Highlights of International Support Functions

- Second workshop of the South-South Knowledge Exchange on national funds design held in Oslo in October
- "Guidance Note on Gender Sensitive REDD+" aiming to promote gender sensitive REDD+ processes and support Partner Countries and stakeholders in the preparation, development and implementation of gender sensitive national REDD+ strategies launched in November
- Updated lessons learned brochures on Benefit Distribution
 System in Asia-Pacific region









Highlights of International Support Functions

- Policy Brief, "REDD+ and the 2020 Aichi Biodiversity Targets: Promoting Synergies in International Forest Conservation Efforts" launched in October
- Policy Brief "Tenure and REDD+" completed and presented to the Policy Board at PB11
- UN-REDD fast fact flyer on legal preparedness for REDD+ launched in October











Highlights of Secretariat Functions

- Joint UN-REDD-FCPF Country Needs Assessment presented at the REDD+ Partnership regional workshop in Dominican Republic in August and in the REDD+ Partnership meeting in Indonesia, in October
- Resources mobilization resulted in new contribution from Denmark and new pledge from Norway
- Coordination of overall programming through development of the SNA budget revision and support to new National Programmes
- Coordination of Fifth Anniversary celebrations and COP XIX side event









Highlight of Country Specific Support

- DRC National Fund launched in Warsaw with support from UN-REDD Programme to institutional arrangements for making the fund operational
- Transparency and accountability used as criteria to understand drivers of deforestation and forest degradation and options for REDD+ financial architecture in Nepal through targeted support
- Bangladesh REDD+ Integrity study used to inform outputs of the Bangladesh National Programme, to be presented at PB11






