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## **Overall comments:**

The final evaluation (Ver. April 2013) shows the adequate assessments on the performance and results of Phase I of the UN-REDD Viet Nam Programme. The evaluation team has applied the standard methodology during the mission, such as: reviewing literature, interviewing relevant stakeholders and debriefing in Hanoi after the field trip.

Recommendations are useful for Viet Nam and other REDD countries. It is particularly important as Viet Mam is going to commence implementation of Phase 2 of the Programme.
