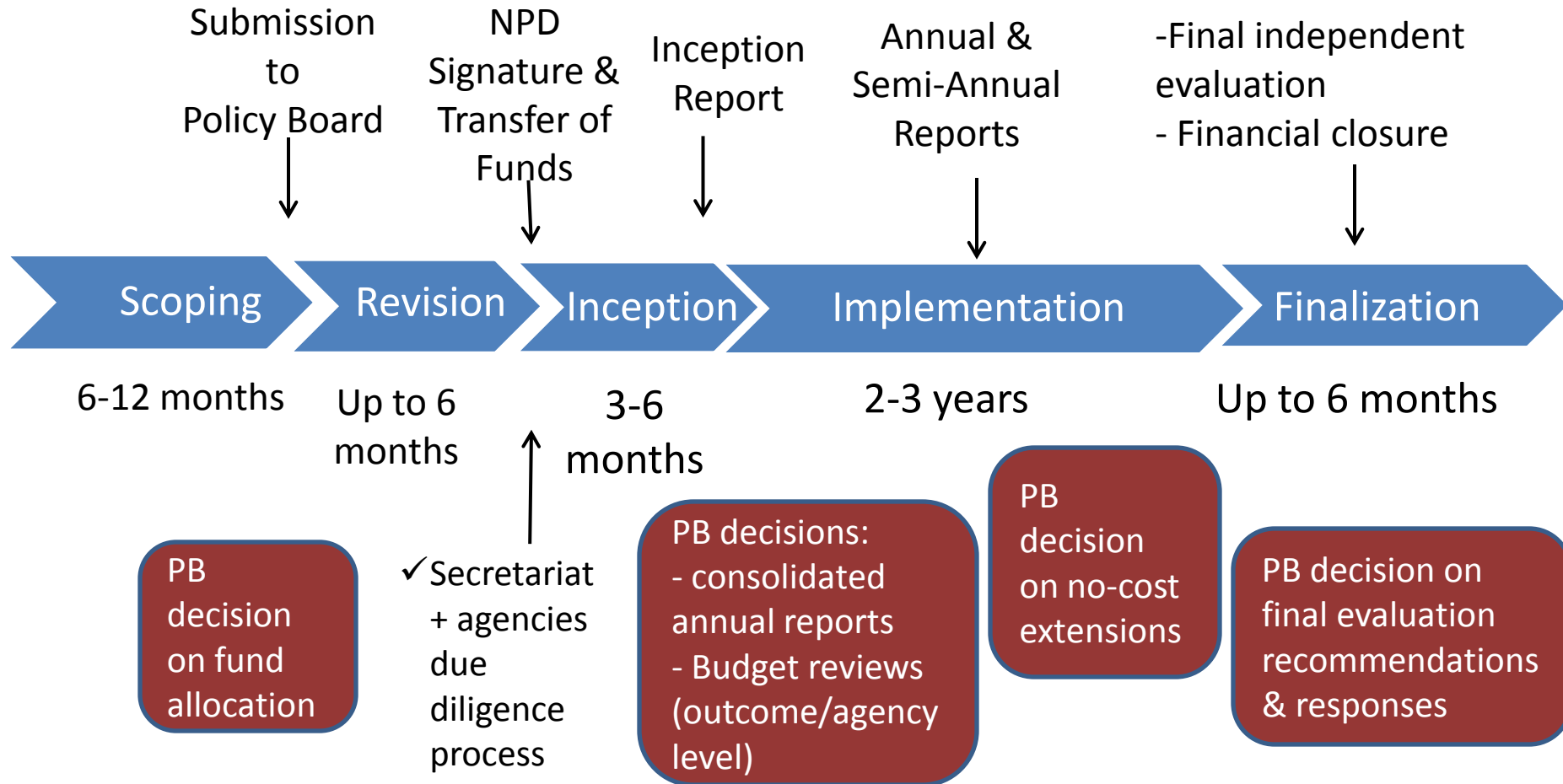


Background

- The [Programme's RoP and Op. Guidance](#) → general guidance on NPs → scoping, formulation, validation, and submission to the Policy Board
- From 2009 onwards the Board took several decisions & recommendations for NPs' submission, implementation and completion
- The guiding note summarizes the operational cycle of UN-REDD NPs → highlighting the role of the main actors including the PB, Government, CSOs and IPs, UN Agencies and Secretariat
