<b>File(s):</b>	<b>Objective(s):</b> (i) Agree coordinated plan for work of safeguards coordination group over 2013; (ii) Share and obtain input on UNEP's plans for work on safeguards and multiple benefits in 2013; (iii) Emphasise importance of SEPC as a guiding framework for our safeguards work

### Brief summary:

The Safeguards Coordination Group meeting's objectives were:

1. To improve the coordination and work of the UN-REDD Programme on safeguards
2. To finalize the work plan and role of the safeguards coordination group for 2013
3. To clarify the structures, roles and responsibilities relevant for the implementation of the Programme's work on safeguards including implementation in countries.

The meeting was spread over two days. The first was open to UN-REDD Programme staff more widely, and included Tim Clairs, a number of regional officers from UNDP (see above), and Lucy Goodman from WCMC. They were able to provide some clearer national perspectives on approaches to safeguards and safeguard information systems.

On the second day, the SCG core group discussed the ongoing role of the group, and more concrete plans for the coming year's work. We agreed that the conceptual framework was (virtually) complete. More time overall was spent on the Policies, Laws and Regulations component of the national approach to safeguards than on Safeguard Information Systems, but information was shared and actions agreed relating to both.

We were clear that the role of the group was to provide guidance based on this framework for the broader UN-REDD Programme on safeguards and SIS, to coordinate and undertake global work as needed, and to be available to provide technical support. The need now is to communicate this within UN-REDD. The group asked that new proposals for work on safeguards (in-country or under the SNA) be submitted to the group for review. We would not wish to review every output. The group also agreed to track (log) safeguards work being undertaken across the programme. We didn't precisely define the boundaries for this (e.g. when is work on FPIC, or mapping potential benefits, 'safeguards work').

We agreed to request an Information Session at Policy Board 10, which would focus on the conceptual framework and offer scope to communicate other safeguards work.

One welcome advance was a proposal from Maria Sanz Sanchez to put together an interactive decision tree (or matrix) for the tools and guidance available to countries at different stages of their work on safeguards. I offered the new multiple benefits webpages as a home for this, as it should be possible to use the CMS library of tools as a backbone for the tree. The draft of the framework would be prepared in time for the Information Session.

On specific tools, we agreed to work on options for the Benefit and Risks Tool, based on initial discussions last year and feedback received on the draft tool.

A participatory biodiversity monitoring briefing, drafted by UNEP-WCMC in collaboration with SNV, was circulated to the group for review and some constructive feedback received after the meeting.

The draft work table is attached; and a list of recommendations from the meeting will be sent to UN-REDD MG.
