





Background



UNFCCC Decision 1/CP.16: develop 'a national strategy or action plan'

- Location of potential sites/zones for REDD+ activities
- Specific policies/interventions to implement
- \rightarrow national/local priorities
- \rightarrow suitability of different locations
- \rightarrow spatial variability in risks/benefits
