Following up on the letter from Dr Kuntoro Mankusubroto of 23 May 2013 and additional information received on results foreseen, workplan and budget, describing Indonesia's planned continuous work on Participatory Governance Assessment (PGA) for REDD+, I am pleased to inform you that the UN-REDD Programme has approved an additional amount to Indonesia under the targeted support modality.
