 Capacity Building at district level to benefit from REDD+.










Background

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Challenge of Engagement

- Different capacities among IP/local communities
- Different perception of the role of IP/local communities
- Limited acceptance of IP/local communities ideas
- Tenurial conflict

Awareness raising	To improve knowledge	Training programs, workshops, and FGD, conference (AMAN-Tobelu, IP's conference- Palu)
Encouraging	To strengthen role of institutions	National Forestry Council Conference (National Guidelines), IP's/local cummunities involved in National Strategy process)
Initiating	To trigger actors to act	Working Group REDD+ endorsed by Governor
Facilitating	To accelerate activities	Working Group REDD+ Pilot activities using Guidelines
Assisting	To identify and fill gaps (capacity building)	Intensive involvement, Provincial, National REDD+ development
